## NORTH AMERICAN MUSTANG MK 2 Single seat fighter reconnaissance 1:72 scale

The original Mustangs were designed and built by North American Aviation of California to satisfy R.A.F. requirements. The prototype first flew in September 1940 and deliveries of production planes to Britain started in October 1941, Their first operations were in July 1942 when they were engaged ross-channel sweeps, taking photographs and attacking ground targets. Later Mustangs fitted with Packard-built Merlin engines were employed in large numbers escorting U.S.A.A.F. daylight bombing missions over Germany, Engine: 1,120 h.p. Allison V-1710-81. Max. speed: 390 m.p.h. at 8,000 ft. Service ceiling: 32,000 ft. Armament: four 0.50 guns and four 0.30 guns.

To complete the aircraft as illustrated, you will need model aircraft paint. A display stand is not supplied with this model.






Caution


Polystyrene cement is highly inflammable. Keep away from naked flame, and also from the face particularly the eyes and nose – and from clothing. Use pin to open tube and replace after use. Use sparingly.

Instructions Test assembly position and fit of parts before cementing. Assemble in sequence shown i.e. A.B.C.D. etc., Note that the part numbers needed for each step are listed in the recommended assembly sequence.
















