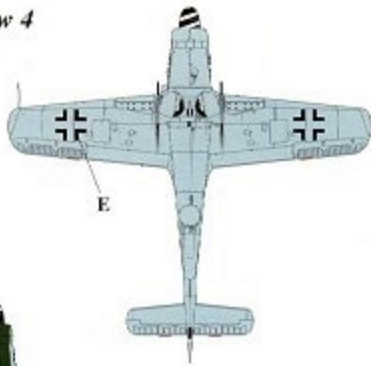
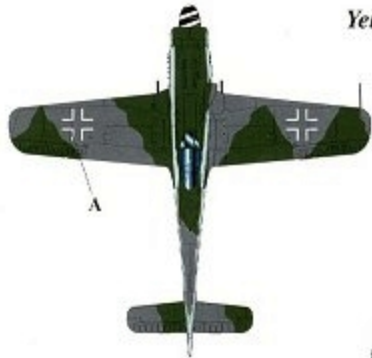

"White 10" Fw 190 D-9 W. Nr. not known Pilot: Possibly Fw. Rennack or Ofw. Strathbücker II/ NAG 6 21 April 1945 Schleswig Germany
Fw. Rennack and Ofw. Strathbücker of 5./JG 26 were transferred to II./NAG 6 at Leck with their machines and mechanics on 21 April 1945. This is probably one of those D-9's.

Spinner: Black/White spiral Prop Blades: 70 Black Green Lower gear door 83 Dark Green or 75 Gray Violet.
National Markings: Fuselage: B4 800 mm Black crosses, Hakenkreuz 420 mm
Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - 900 mm solid Black crosses
Stencilling: Factory standard.

"Brown 9" Fw 190 D-9 W. Nr. not known Pilot: Unknown, possibly Lt. Siegfried Sy 7./JG 26 (II. Gruppe) Feb 1945 Nordhorn Germany
Early Canopy with pulley; no loop antenna; "Brown 9" and II. Gruppe bar faded Brown

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 82 Bright Green, 83 Dark Green, Mottled 82/83.
Spinner: Black/White spiral typical 7. Staffel Prop Blades: 70 Black Green ETC 504: Dark Gray RVD bands: Black/White
Latch buttons: Red Black exhaust panel
National Markings: Fuselage: B4 800 mm Black crosses; Hakenkreuz H3 420 mm
Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B4 900 mm Black crosses
Stencilling: Moderate stencilling, Yellow octane B4 triangle.

"Yellow 4" Fw 190 D-9 W. Nr. not known Pilot: Gefr. Werner Merz 11./JG 54 (III. Gruppe) Fall 1944 Oldenburg Germany
Early canopy, no antenna pulley.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 83 Dark Green
Spinner: Black/White spiral Prop blades: 70 Black Green ETC 504: Dark Gray
Latch buttons: Red **BUMS:** White; Shamrock; Green, White trim Red/White stripped morane antenna
National Markings: Fuselage: B4 800 mm Black crosses, Hakenkreuz H3 420 mm possibly 530 mm
Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm, White crosses, Lower - B4 900 mm, Black crosses
Stencilling: Factory fresh standard

"Black 1" Fw 190 D-9 W. Nr. 210972 Pilot: Fw. Gerhard Müller-Berneck 5./JG 26 (II. Gruppe) 5 May 1945 Lister Norway
Closed lift hole rear fuselage. Machine belonged to the 6./JG 26.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 83 Dark Green, Fuselage & tail mottled 75/83
Spinner: Black/White spiral Prop blades: 70 Black Green ETC 504: Dark Gray
RVD bands: Black/White Latch buttons: Red Black exhaust panel
National Markings: Fuselage: B4 800 mm Black crosses, Hakenkreuz H3 420 mm Black
Wings: Upper - B6 910 mm White crosses, Lower - B4 900 mm Black crosses
Stencilling: Minimal: modeller's discretion. Large MW50 Yellow/White triangle, point down
Full *Keine Bombe!* stencilling on late cigar shaped drop tank.
