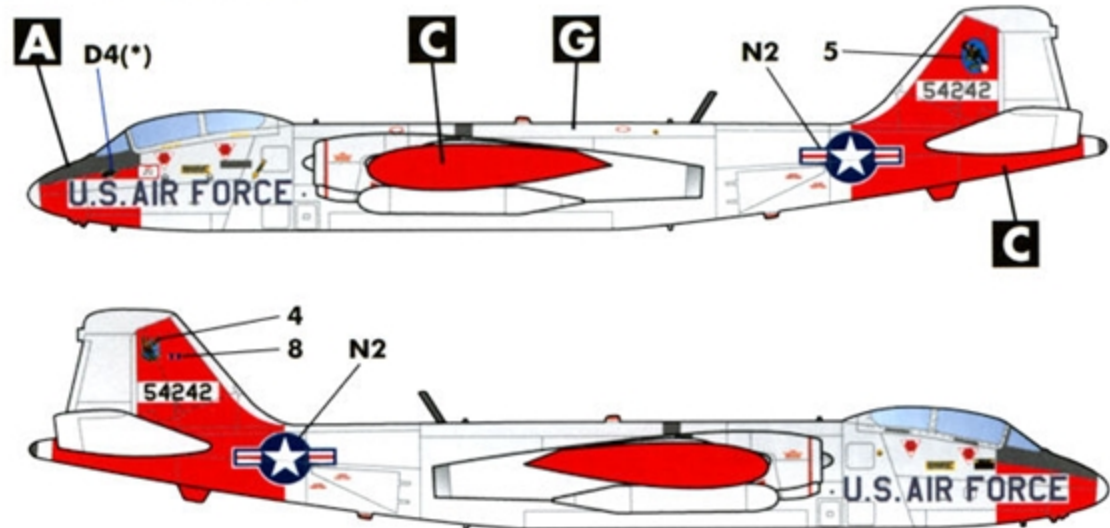

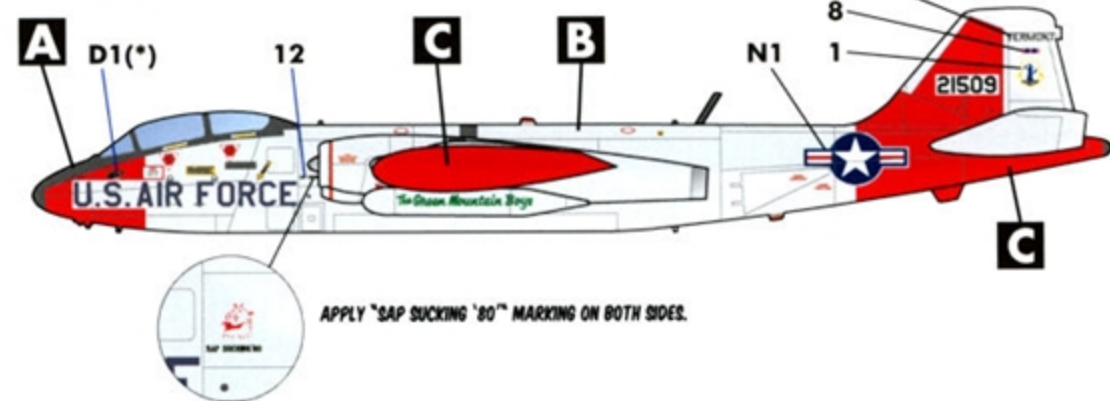


**OPTION 1: EB-57 55-4242**

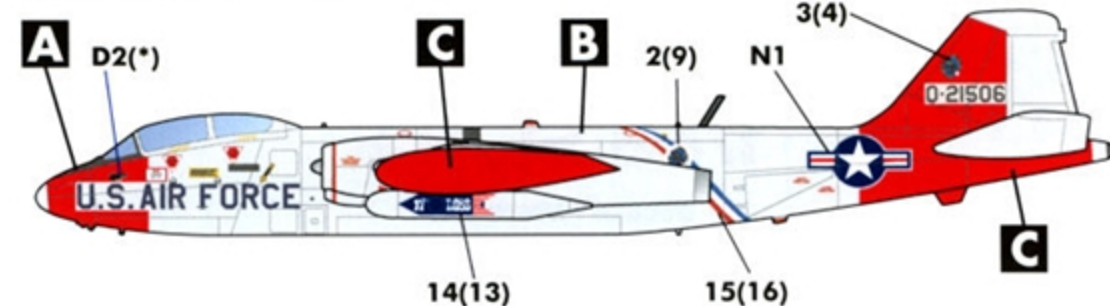

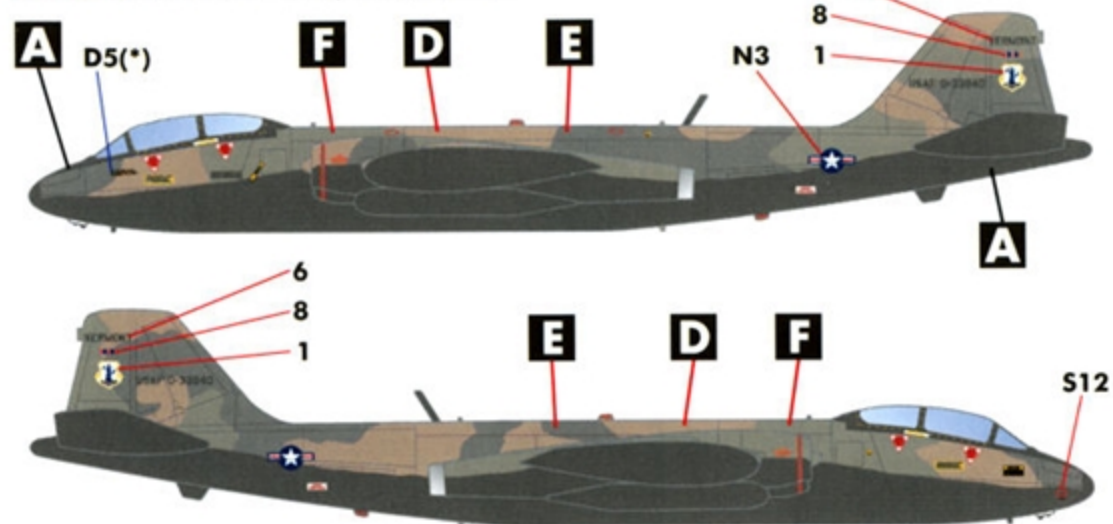

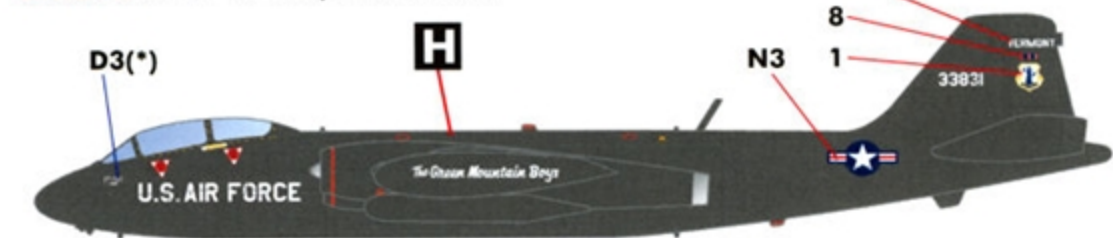

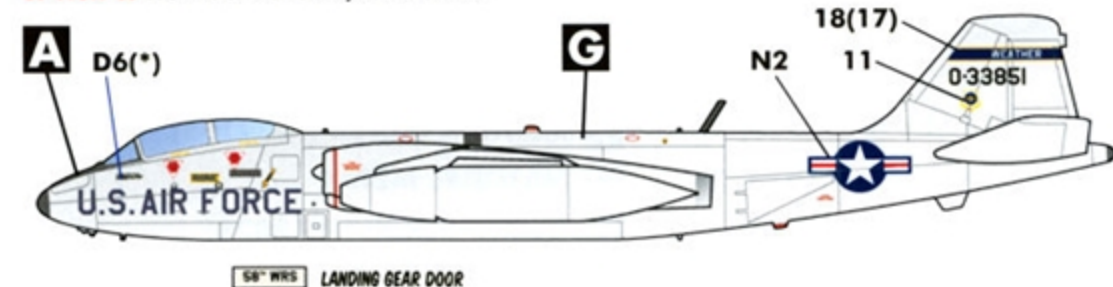

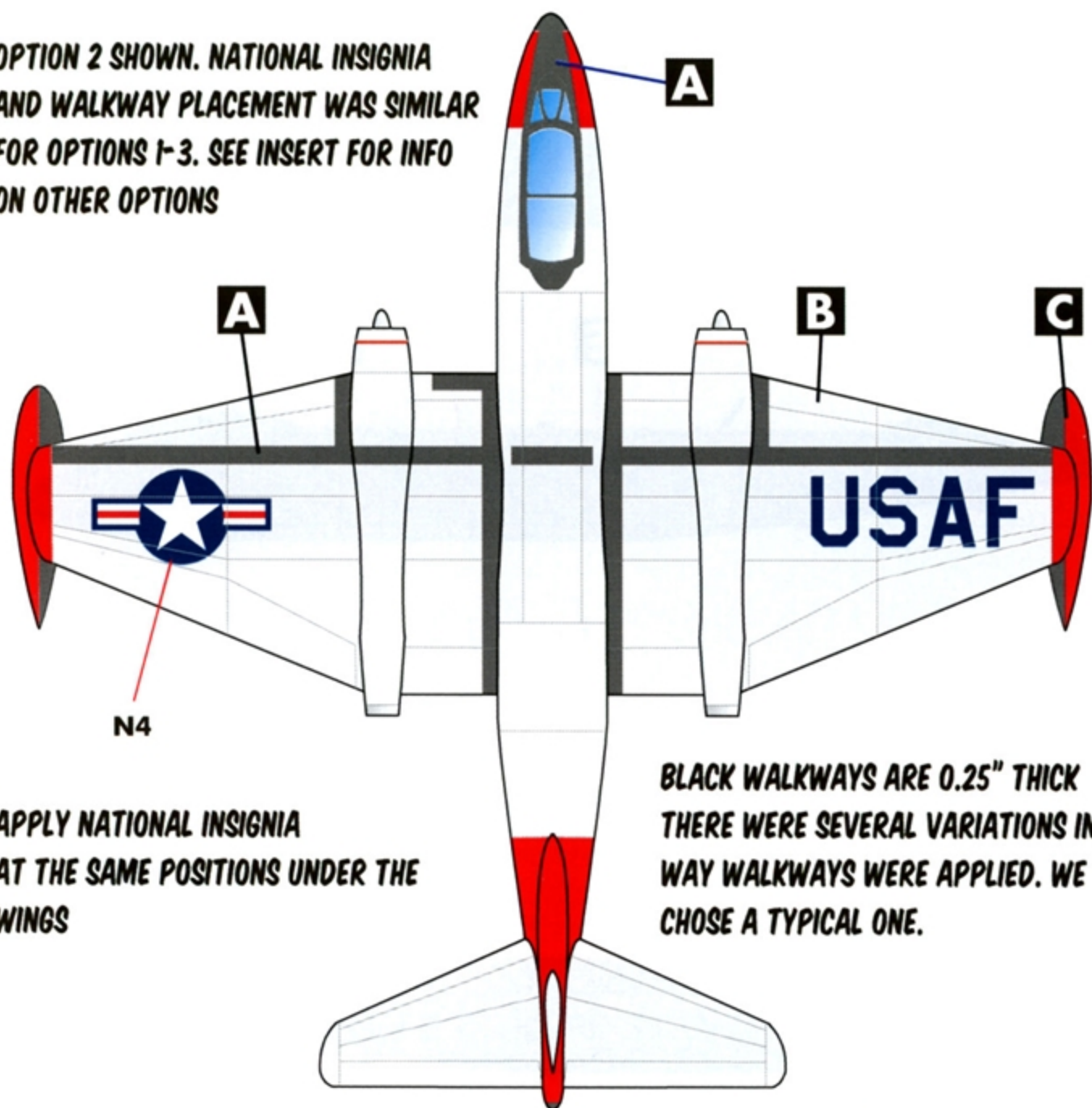

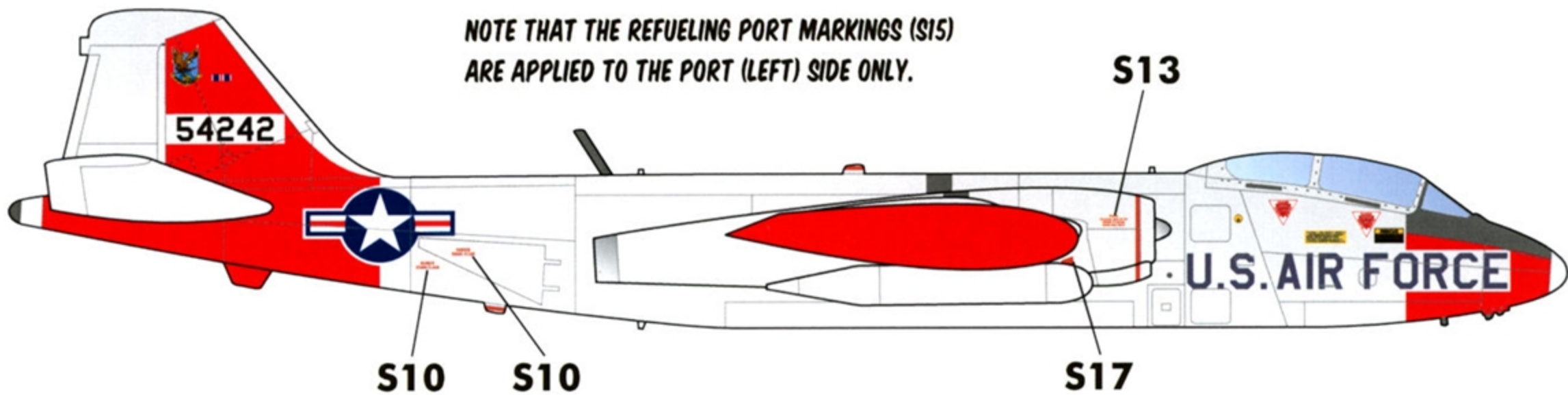

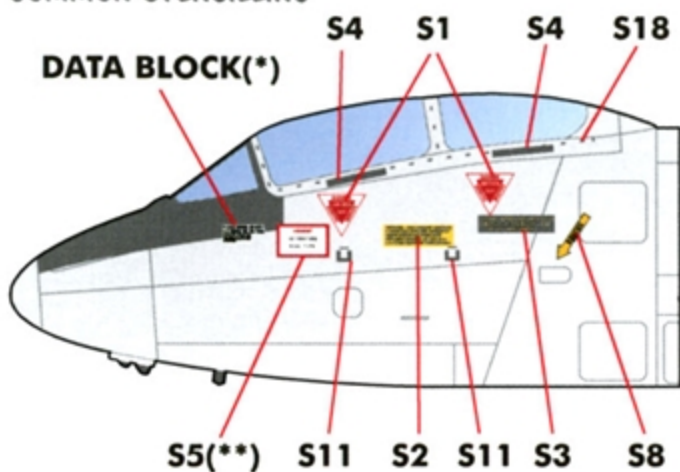

## COMMON STENCILLING



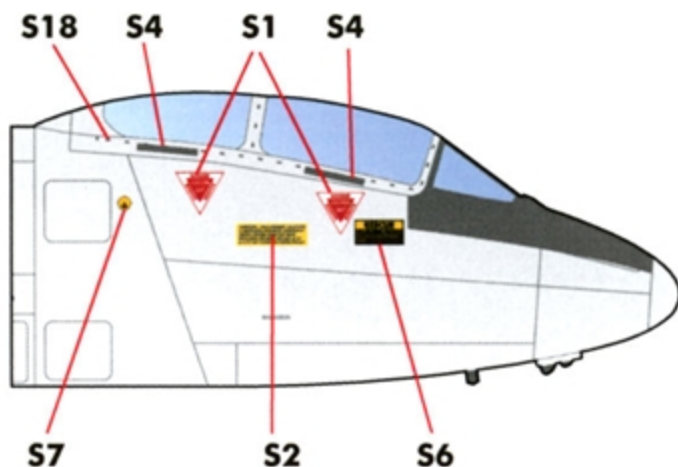
MARKINGS ON THE CANOPY FRAME (S18 AND S4) ARE SHOWN IN BLACK FOR CLARITY. CUT AND APPLY S18 ON THE CANOPY FRAME AS SHOWN.

(\*): THE DATA BLOCK WAS USUALLY A STICKER PRINTED ON METALLIC FOIL. APPLY THE CORRECT ONE (D1 TO D4) FOR THE OPTION OF YOUR CHOICE. ON SOME AIRCRAFT THIS DATA WAS PAINTED (D5 AND D6).

(\*\*): THE ARMAMENT PANEL TYPICALLY MENTIONED THE WING TIP DROP TANK SEPARATION DETONATORS, AS THE EB-57S WERE UNARMED. YOU HAVE THE OPTION OF USING A BLANK PANEL (S9).

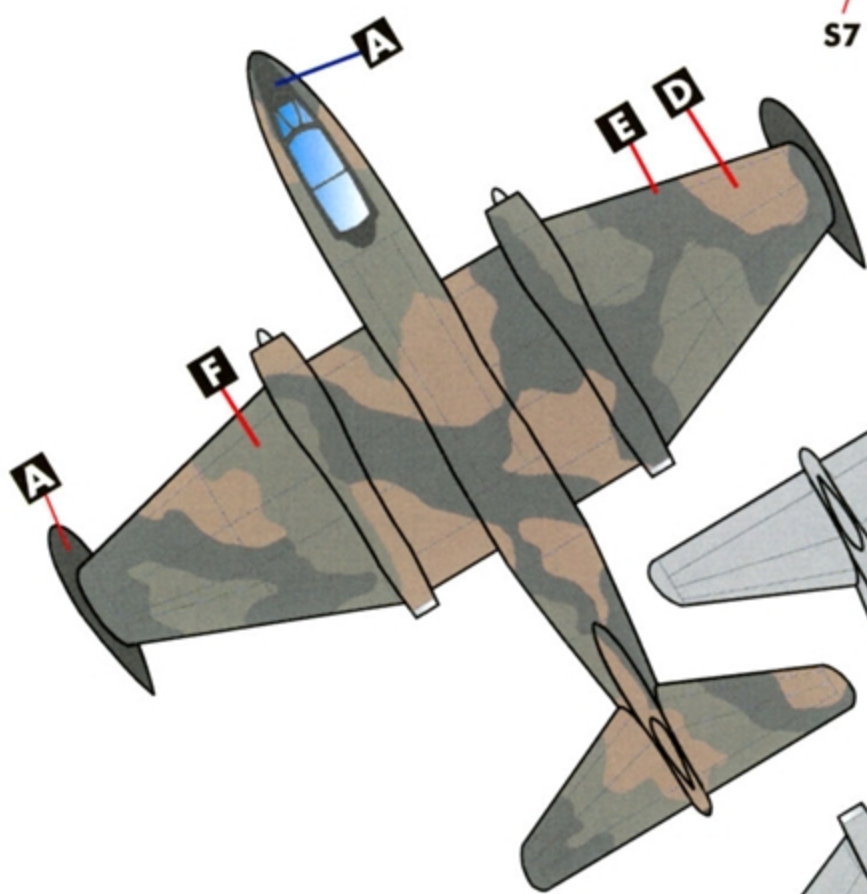
STENCILLING WAS SIMILAR FOR MOST POST-VIETNAM WAR PERIOD B-57 CANBERRAS, INCLUDING CAMOUFLAGED AIRCRAFT.

THE CREW ACCESS LADDER GUIDES (S11 ON MOST AIRCRAFT) WERE WHITE ON THE OVERALL-BLACK VERMONT ANG JET. USE S14 IF YOU CHOOSE THIS OPTION.



OPTION 4: USE STANDARD SEA CAMOUFLAGE SCHEME AS SHOWN. LOWER SURFACES ARE BLACK.

OPTION 6: USE LARGE INSIGNIA & USAF SCRIPT AS IN OPTION 1, BUT APPLY EARLY STYLE WALKWAY STRIPES FROM THE KIT DECAL SHEET.



OPTION 5: WE USED LIGHT GRAY FOR THE GLOSS BLACK AREAS TO SHOW THE WALKWAYS, WHICH ARE PAINTED IN FLAT WHITE. APPLY THE NATIONAL INSIGNIA IN THE SAME POSITIONS UNDER THE WINGS.
