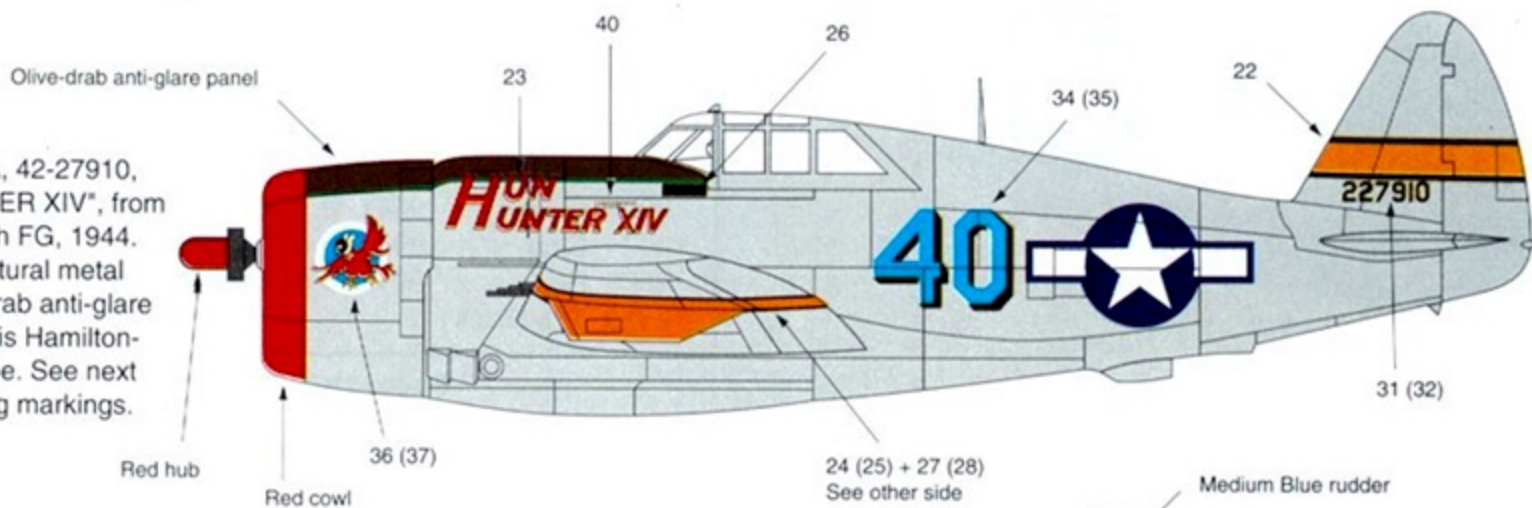

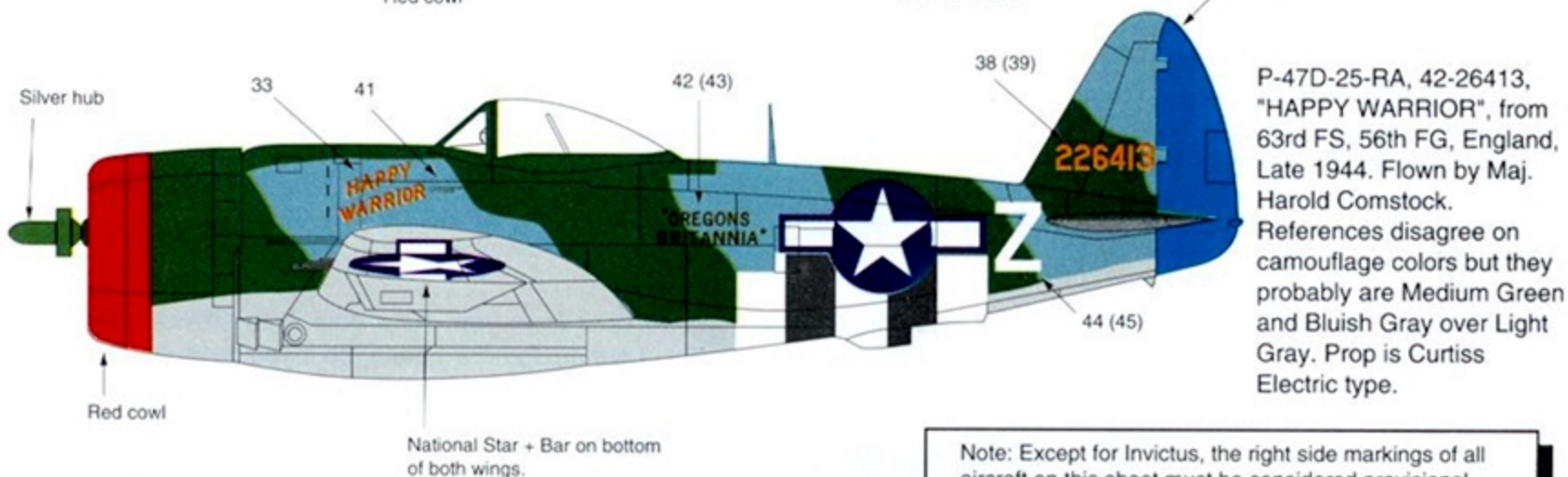
P-47D-27-RA, 42-26967

page for wing markings.



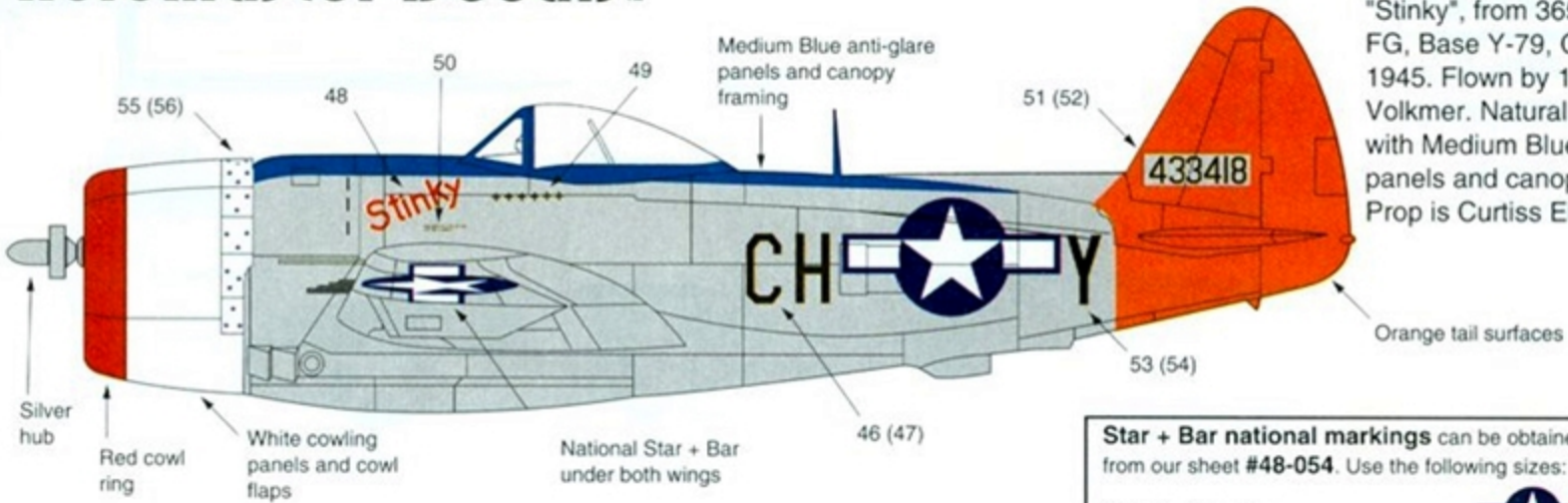
P-47D-25-RA, 42-26413,

Electric type.



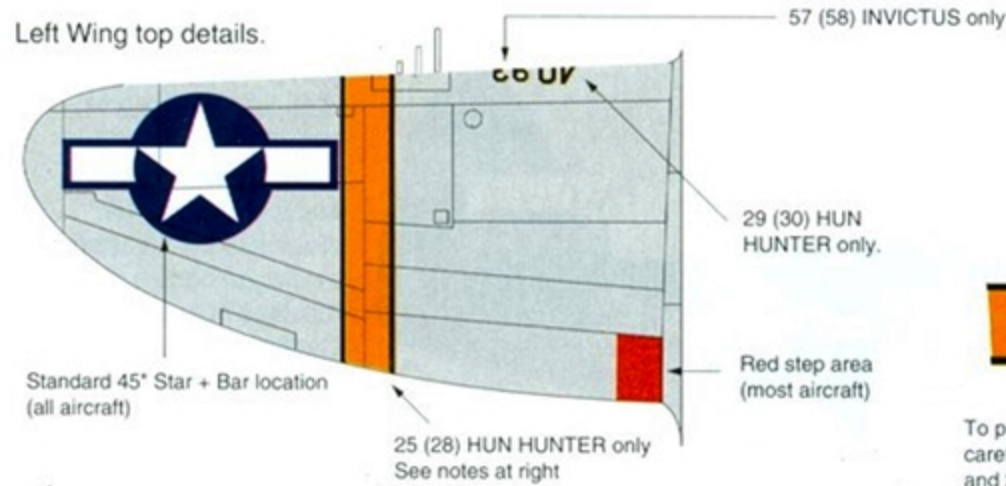

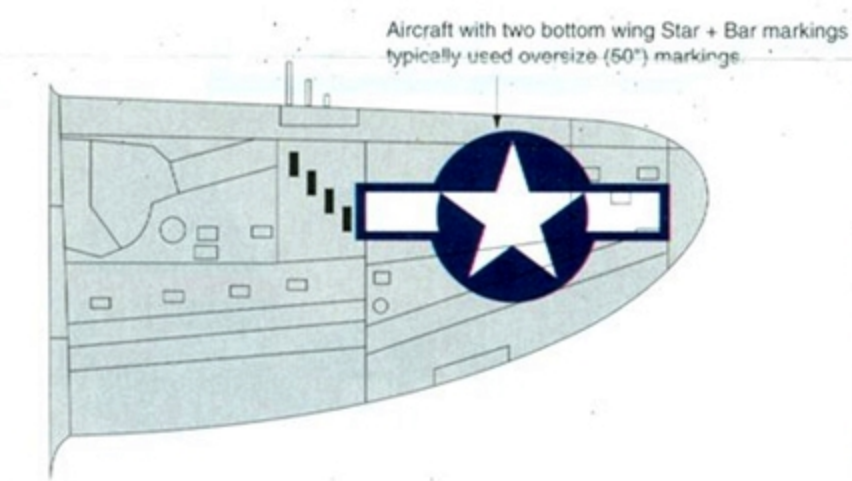
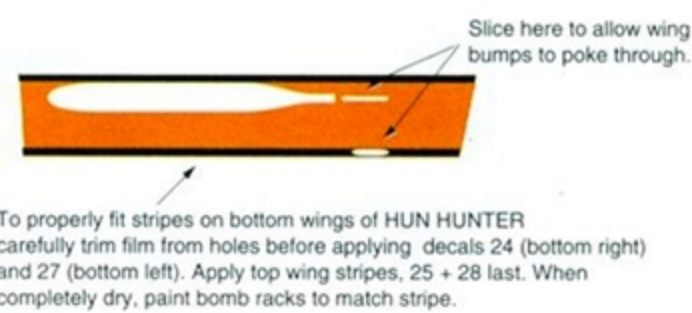


**Star + Bar national markings** can be obtained from our sheet #48-054. Use the following sizes:
