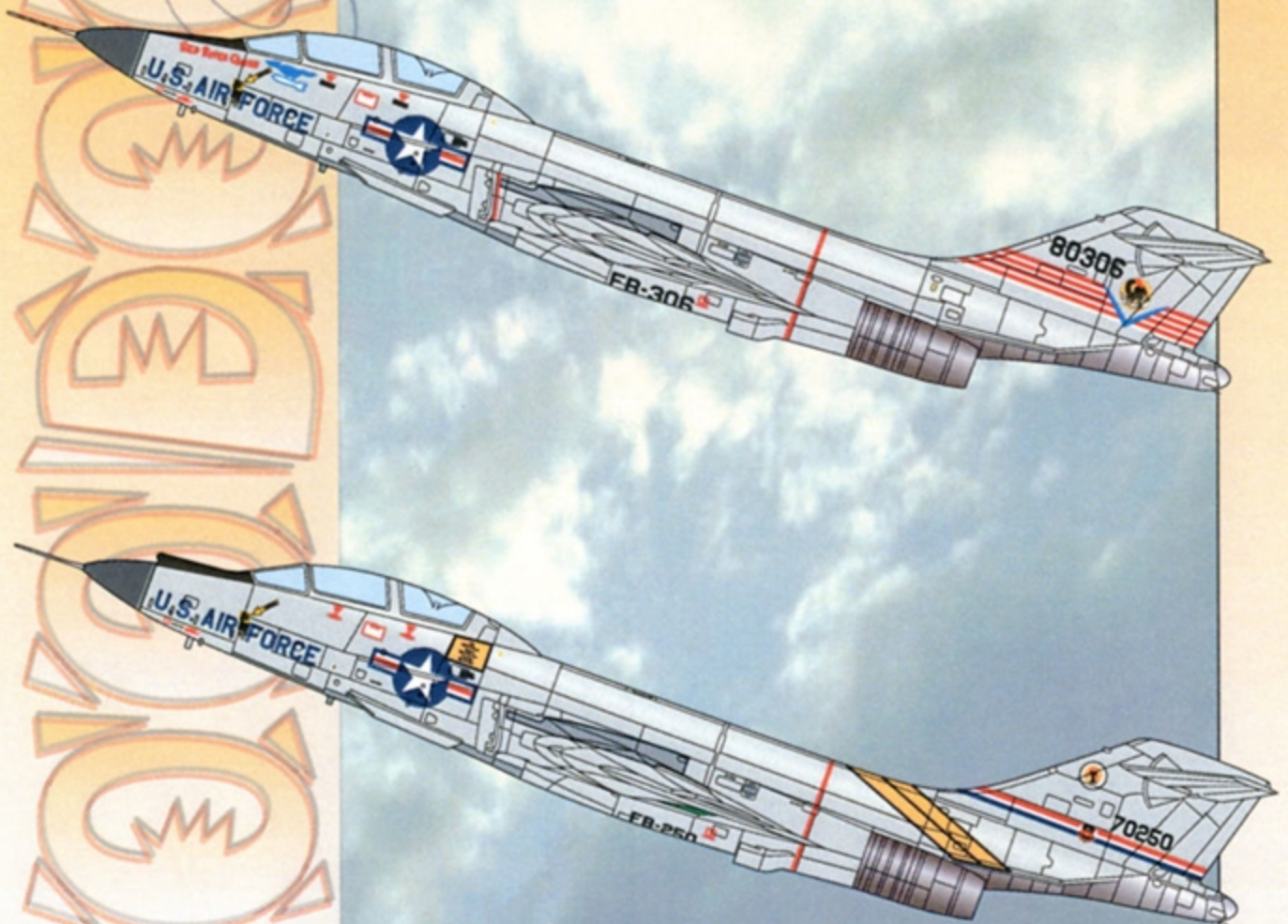

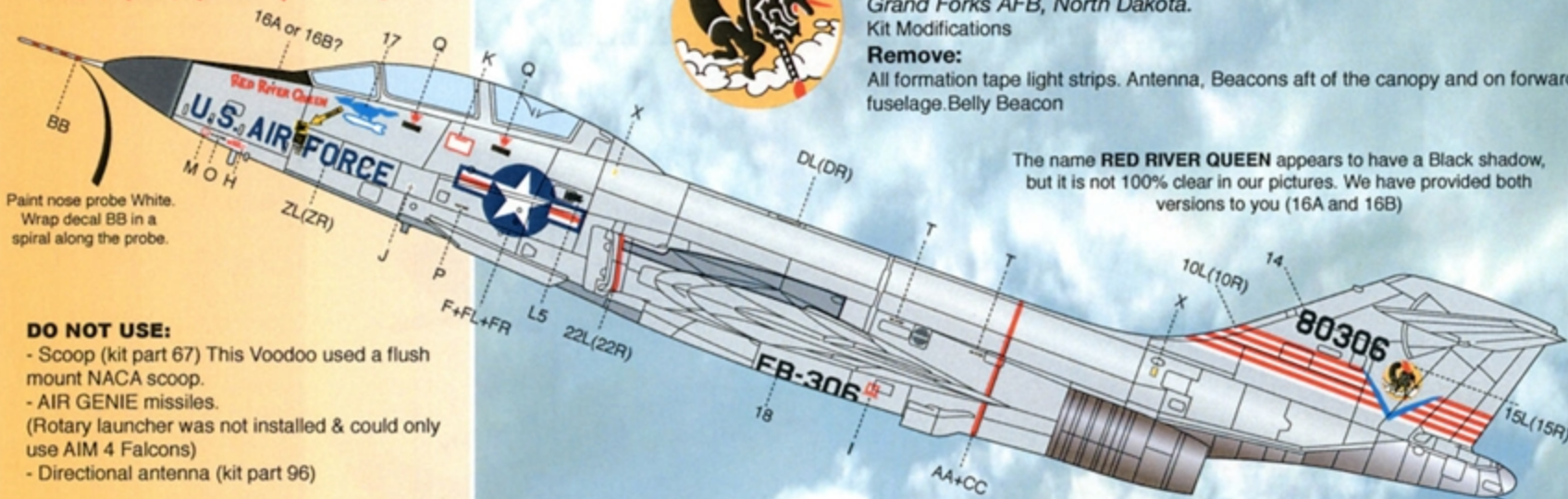


Suggested Kit: Monogram - 1:48 F-101 Voodoo.



VOODOO *Flight* 48244

AIRCRAFT #1



Paint nose probe White.
Wrap decal BB in a spiral along the probe.

DO NOT USE:

- Scoop (kit part 67) This Voodoo used a flush mount NACA scoop.
- AIR GENIE missiles. (Rotary launcher was not installed & could only use AIM 4 Falcons)
- Directional antenna (kit part 96)

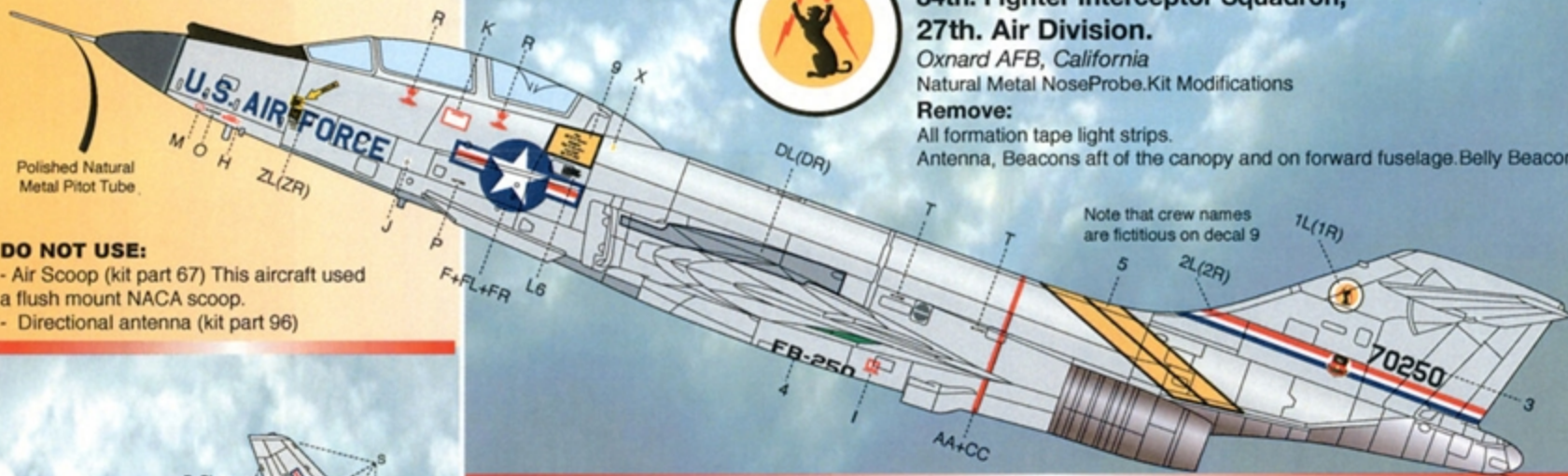
Kit Modifications

Remove:

All formation tape light strips. Antenna, Beacons aft of the canopy and on forward fuselage. Belly Beacon

The name **RED RIVER QUEEN** appears to have a Black shadow, but it is not 100% clear in our pictures. We have provided both versions to you (16A and 16B)

Polished Natural Metal Pitot Tube

DO NOT USE:

- Air Scoop (kit part 67) This aircraft used a flush mount NACA scoop.
- Directional antenna (kit part 96)

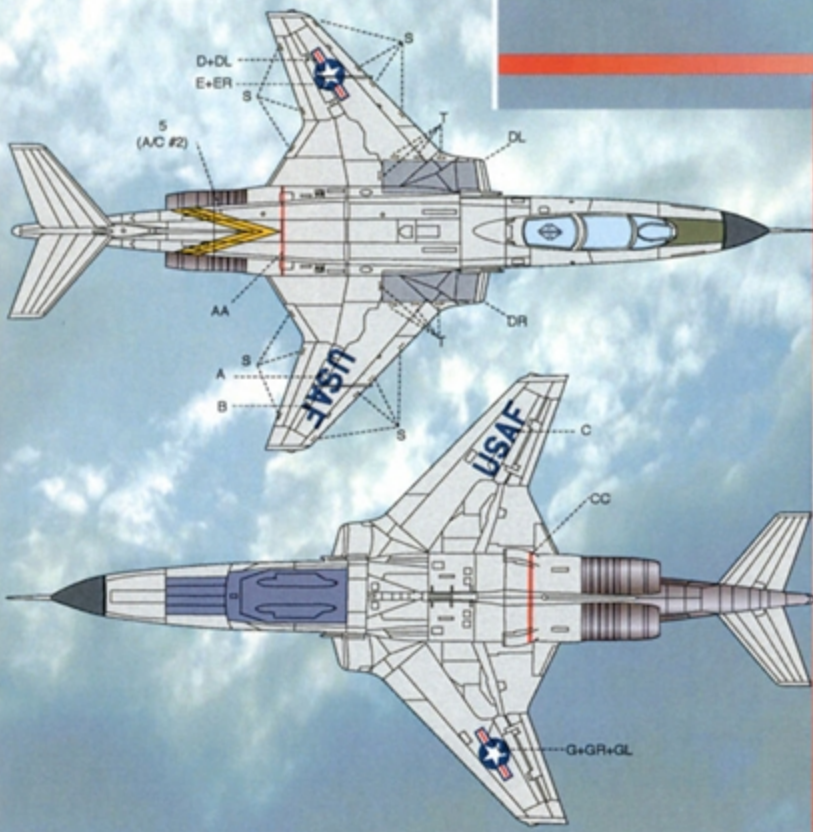

Natural Metal NoseProbe.Kit Modifications

Remove:

All formation tape light strips. Antenna, Beacons aft of the canopy and on forward fuselage. Belly Beacon

Note that crew names are fictitious on decal 9

Recommended Kit:

1. Monogram - 1:48 F-101 Voodoo

Decaling:

Apply decals only to a glossy and smooth surface. Place decal 5 before glueing the air brakes. Place Air Brakes on the cavity, apply decal 5 and with a new #11 blade, cut along the edge. Perfect fit everytime.

48244 Voodoo Flight

Overall ADC Aircraft Gray (FS 16473). Black radomes and antiglare panel for both a/c. Burnt Titanium afterburning areas of the engine and lower rear fuselage following the panel lines. Gloss Dark Gray area from nose gear doors to aft of weapons bay area. Lt. Gray or Aluminum nose probes for a/c 2 and White/Red barber pole for a/c 1.

General Notes About Voodoos

Stencils are applied to both sides of the fuselage unless only one set is provided. Only those stencils visible in our photos have been reproduced for you. If they are not visible, you

don't want them anyway. Use only those stencils shown in your profiles, other stencils may be for the other machine featured in your set.

Although an older kit, Monogram's F-101B represents the best technology available to us modelers in the 1970's. A very large and worthwhile kit, it belongs into any modern A/C collection and will show the relative size of these Century A/C when compared with some current designs like F-5's, Mirages and MiG's. Just spending an hour or so removing and re-engraving the panel lines will bring this bird to a standard equivalent to most contemporary kits in the market today. This kit is available in the US and we believe in most good hobby shops worldwide, and from mail order houses.

Try it, you will like the results.
