

Spitfire Mk IX MK805/SH-B 64 Squadron July 1944


Standard Dark Green/Ocean Grey Upper surfaces with Medium Sea Grey Lower surfaces.

Sky spinner and tail band. 18* Invasion stripes on lower wings and fuselage only




Dark Green/Ocean Grey Upper surfaces with Medium Sea Grey Lower surfaces. Spinner and front of cowl white. Sky fuselage band. 18" Invasion stripes on wing upper and lower surfaces and fuselage.



Typhoon 1B RB222/TP-E 198 Squadron

Dark Green/Ocean Grey Upper surfaces and Medium Sea Grey Lower surfaces. Spinner yellow. Sky Fuselage band. 18* Invasion stripes on upper and lower wings and lower fuselage.




Lysander III JR-P Serial unknown 161 Squadron

Dark Green/Ocean Grey upper surfaces, matt black lower surfaces.

18* Invasion stripes on fuselage only. Cowling front is darkened bronze

Markings on all aircraft were changing rapidly on a day to day basis at this point of the war. In particular, Invasion stripes which in many cases had been hurridly applied on June 5th were removed from some areas of the airframe
