## **Pacific Lightnings Part II**

P-38J. "WINDY CITY RUTHIE", flown by Ken Ladd. This aircraft was overall bare metal with an O.D. anti-glare panel and Green trim on the nose, gun opening panels, fins and spinners.

P-38J-10, 42-67590 "JANDINA II", 80th FS. flown by Capt. Jay Robbins. This Lightning carried the standard color scheme of O.D. uppers and Neutral Gray lower surfaces. The upper and lower fin tips were painted Green with White trim. The spinners were finished in Red, White and Blue. Notice the Jandina name is missing. A/C was one of the first J models to arrive to the S.W.P.A. theatre. Robbins must have considered this A/C as II, since his next A/C (42-103988) became III. We don't know if the nose art was present on the right side of the nose. Appropriate version is supplied. Modeller must paint the Red and Blue parts of the spinner. Then trim with decals 14.

P-38L-5, 44-25638, 'MADU V', 431st FS, the spinners, fins and rear booms.


