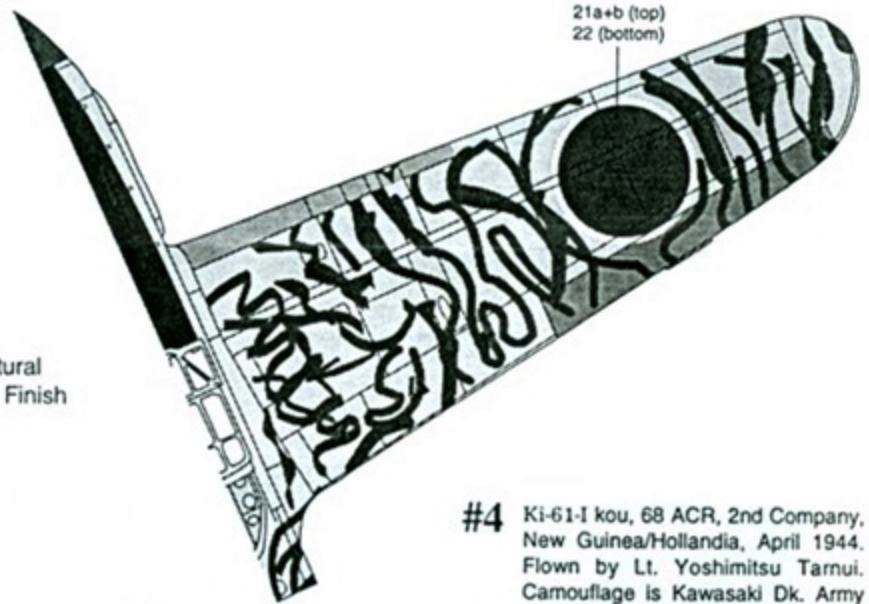

#1 Ki-61-I Tei, 23 Independent Co., April 1945. Okinawa. Dark Army Green with natural metal under surfaces. Note: stencil placement is shown on this aircraft only, but applies to all A/C.



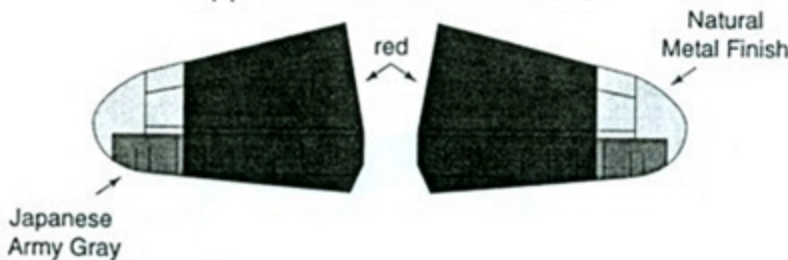
#2 Ki-61-I-OTSU. This plane is said to have belonged to 59 ACR, 3rd Company commander, possibly a Kamikaze Special Attack Unit. Overall natural metal finish. Paint wing bands white before applying hinomarus. Note: 2/3 of horizontal stab. is red (see left side of page). Found in Fukuoka (Ashiya) AB, November 1945. Note: Landing gear covers could have been Red-Brown primer

#3 Ki-61-I Tei, 55 ACR, August 1945. Itami AB. Overall Dark Army Green with natural metal under surfaces.



#4 Ki-61-I kōu, 68 ACR, 2nd Company, New Guinea/Hollandia, April 1944. Flown by Lt. Yoshimitsu Tarnui. Camouflage is Kawasaki Dk. Army Green randomly applied over natural metal upper surfaces, resembling foliage or palm tree leaves.

#2 Upper Horizontal Stabilizers



Note: All NMF Tonys had the fabric covered control surfaces (ailerons, rudder, elevators) painted light gray/green. If A/C was painted, the corresponding part would also be painted the new color.
