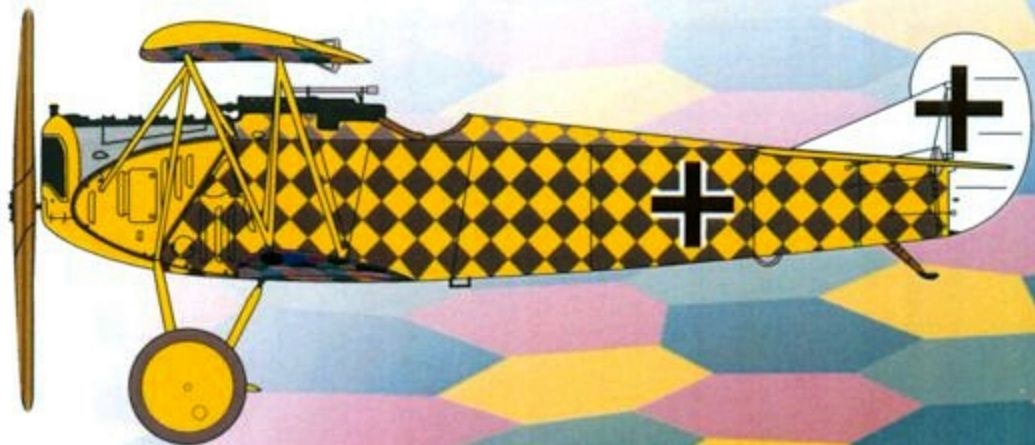

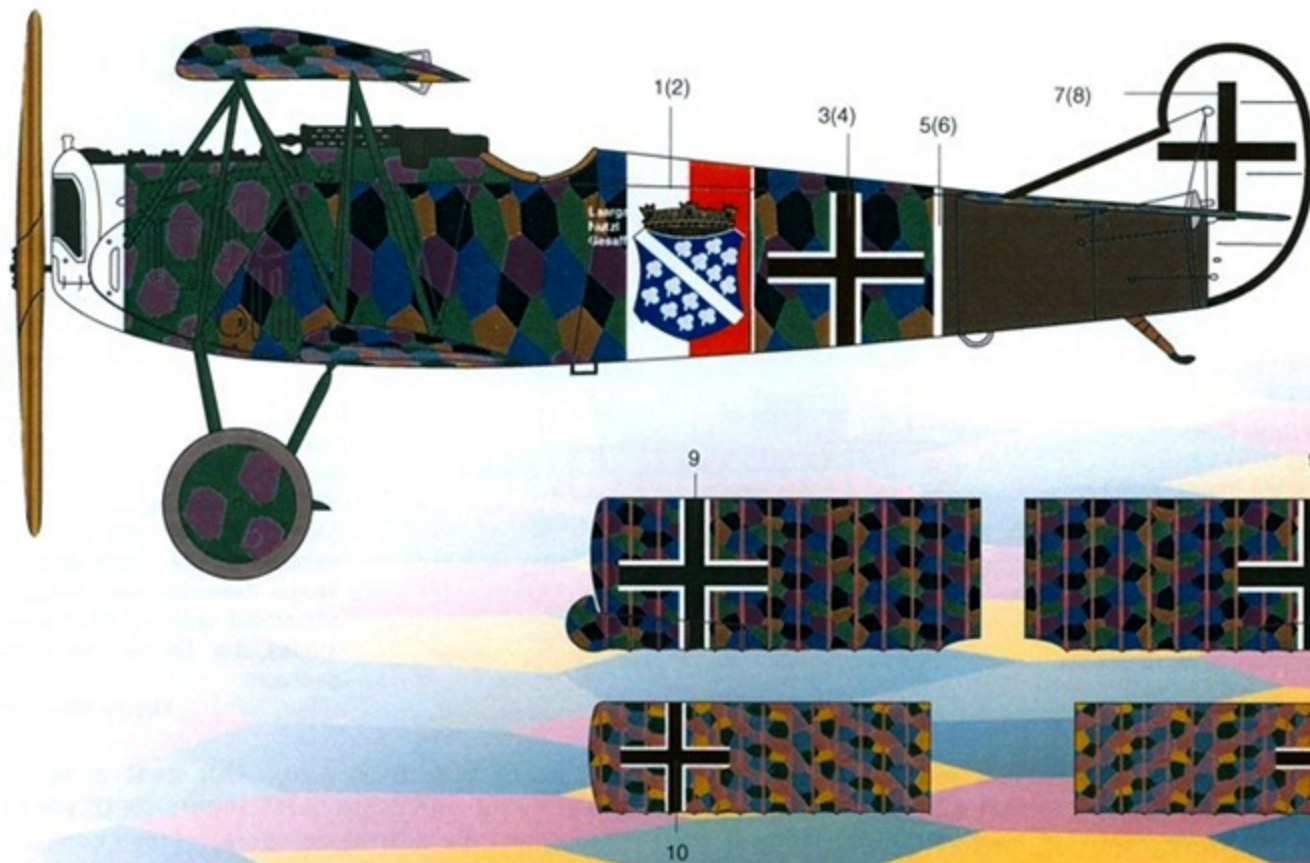

## Those incredible FOKKERS! Pt. II



Fokker D. VII (OAW) Jasta 58. Covered in 4 color lozenge fabric, this A/C shows typical Jasta 58 markings of White nose, Black tail and rear fuselage sides and lower sections. Dk Green strut on wings and undercarriage. Notice typical OAW Green/Mauve patch camouflage on engine cowling, axle wing and wheel covers.

A striking Fokker D. VII F of MFJL, 1918, flown by Lt. Gotthard Sachsenberg. Wings are covered in 4 color lozenge fabric. Side engine panels, (shown in gray in our drawing) were removed, exposing the engine, not illustrated here. White Fin & Rudder, with a Yellow upper wing and wheel covers. Notice small Black rectangles on the top of the wing (photo page 55 & 56), reason unknown. Paint fuselage and horizontal stabilizers Yellow. Apply Left side checkers. Apply right side checkers making sure they are properly aligned. Next apply upper and lower sections, matching both sides.
