



AIRCRAFT 2 • F-18C, BuNo. 165203, #303 of VFA-82 'Marauders'. Pilot's name, if assigned, is unknown. Aircraft based on the USS George Washington.

AIRCRAFT 3 • F-18A, BuNo. 161502 (?), #02 of VMFA-251 "Thunderbolts'. The actual Bureau number for this aircraft is undecipherable in the reference photo, as is the pilot's name. We have assigned a BuNo. in the 161 series, as the antenna arrangement suggests the aircraft is a F-18A, and a fictitious name to the pilot. Note mainwheels appear to be painted black or very dark gray, as is nose of drop tank.



Suggested Kits:

This set has been designed to fit the Hasegawa F18 kit family. Italeri's & Monogram's F18 kit may be used if decals are trimmed to fit.
