Replacement aircraft later in the war



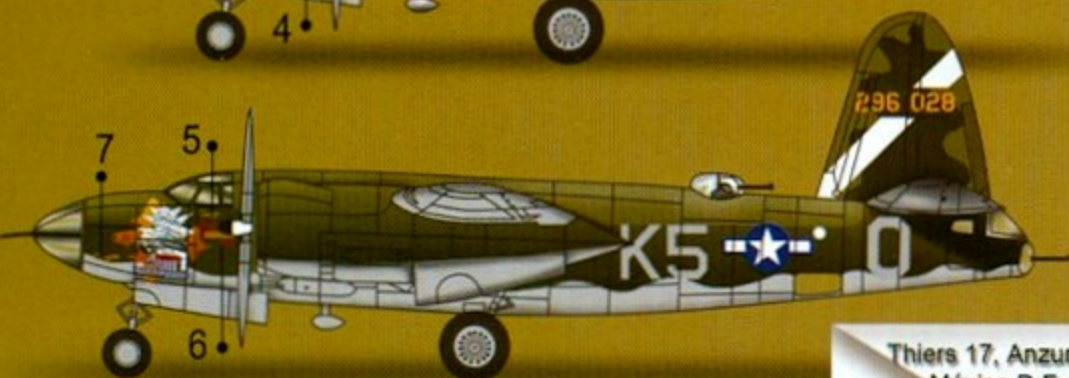
42-96026 B-26B-50MA K5*B "Victory Reed 75 missions before being replaced with Victory Read II 42-96301. Aircraft 42-96026 went on to fly more missions without the pilot's armor and nose art.



42-96077 B-26B-55MA K5*F "Ladies Delight" completed 65 missions before crash landing at Laon/Athies, France on Dec. 2 1944 after being shot up. Through July of 1944 "Ladies Delight" was flown by Lt. George Backes



42-96072 B-26B-55MA K5*C "Dina Might" 95 plus missions, later it's nose art which was painted on the pilot's armor plate was removed and placed on another aircraft as was "Victory Read"



42-96028 B-26B-50MA K5*O "Faith Prelude To Victory" voted as the best nose art carried on a medium bomber in England. This aircraft later was assigned to the 17BG.
