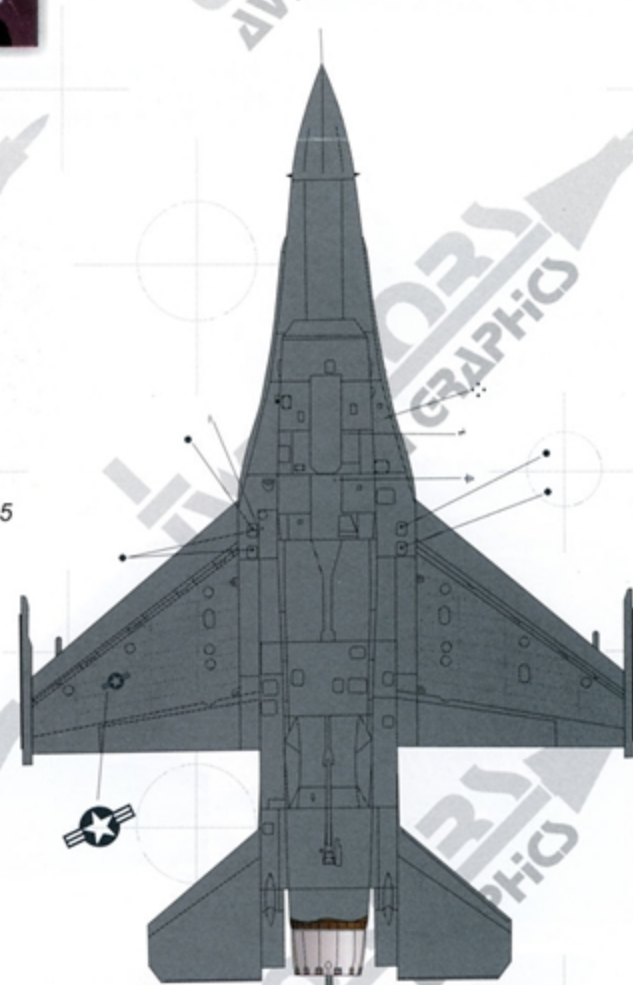

Aircraft 83-119 is actually a Block 25 Viper assigned to the Air Force Flight Test Center.

Typical of the AFFTC Vipers, this F-16 has had numerous modifications done to it and is now a combination of Block 25 airframe and Block 40 avionics. This A/C features a Block 40 cockpit (big HUD) along with the IFF antennas typical of ADF Falcons in front of the canopy on the nose. Block 40 type nose wheel lights are also on this jet.
