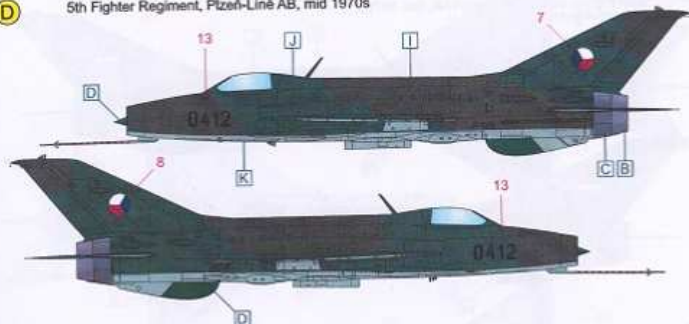
B MiG-21F-13 No. 23, Cuban Air Force, San Antonio de los Baños AB, 1963



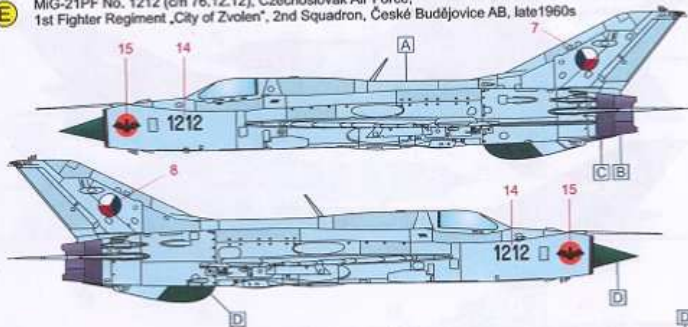

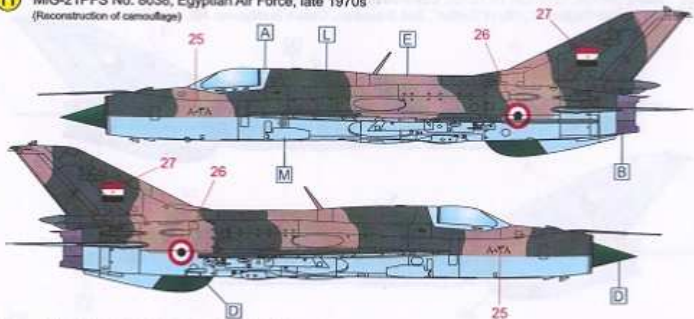

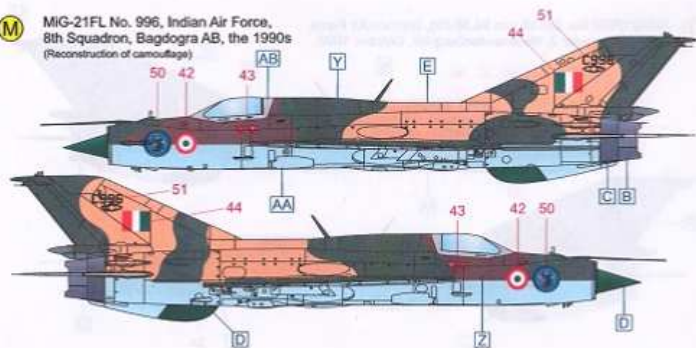
