#### Cripes A' Mighty

This jet was painted to commemorate the last ever reunion of the 352nd Fighter Group.

Cripes A' Mighty was the famous P-51 that was flown by Maj. George Fredly in WWII. Maj. Fredly ended up being the top Mustang Ace of the war with 26.83 confirmed kills.

Maj. Fredly was killed on Christmas day in 1944 while chasing a FW-190 at tree-top level for his third kill of the day. Ironically he was hit by friendly ground fire.

The 149th Fighter Squadron of the 102nd Fighter Wing of the VA ANG owes its lineage to the fine aviators of the "Bivenosed Bastards of Bodney."
