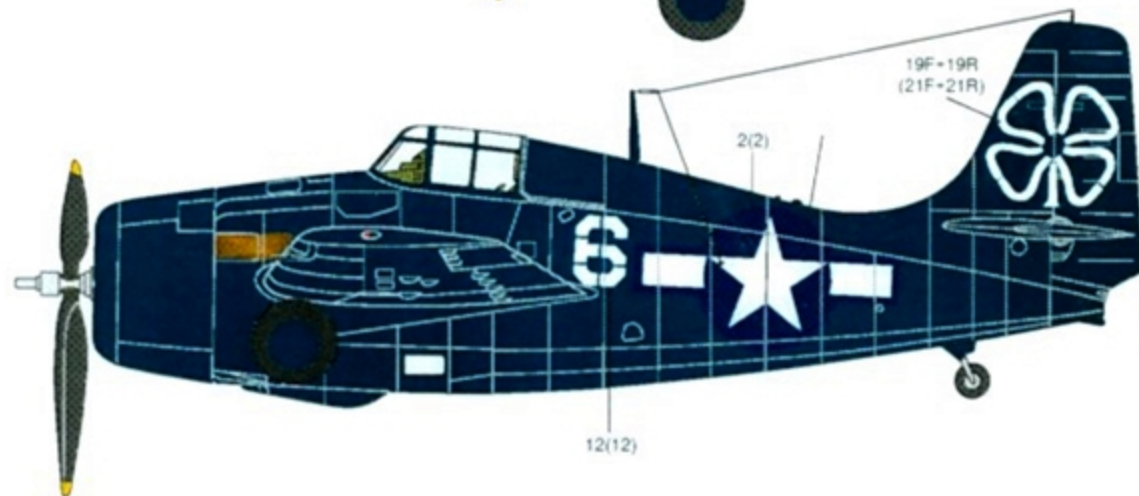

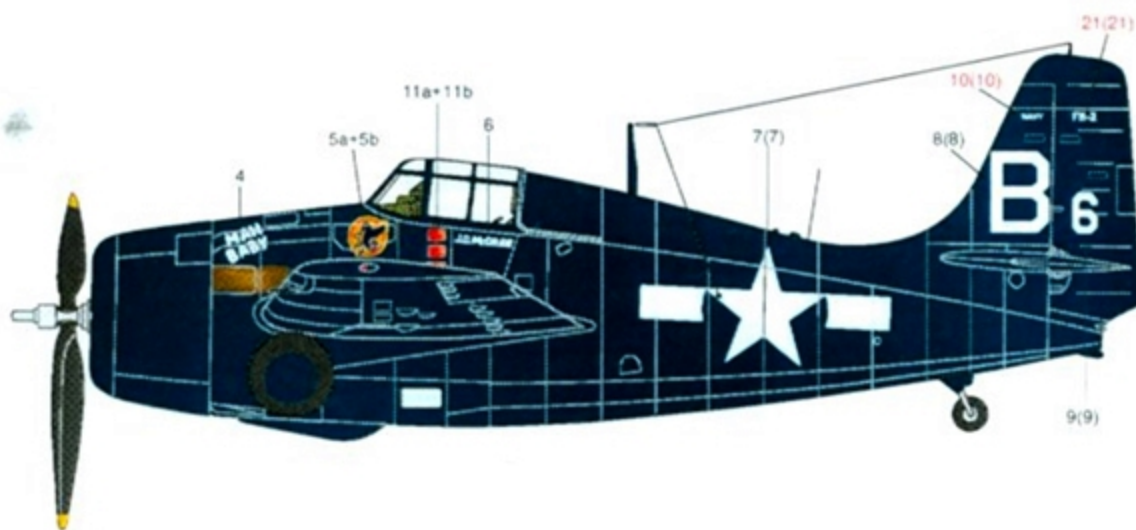

GM FM-2, of VC-96, U.S.S. Rudyerd Bay, April 1945. Overall Gloss Sea Blue with white geometric signs on vertical stab/rudder. Very typical escort carrier aircraft. Stars in four positions. Prop hub in natural metal.



GM FM-2 belonging to VC-93 aboard U.S.S. Petrol Bay, June 1945. Sea Blue Gloss with White carrier markings on vertical stab/rudder and upper right wing. Stars in four positions prop hub in natural metal.



Items #10 and #21 are shown on A/C #3 only, but may apply to all.

GM FM-2 nick named "MAH BABY" flown by Lt. Bruce Allen McGraw off U.S.S. Gambier Bay, October 1944. Colors and markings as A/C 1 and 2.
