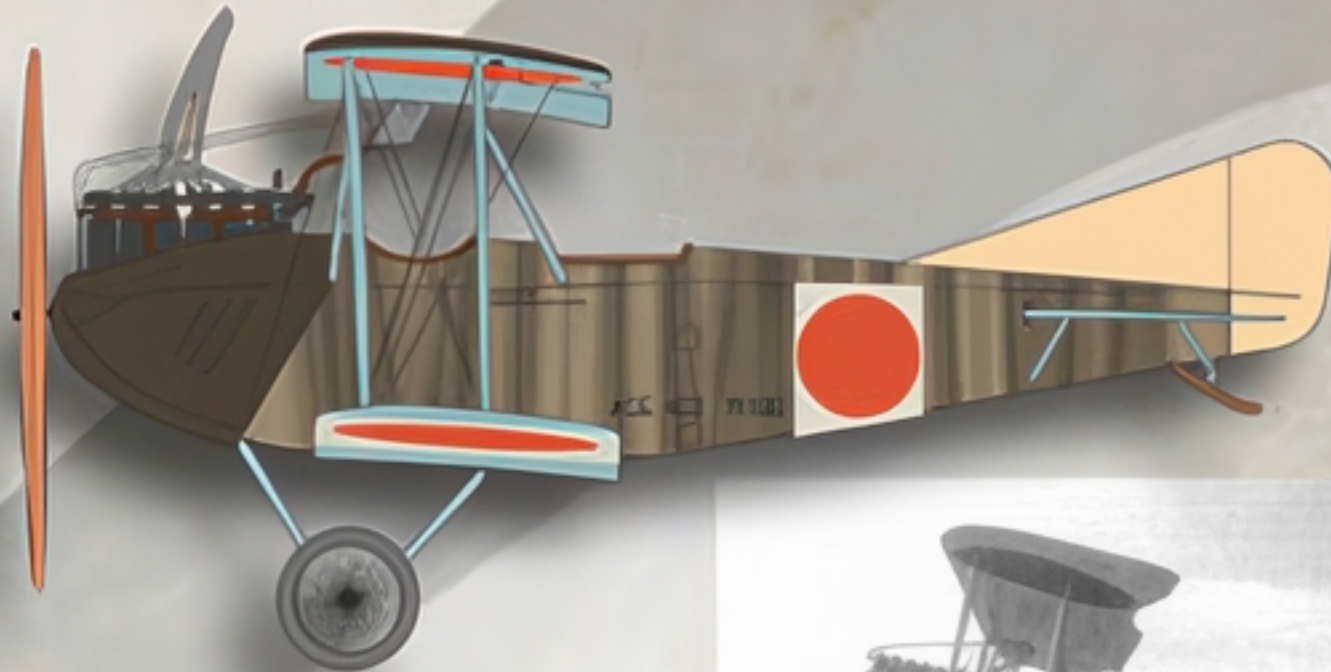

⑥ AEG C.IV trainer in postwar Netherlands service.



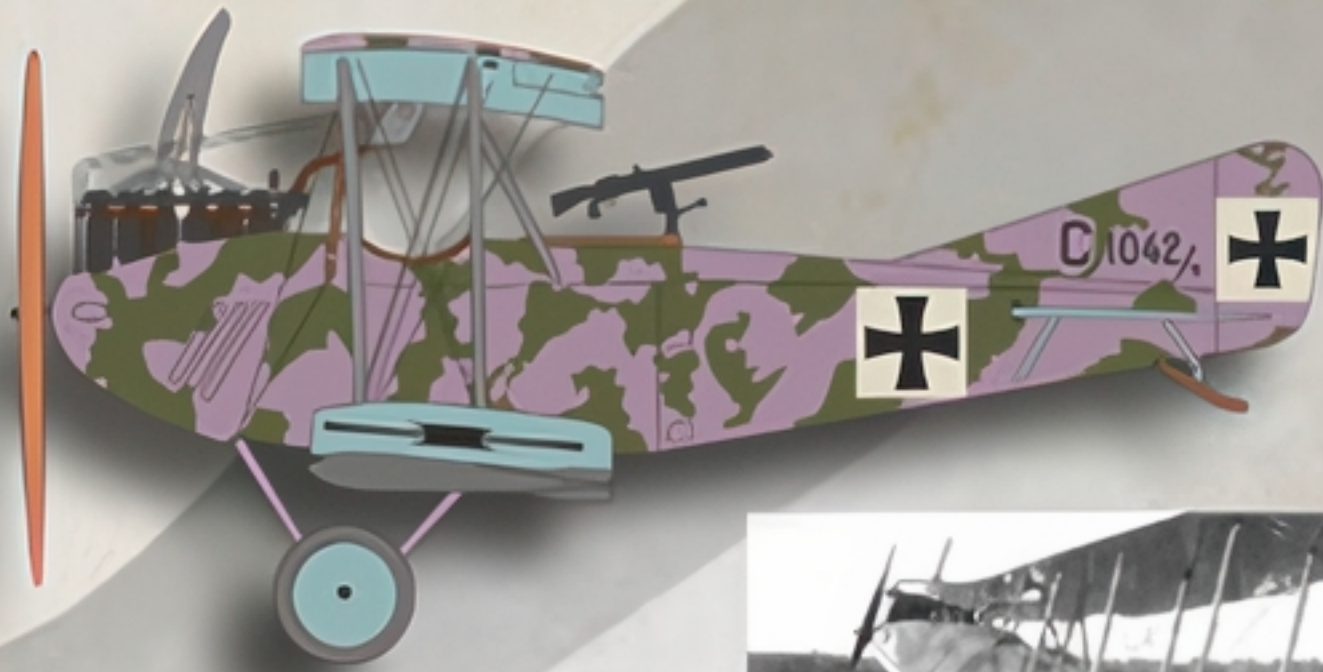
① AEG C.IV v.R C.7123/17. № CWL 5.3
