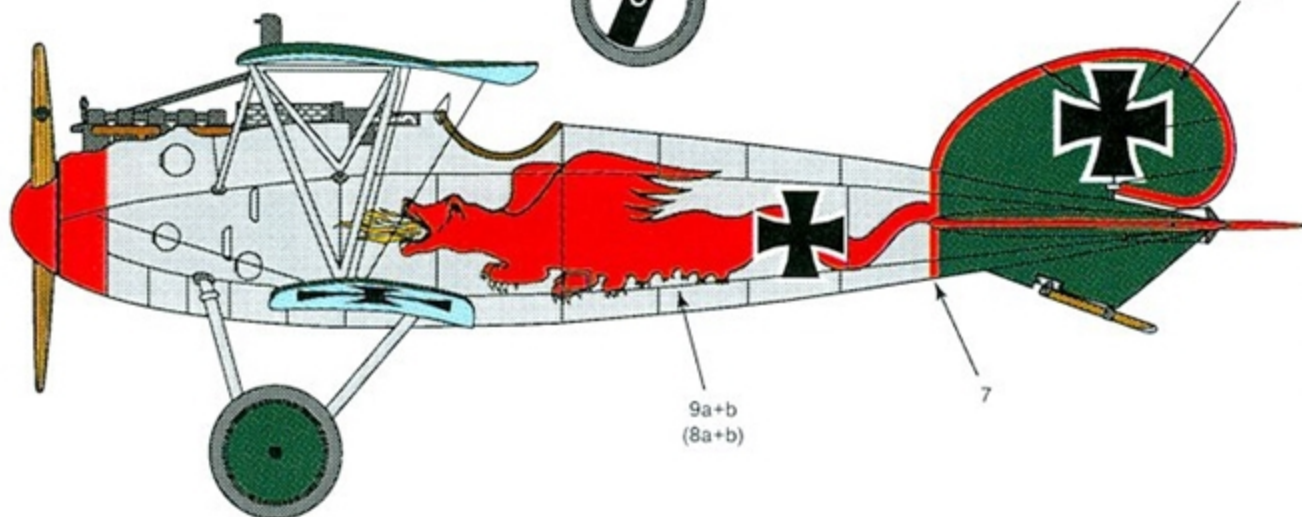
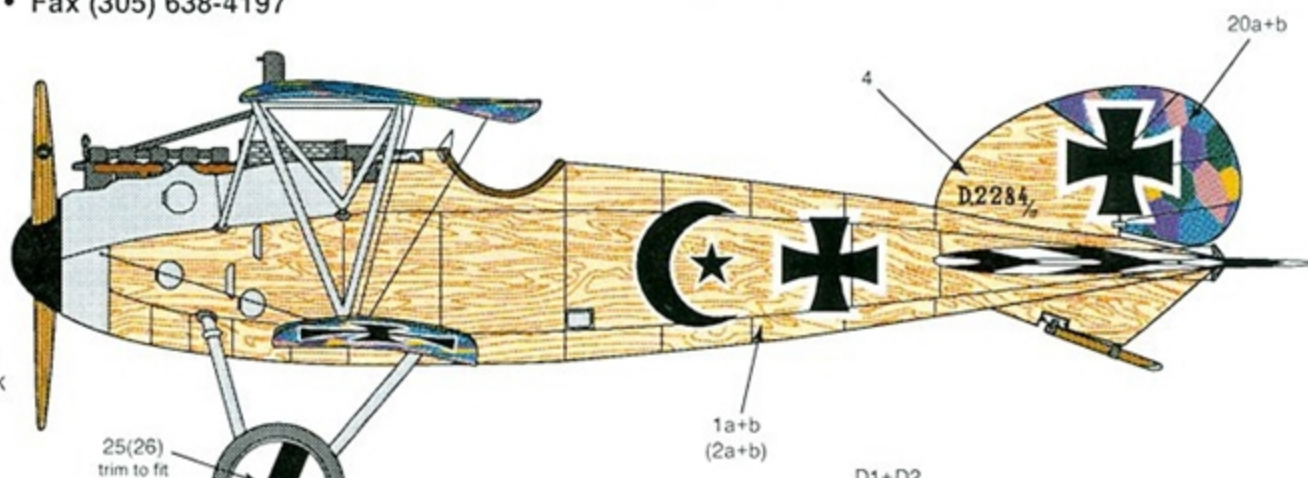

Jasta 37, 1917, flown by Lt. Hans Waldhausen. Clear varnished plywood fuselage. Wings covered with 4 or 5 color lozenge camouflage fabric. Rudder covered with under surface lozenge camouflage fabric. Light gray struts and metal panels. Black spinner, black and white wheel covers.

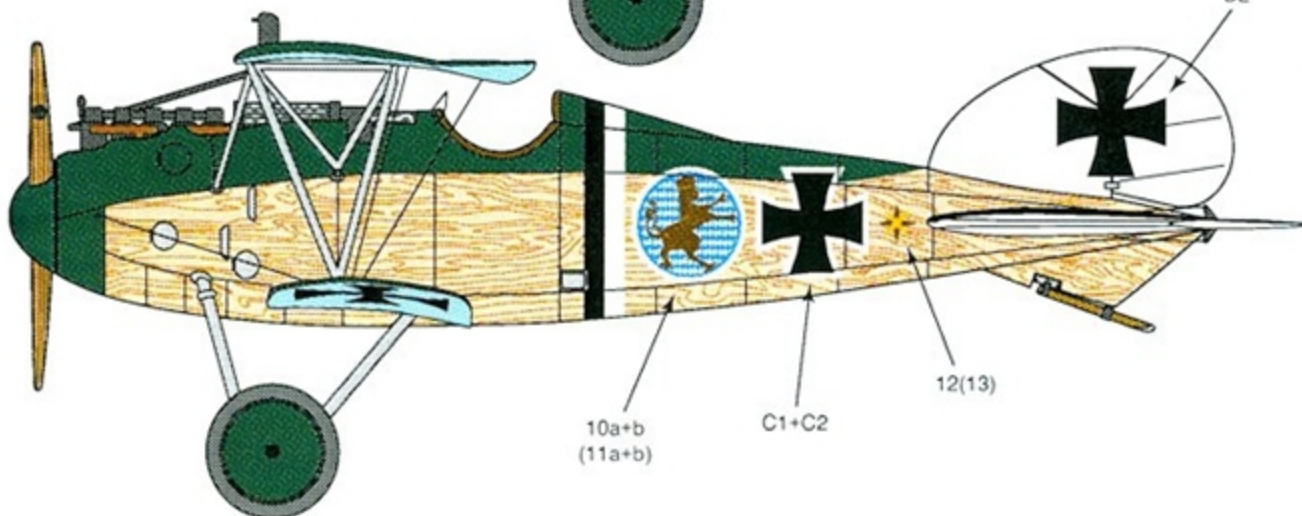
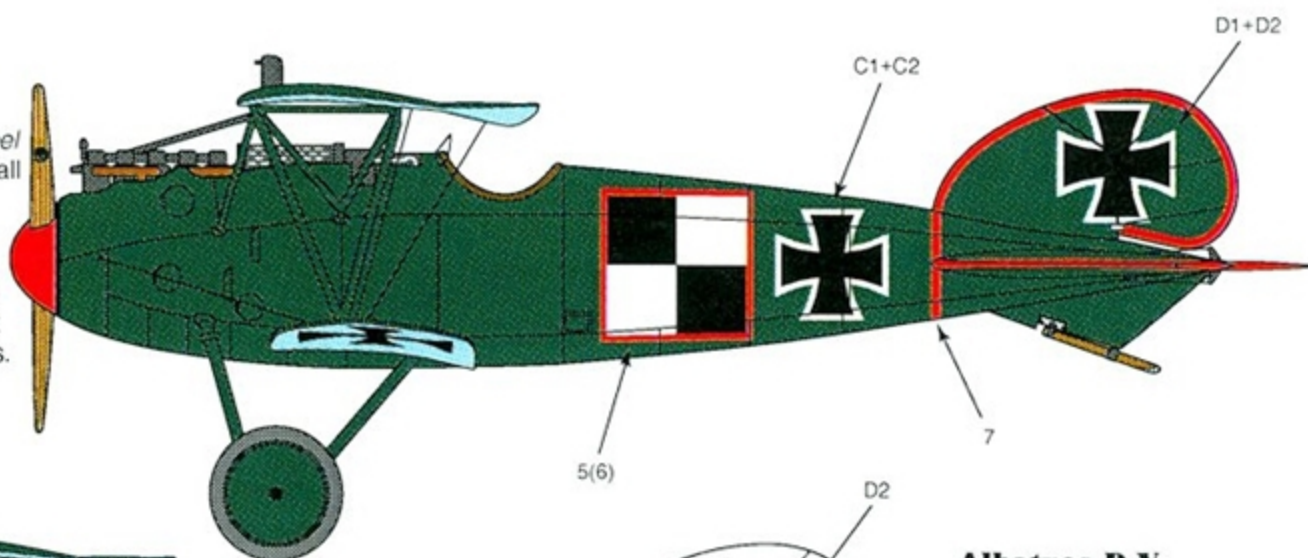


Albatros D.V

Jasta 5, flown by Lt. Hans Joachim von Hippel. Fuselage overall light gray. Dark green and mauve camouflage on upper surfaces of both wings, with light blue under surfaces. Tail dark green with red trim. Light gray struts. Red forward cowl and spinner. Wheel covers dark green.

Jasta 5, flown by *Vizefeldwebel* Otto Könneke. Fuselage overall dark green. Dark green and mauve camouflage on upper surfaces of both wings, with light blue under surfaces. Tail dark green with red trim. Dark green wheel covers and struts. Red spinner.

Jasta 21, 1917, flown by Hpt. Eduard von Ritter Schleich, C.O. of *Jasta 21*. Clear varnished plywood fuselage. Dark green forward cowl, fuselage decking, spinner and wheel covers. Dark green and mauve camouflage on upper surfaces of both wings, with light blue under surfaces. Light gray struts and metal panels. Fin and rudder white.

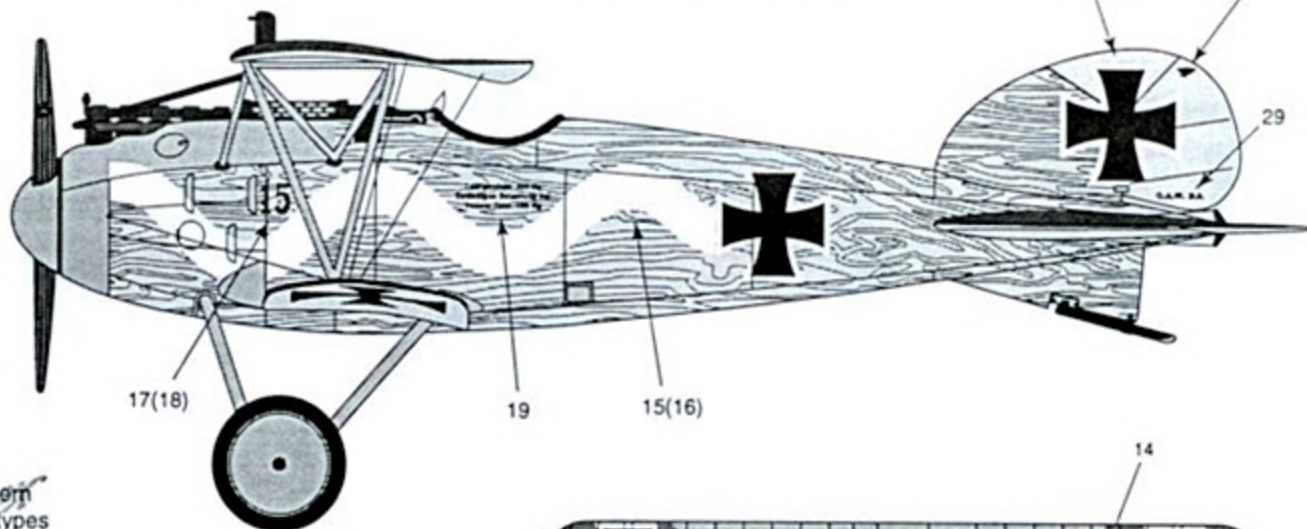

Jasta 10, 1917. Clear varnished plywood fuselage. Dark green and mauve camouflage on upper surfaces of both wings, with light blue under surfaces. Yellow forward cowl and spinner. Clear doped rudder. Light gray struts, wheel covers and metal panels.
