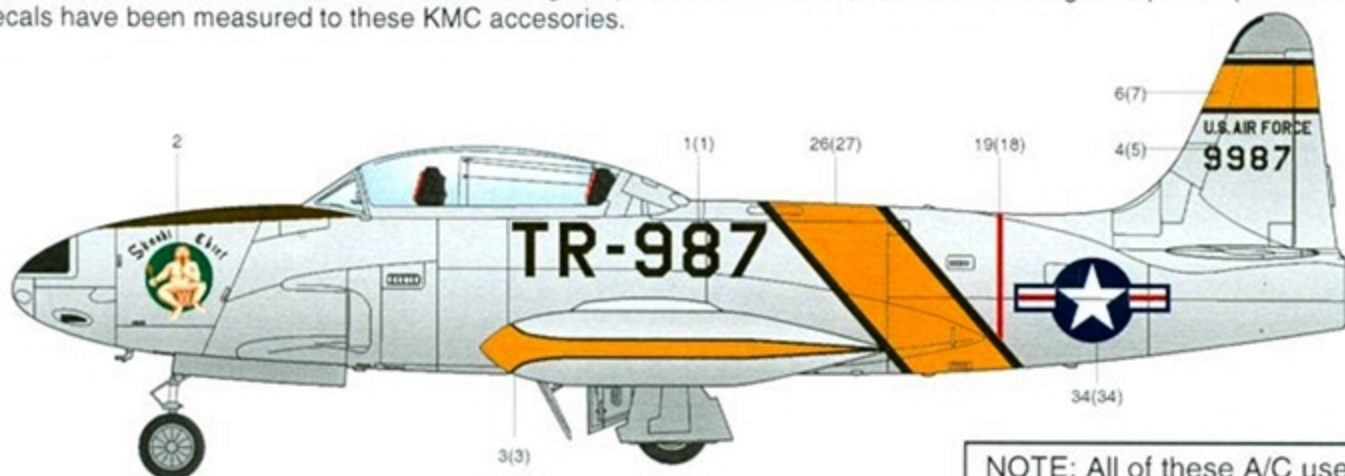

T-33A, serial number 49987 "Skoshi Chief", 4th Fighter Interceptor Wing, Kimpo, 1953. The aircraft is overall bare metal with Yellow and Black stripes on the main fuselage, wings, fin and tanks. Some slight trimming may be required for decal 3 to insure a neat fit. The aircraft has an Olive Drab anti-glare panel. All of these A/C used the 265 gal drop tank (KMC 48-5043). Decals have been measured to these KMC accessories.

T-33A, serial number 514125 "STOVE PIPE SUE", 51st Fighter Interceptor Group, Suwan, 1953. The aircraft is the usual bare metal with Yellow and Black stripes. The tips of the wing tanks are Red. The vertical stabilizer/rudder has Black checks applied above and below the 'U.S. AIR FORCE 14125' (these are identical to the decals provided in the 1/48 Hobbycraft Korean War T-33 model kit, and must be used.). An Olive Drab anti-glare panel is just forward of the canopy.



Center Red on Yellow



T-33A, serial number 49979 "SNAFU", 27th FIW but later assigned to 51st FIG, Suwan, 1952. The aircraft is bare metal with Yellow and Black stripes on the fuselage and wings. The forward areas of the fuselage and the wing tanks are Red. The anti-glare panel is Olive-Drab. The nose art is believed to have a Yellow outline to it. If this is not desired, simply apply decal 29b only.
