

# DHC-6 Twin Otters

DHC-6 Series 300, FAE 449, of the Ecuadorian Air Force.

Upper surface colours seem to be tan FS 30219, green FS 34102, and dark green FS 34079, with light grey FS 36622 undersides.

Rudder is striped in the flag colours of yellow, blue, and red.



Twin Otter series 300 operated by Transport Canada in the coastal surveillance role.

Aircraft is overall red ca. FS 11105, with black areas in way of engine exhaust.



UV-18A (essentially a series 300, but here with the short nose) of the Alaska Army National Guard.

Aircraft is overall gloss Olive Drab FS 14087, with white wing and fuselage bands.



DHC-6 Series 400, s/n 1730, of the Guatemalan Air Force.

Aircraft is close to (and may actually be) Dark Gull Grey FS 36231 over Light Gull Grey (FS 36440).



Twin Otter series 300 operated by the International Committee of the Red Cross.

Aircraft is overall white with black areas in way of engine exhaust. Spinners are natural metal.

Note small Swiss flag

MFO stands for the Multi-national Force & Observers unit, operating in the Sinai.



Twin Otter series 300 of the French Air Force's ET 2/65.

Aircraft is overall white with red wing bands and black areas in way of engine exhaust.



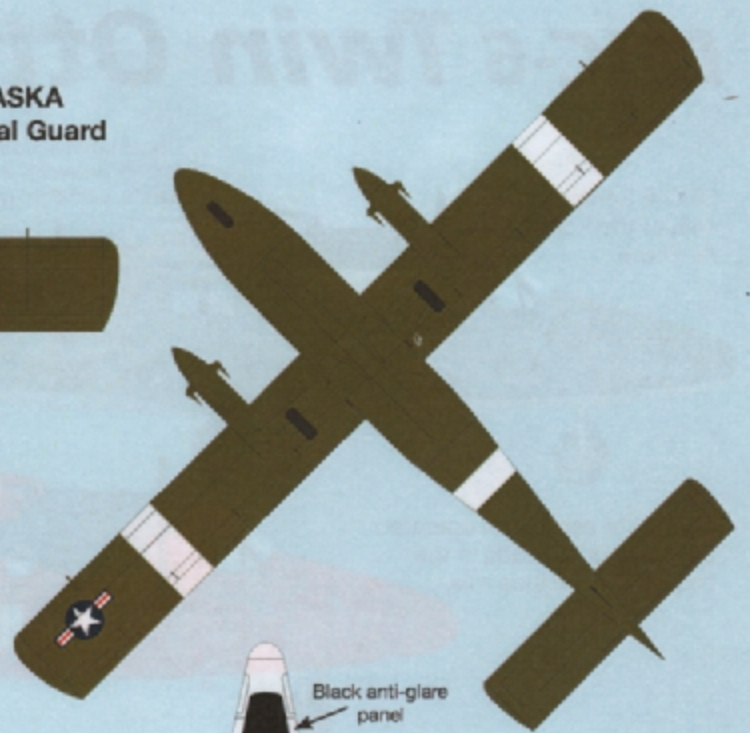
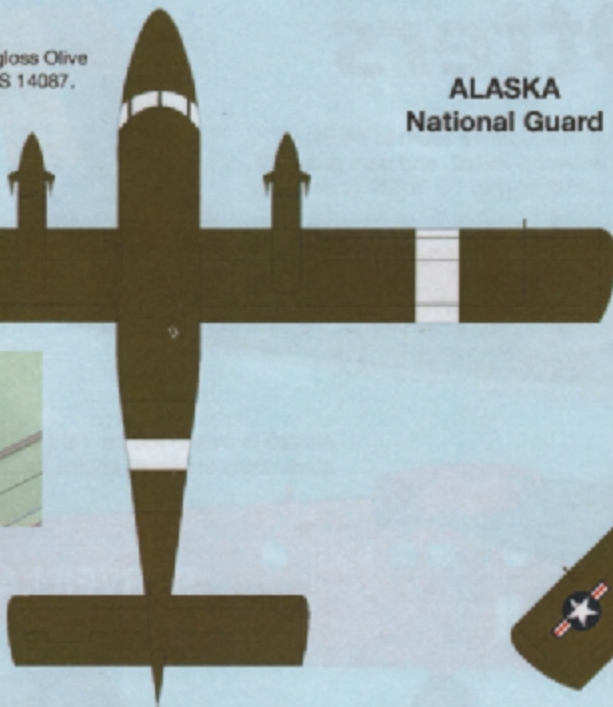

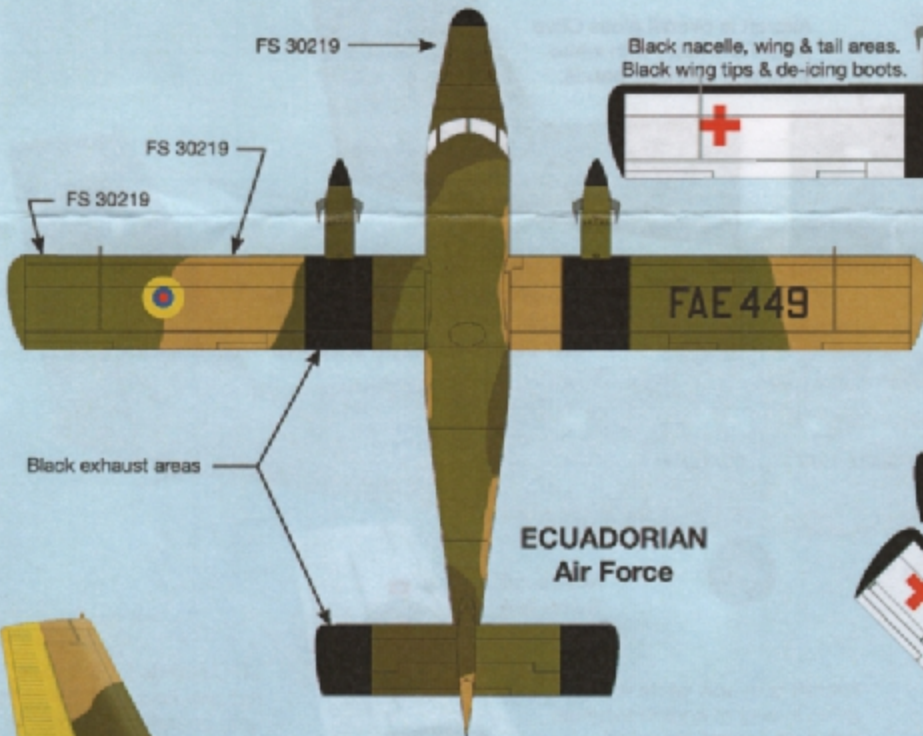

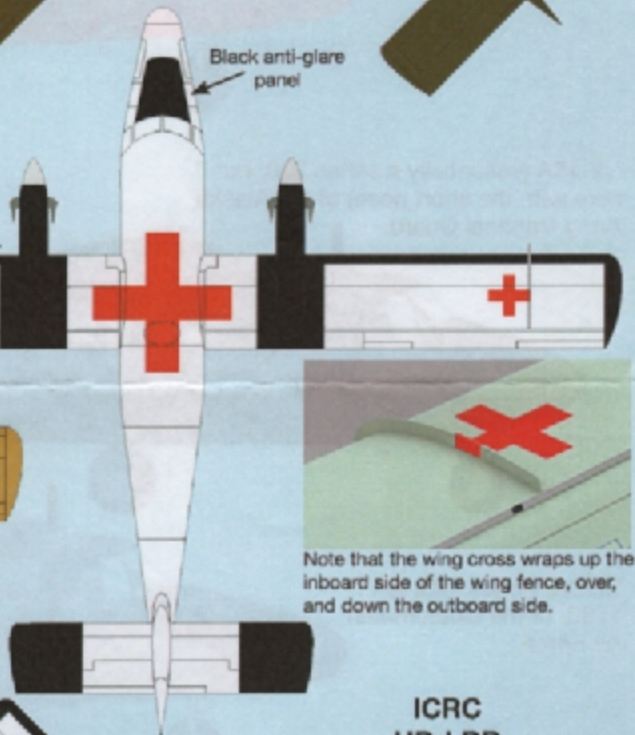

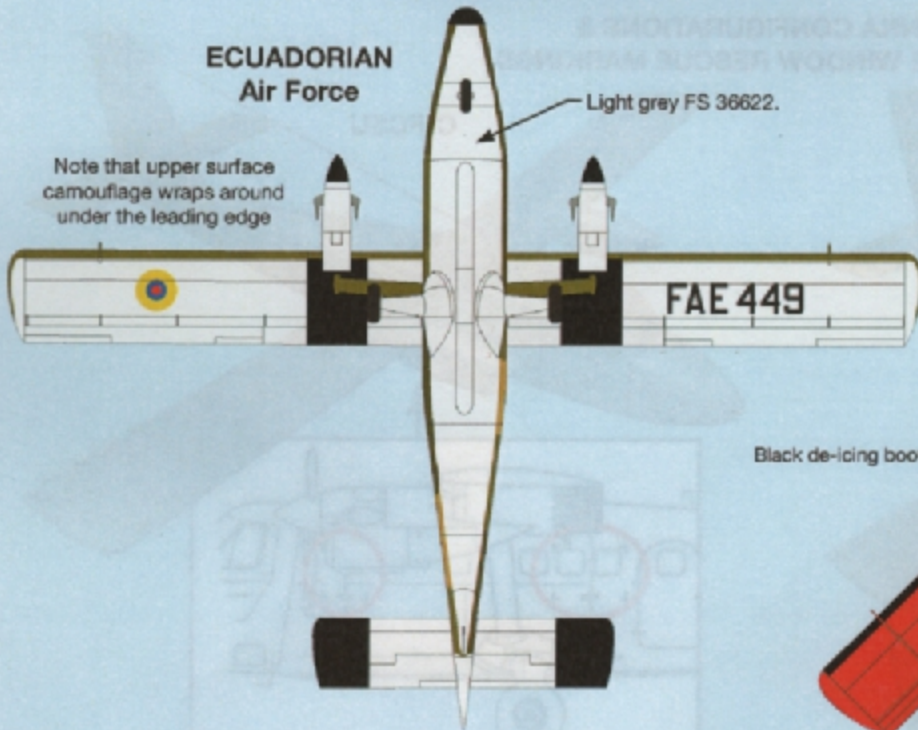

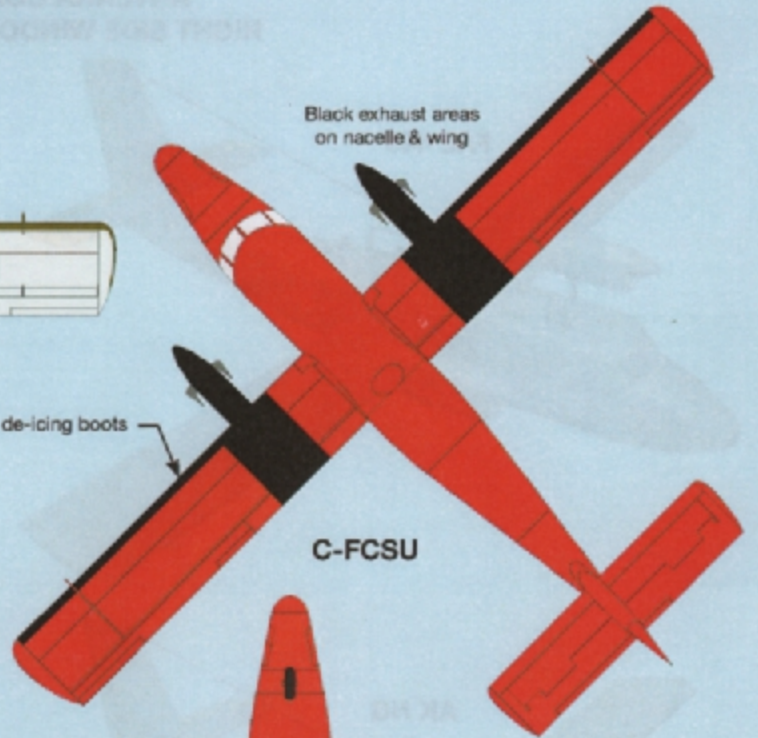

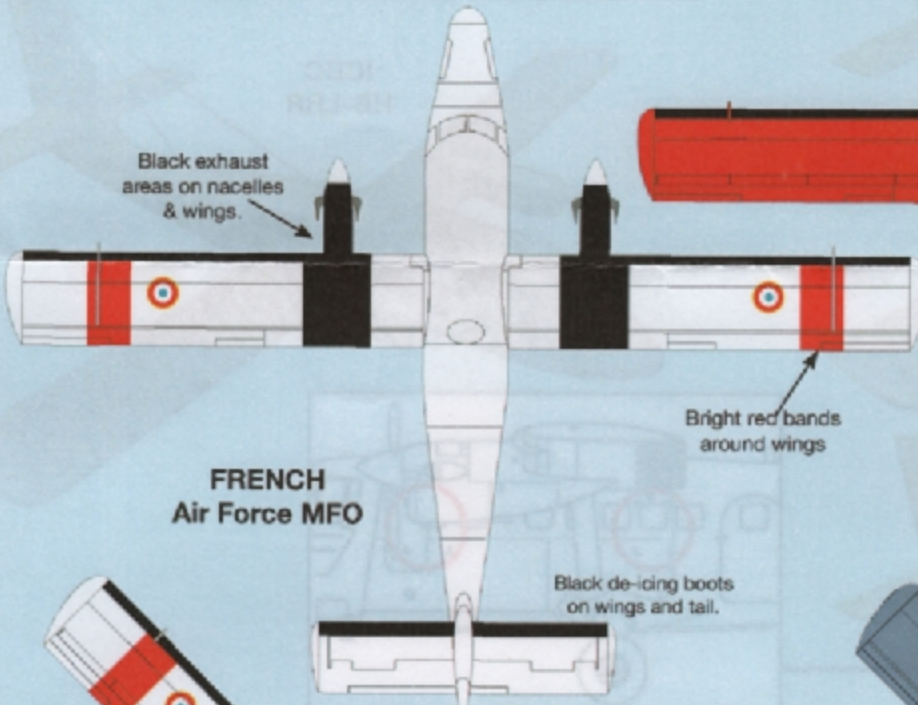
Black exhaust areas on nacelle & wing

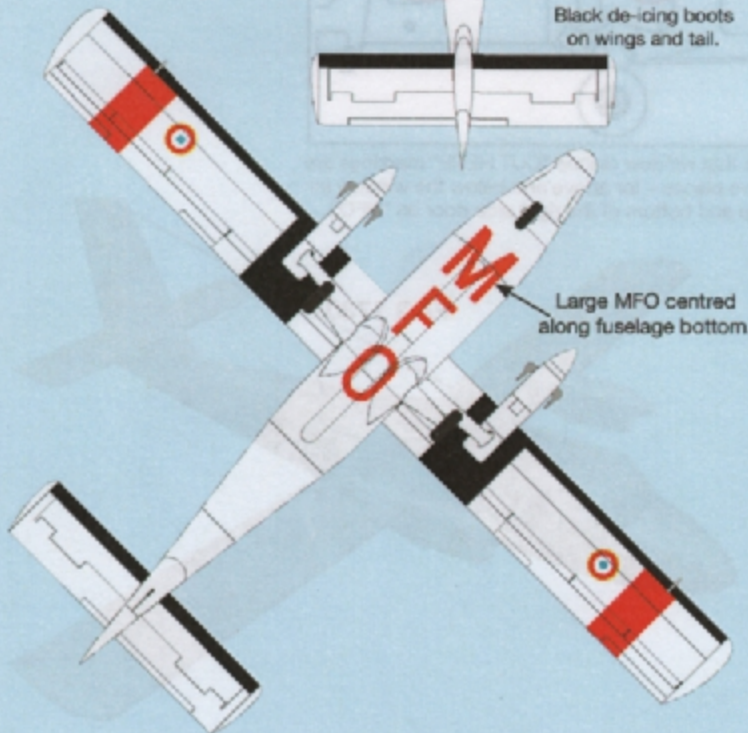
Black exhaust areas on nacelles & wings.

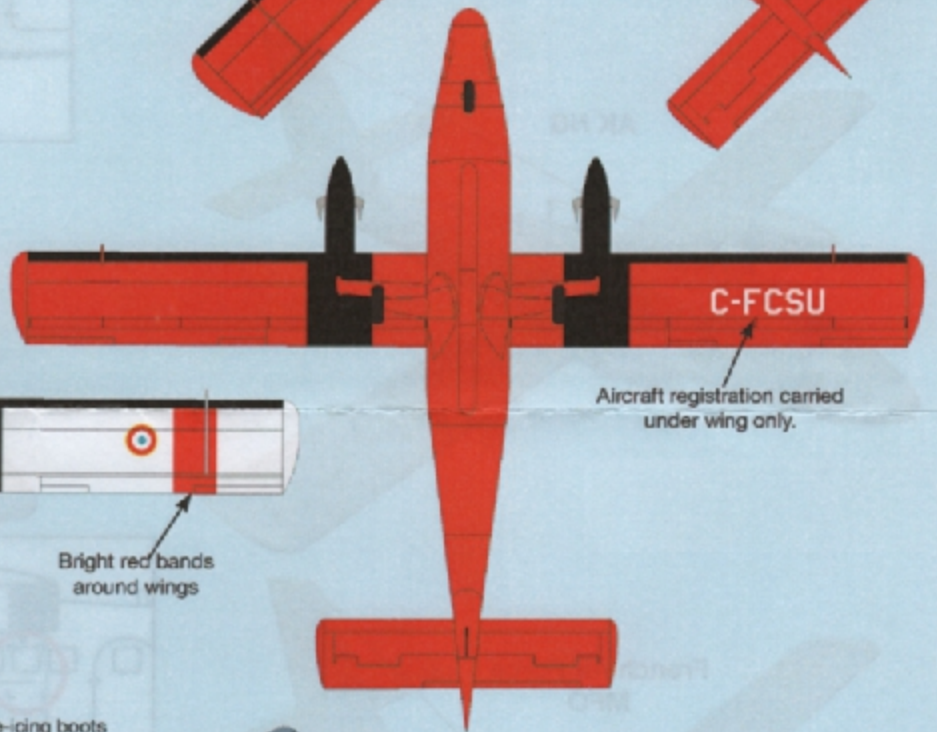
