RVD band: Red. Yellow 11 and II. Gruppe bar with Black outline. Yellow undercowling.
Black spinner/White spiral. JG 1 "Oesau" emblem on the port side of motor cowling. Cowl ring very light color.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 74 Gray Green.
RVD band: Red. Yellow 5 and II. Gruppe bar with Black outline. Yellow undercowling.
Black spinner/White spiral. JG 1 "Oesau" emblem on the port side of motor cowling. Cowl ring dark.

Fw. Geise killed in this machine 8 February 1944 attacking bombers.

RVD band: Red. Yellow 6 outlined in Black. Black/White striped cowl with JG 1 "Oesau" emblem on port side.
Spinner and undercowling Yellow (provisional). Stripes for 48th scale designed to fit Tamiya F-8 cowl; stripes for 72nd scale designed to fit Hasegawa A-8 cowl. Extra stripes are included to fit other available 48th and 72nd Fw 190 kits - may require trimming.

RVD band: Red. Black 3 outlined with Red. Black/White striped cowl with JG 1 "Oesau" emblem on port side. Red spinner.
Undercowling Yellow (Provisional) Stripes for 48th scale designed to fit Tamiya F-8 cowl; stripes for 72nd scale designed to fit Hasegawa A-8 cowl. Extra stripes are included to fit other available 48th and 72nd Fw 190 kits - may require trimming.
