

"SCAT II

P-38J "SCAT II", 479th Fighter Group, May through mid July 1944. This lightning carried the standard color scheme of Olive Drab uppersurfaces with Neutral Gray lowersurfaces, and had full D-Day invasion stripes added later on. It is unknown if nose art were carried on the opposite side, but extra decals are included. The spinner was either O.D., Red or natural metal. It is possible that a solid White circle was carried on the fin (decal 21).

"SCAT #5"

P-51D, 44-14426 "SCAT 5", January through February 1945. Standard Aluminum finish with Red ruder. Kill markings may have been duplicated on stbd. side so an extra set is provided. European Theater stripes may have been applied, and also may have had thin White stripes along each side (decals 35).


"SCAT VII


P-51D, 44-72922 "SCAT VII", March 1945 to end of war. Standard Aluminum finish with Red ruder. Kill markings may have been duplicated on stbd. side so an extra set is provided.







