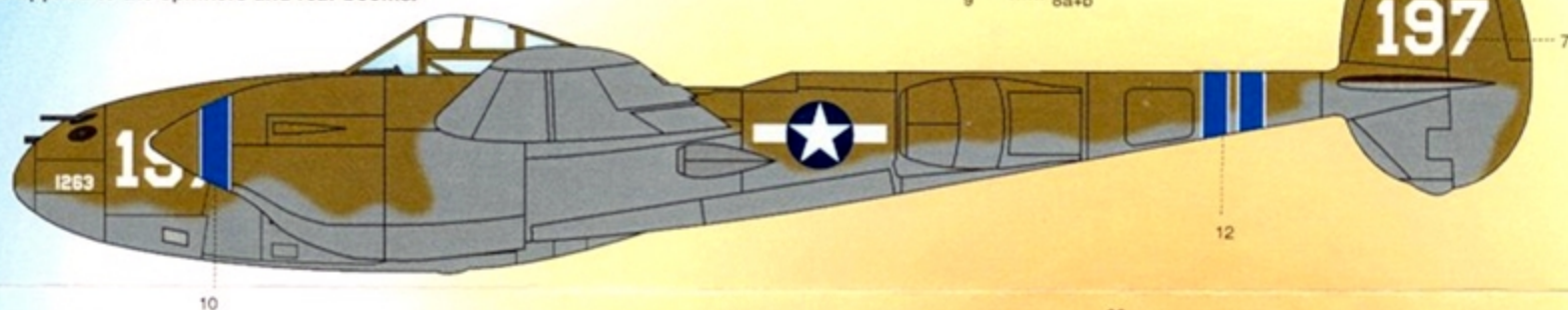

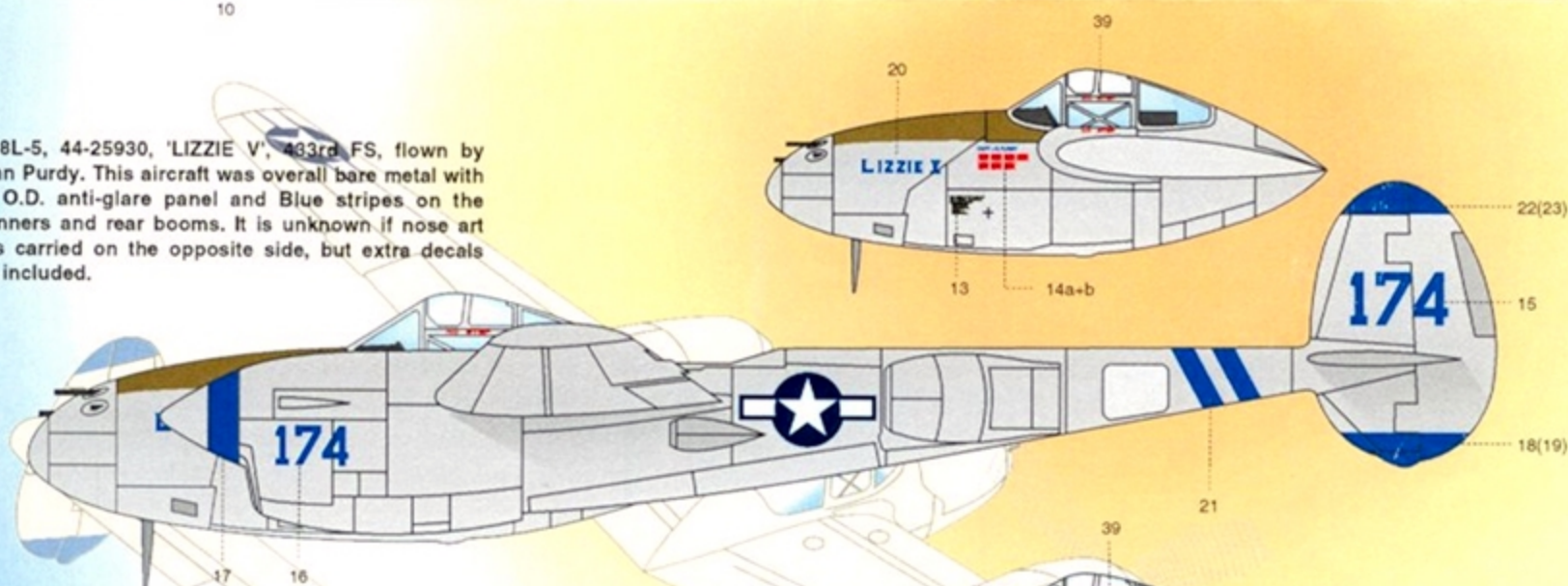
P-38H-5, 42-66764, 'PISS POT PETE', 431st FS, flown by Don Bellows. This lightning carried the standard color scheme consisting of Olive Drab upper surfaces and Neutral Gray lower surfaces. Red stripes were applied to the spinners.



P-38H-5, 42-66752, 433rd FS, flown by Capt. D.T. Roberts. This lightning carried the standard color scheme described above, but with Blue and White stripes applied to the spinners and rear booms.



P-38L-5, 44-25930, 'LIZZIE V', 433rd FS, flown by John Purdy. This aircraft was overall bare metal with an O.D. anti-glare panel and Blue stripes on the spinners and rear booms. It is unknown if nose art was carried on the opposite side, but extra decals are included.



P-38L-5, 44-25600, 432nd FS, flown by Elliot Summer. This aircraft was overall bare metal with an O.D. anti-glare panel and Yellow/Black stripes on the spinners, vertical fins and rear booms.
