What is CCIP?
 A/C 84-1275 has been modified under the Common Configuration Implementation Program (CCIP). This modification is being completed by Lockheed Martin in conjunction with Ogden Air Logistics Center (OLC) to all various Block A/C in the US inventory. These modifications are being done in order to standardize the cockpits and capabilities in all the aircraft. The biggest external clue to this mod are the APX-133 air-to-air interrogator blades in front of the windscreen. These aircraft can also carry both the LANTIRN and Litening Pod as well as the Lockheed Martin Sniper XR Advanced FLIR Pod.

Some advanced versions of CCIP add a NATO standard Link-16 Data Link, Joint Helmet Mounted Cueing System (JHMCS) and electronic horizontal situational indicator.
