





Please Note - Painting propellers and wheel hubs

Aircraft 3 and 4 apparently had their propeller tips overpainted, with the outboard white stripe replaced by yellow, and the two inboard stripes painted over with fresh black paint.

Aircraft 1 and 5 likely had white wheels, but some aircraft have been documented having wheels with a natural metal finish.



AIRCRAFT 2 "Bad News" • A-1H, Serial #137609. 6th Special Operations Squadron, 14th Special Operations Wing, Pleiku, October 1962. SEA camouflage with Gray. Note non-standard armament placard color. AIRCRAFT 3 "Cool Fool" • A-1H, Serial #134551. Flown by Captain D. Miller, 1st Special Operations Squadron, 56th Special Operations Wing, Nakhon Phanom, 1970. SEA camouflage with black undersurfaces.

AIRCRAFT 4 "Bubbles 'n Bust" • A-1H, Serial #39778. 602nd Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, March 1970. SEA camouflage, underside overpainted black. Aircraft carried no national insignia. Note white cowl ring and mismatched cowl flaps. Aircraft was also fitted at one time with Green 34102 cowl ring and flaps. This aircraft carried no national insignias.
