




Seaffres at war. Pt. 1

885 Squadron, HMS Formidable, 'Operation Torch', November 1942. As a means of identifying allied aircraft over the beachhead, the standard RAF/FAA roundels were over-painted with a white star. Note also that MB156 carries a Fighter Command Sky fuselage band.

Seafire Mk.III PP979 D5-X

807 Squadron, HMS Hunter, British East Indies Fleet, Andaman Sea, May 1945. 807 Squadron carried out air cover for anti-shipping strikes with the Fleet in the Andaman Sea. Note the over-painting of ETO roundels with SEAC type and white ID bands to wings and tail (28 inch wide on wings (14.8mm to scale) and 18 inch on tail (9.5mm to scale).
