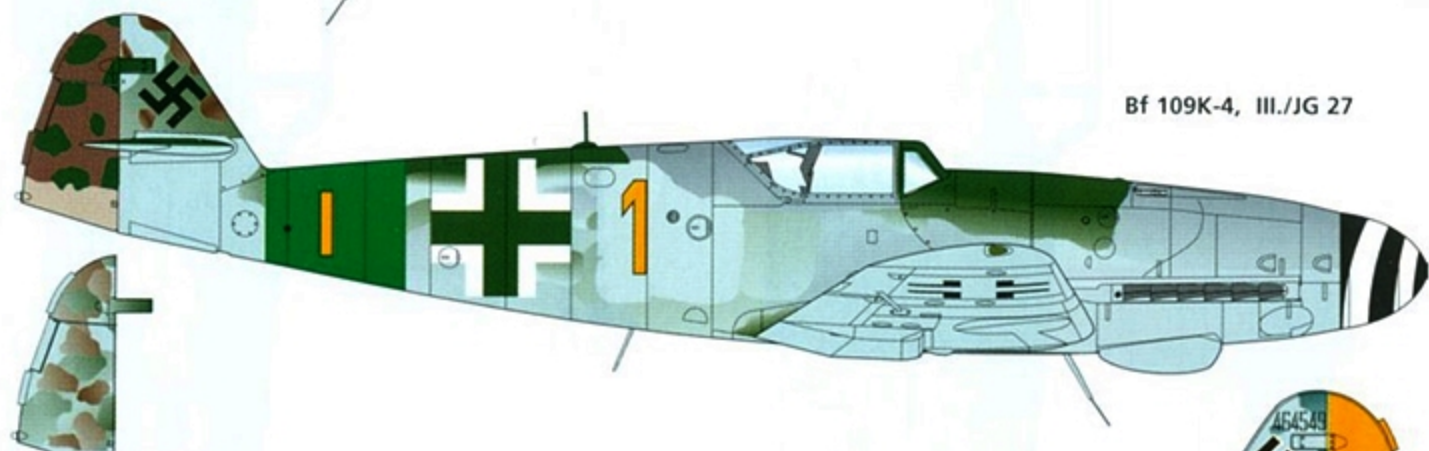

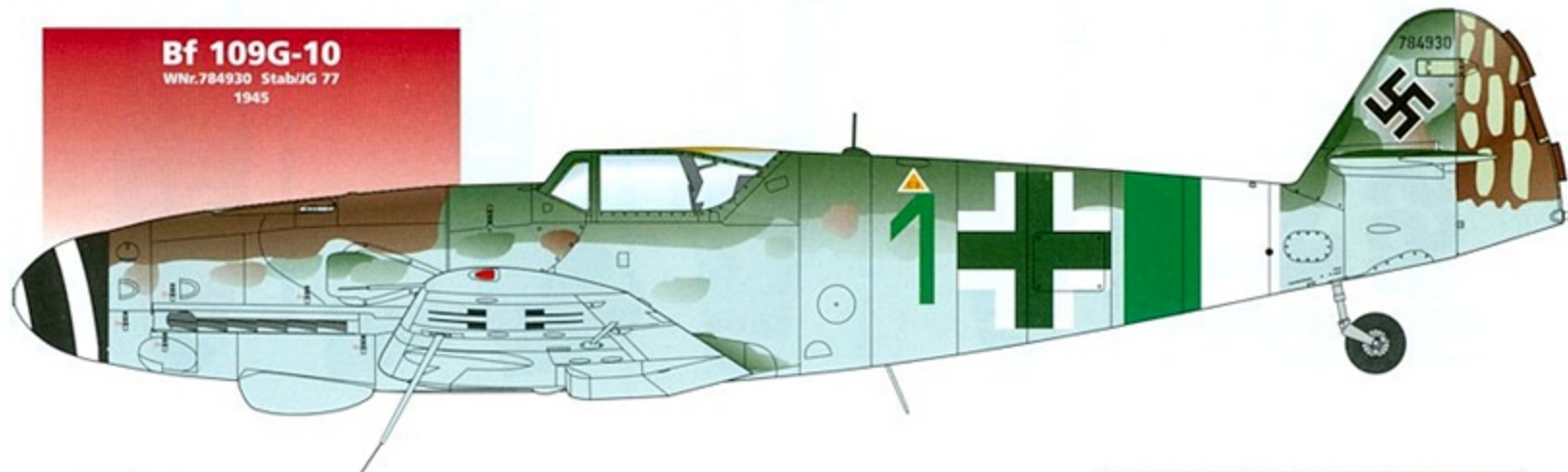

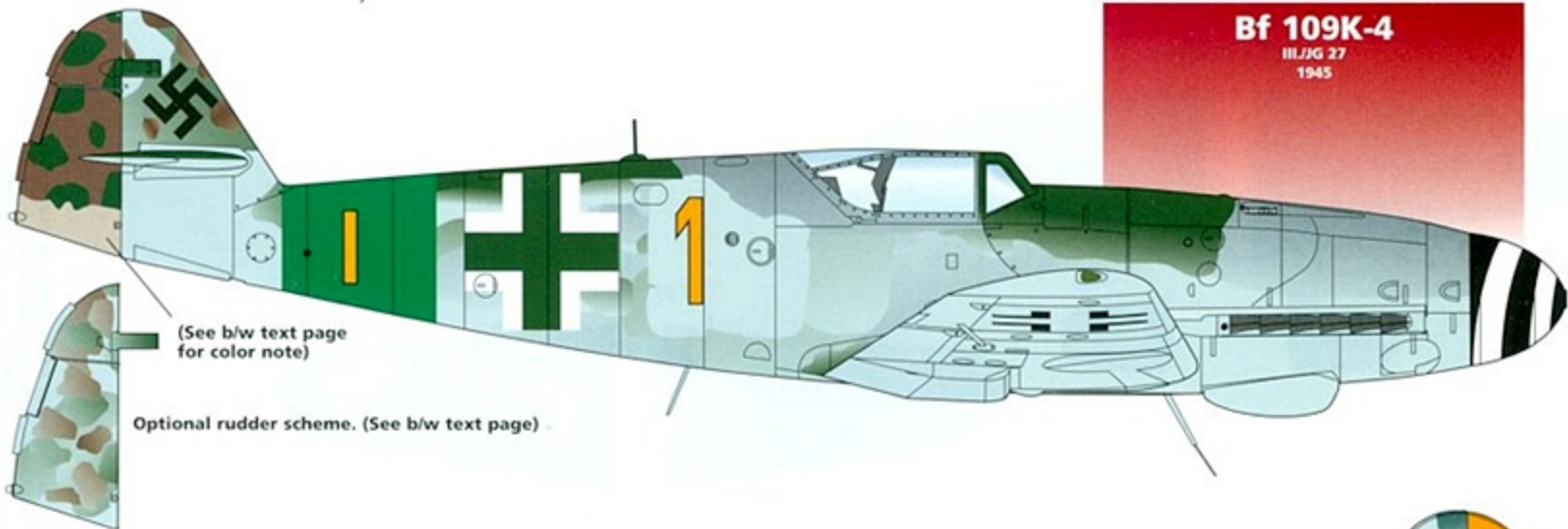

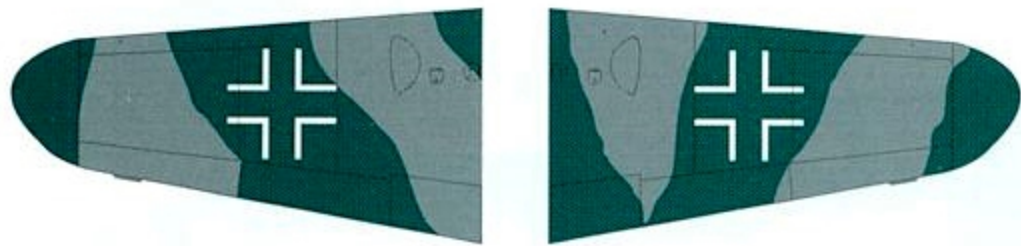

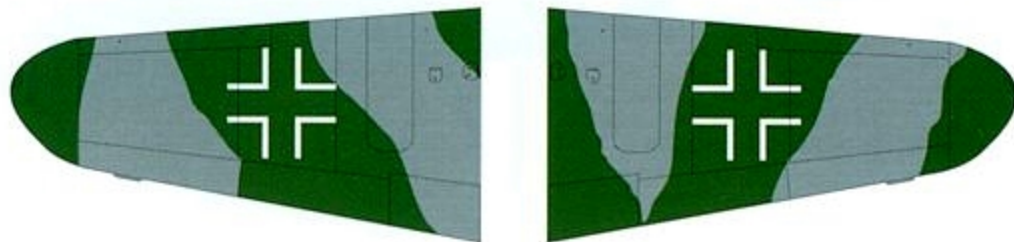

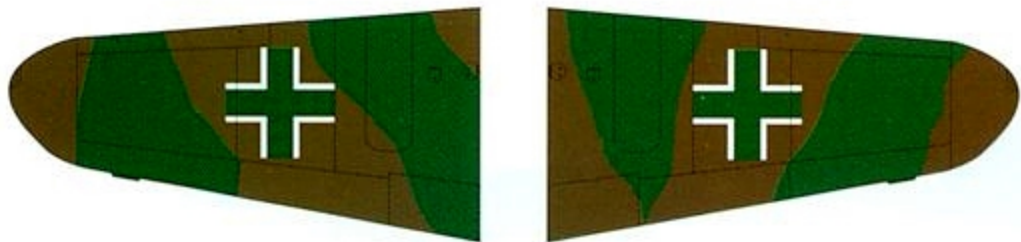
A/C #1 'Yellow 2'



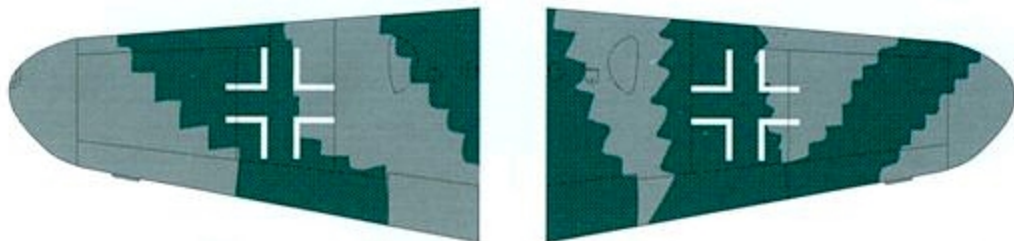
A/C #3 'Yellow 1'
