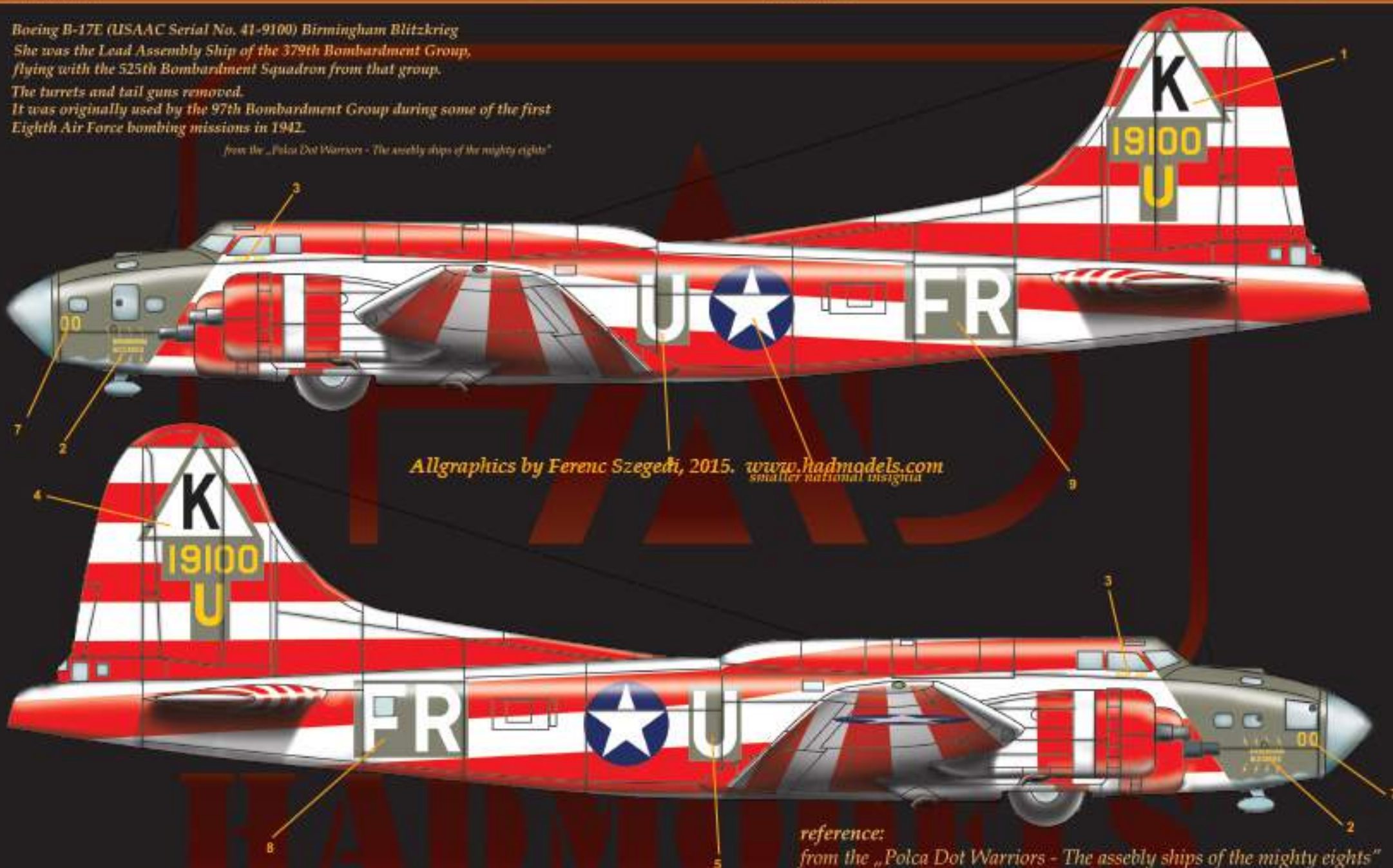


Boeing B-17E (USAAC Serial No. 41-9100) Birmingham Blitzkrieg

The turrets and tail guns removed.

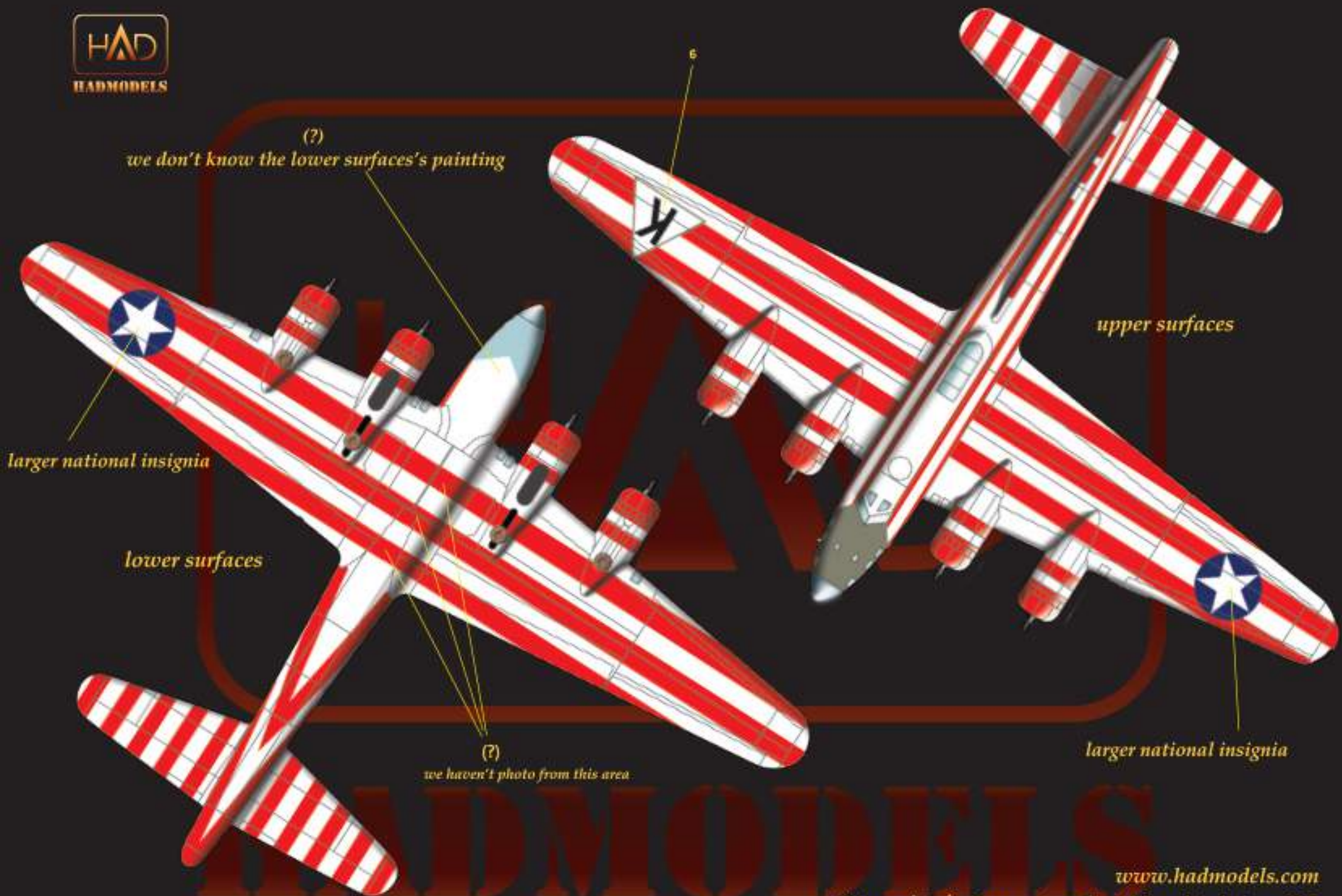
It was originally used by the 97th Bombardment Group during some of the first
