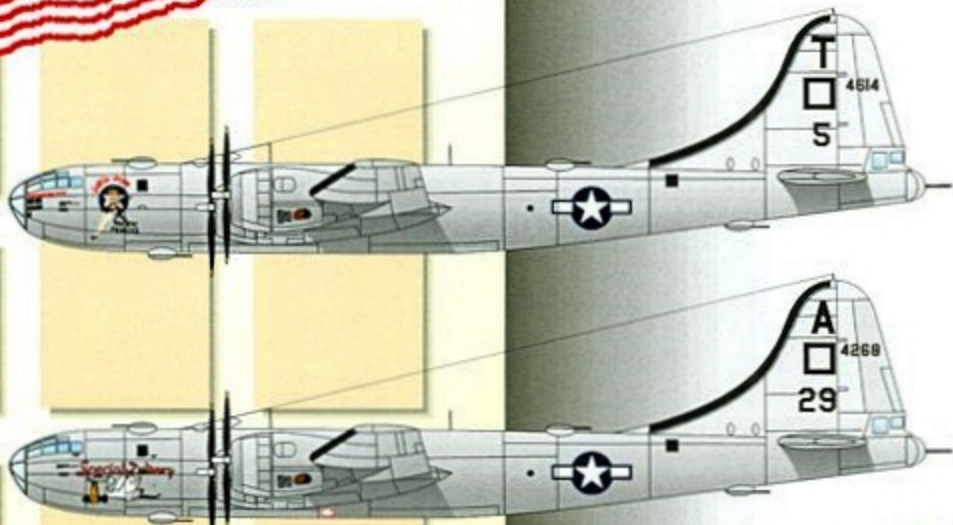

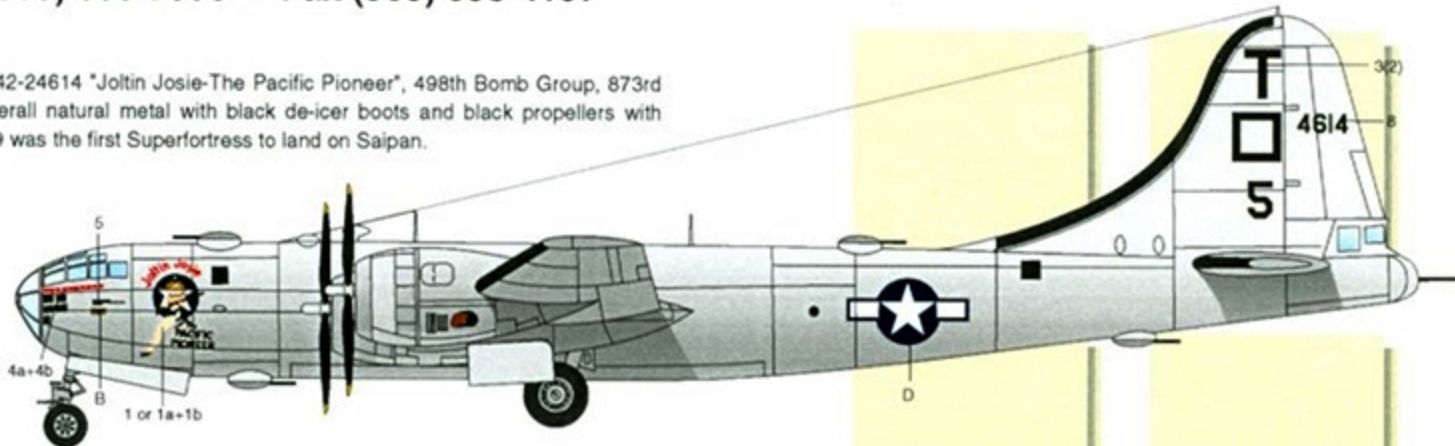

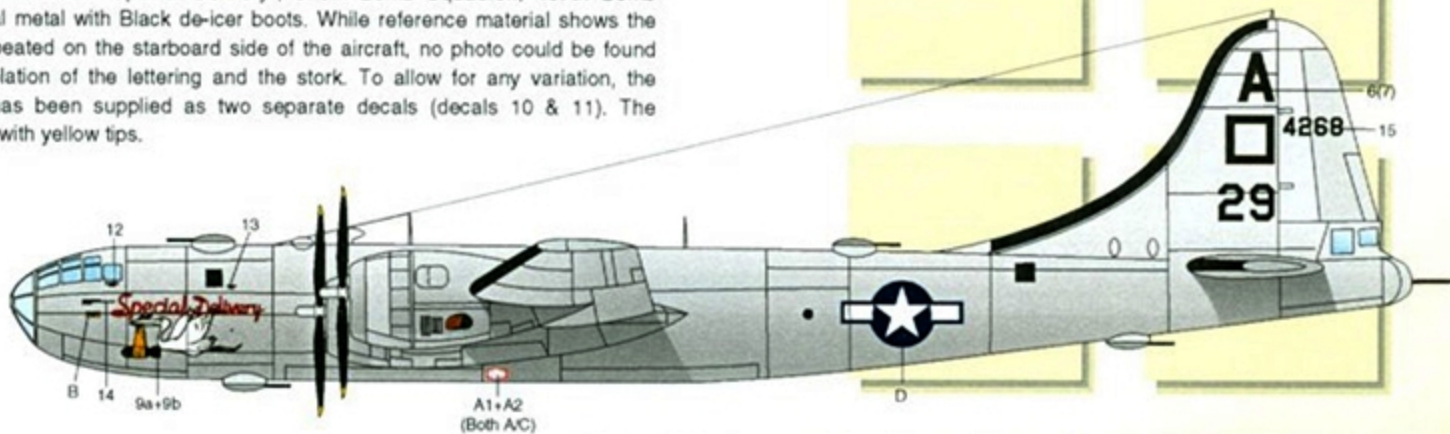

Pacific Superfortresses Pt II

B-29 Serial Number 42-24614 "Joltin Josie-The Pacific Pioneer", 498th Bomb Group, 873rd Bomb Squadron. Overall natural metal with black de-icer boots and black propellers with yellow tips. This B-29 was the first Superfortress to land on Saipan.



B-29 Serial Number 42-24628 "Special Delivery", 870th Bomb Squadron, 497th Bomb Group. Overall natural metal with Black de-icer boots. While reference material shows the nose art as being repeated on the starboard side of the aircraft, no photo could be found showing the exact relation of the lettering and the stork. To allow for any variation, the starboard nose art has been supplied as two separate decals (decals 10 & 11). The propellers were black with yellow tips.
