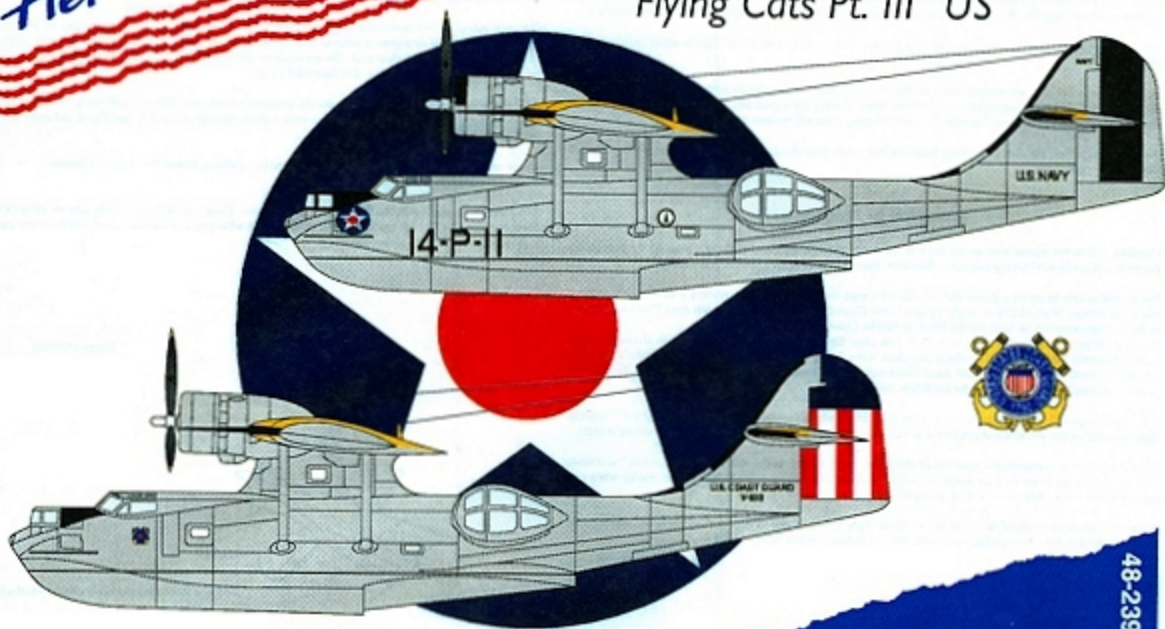

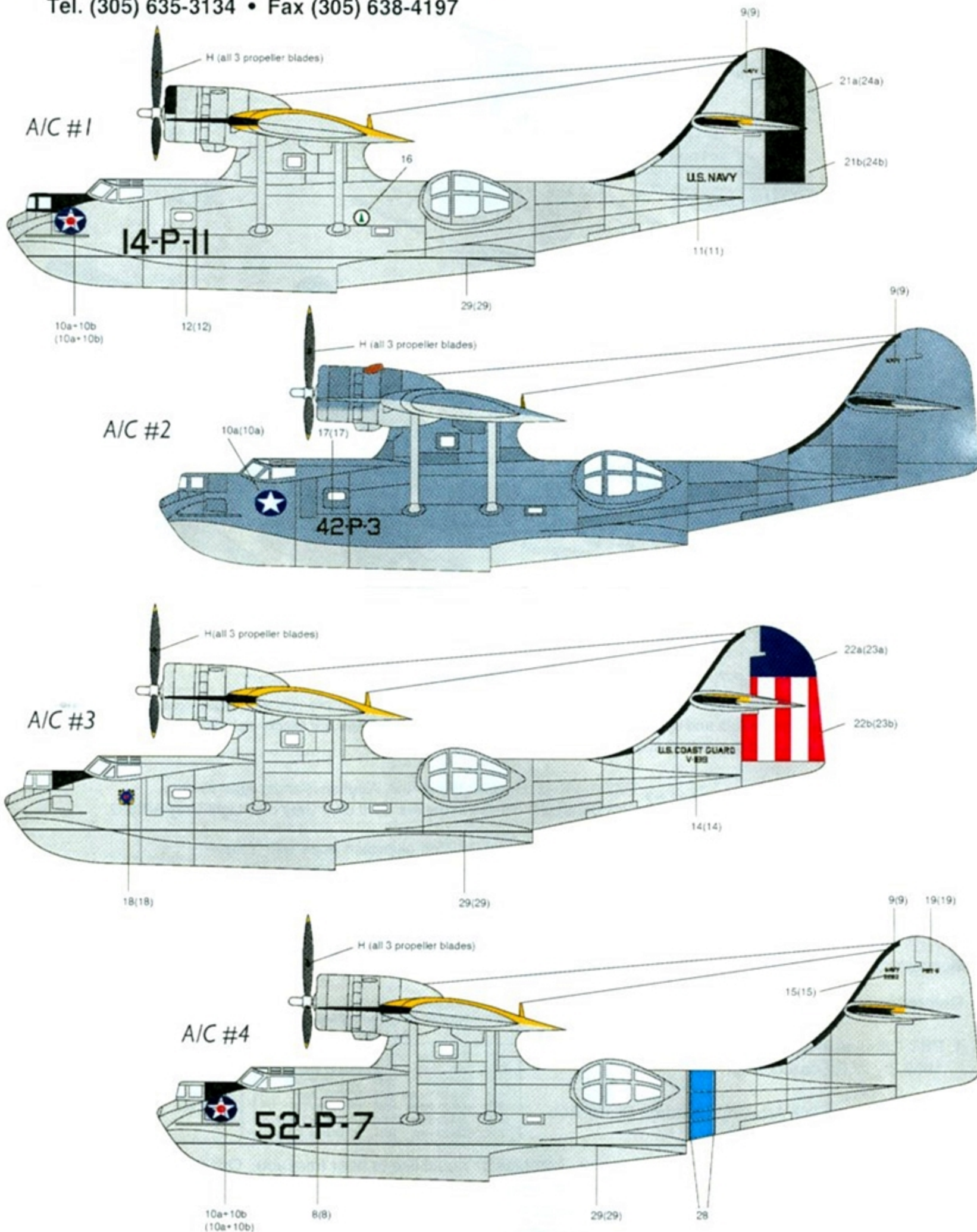

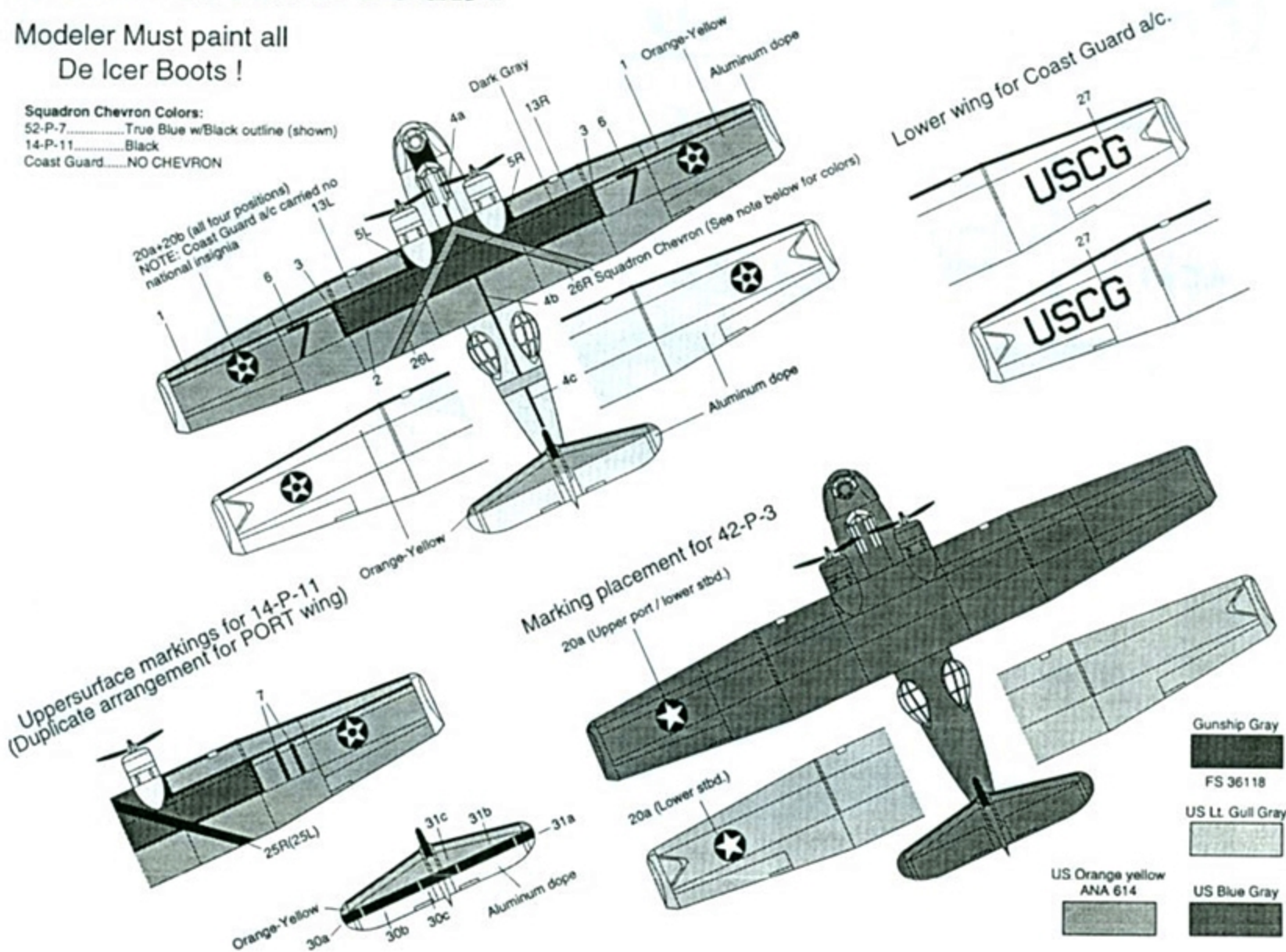

Squadron Chevron Colors:  
52-P-7.....True Blue w/Black outline (shown)  
14-P-11.....Black  
Coast Guard.....NO CHEVRON



Uppersurface scheme for 52-P-7, 14-P-11 and Coast Guard a/c (52-P-7 shown).

**A/C #1** PBY-5 Catalina of VP-14, 1940. The aircraft is painted in the standard pre-war aluminum dope, with Orange-Yellow upper wings and upper horizontal stabilizers. Squadron markings are Black, including the chevron on the upper wing and the vertical stripe on the rudder.

**A/C #2** PBY-5, VP-42, Fleet Air Wing Four, Aleutian Islands, June 1942.  
This Catalina is painted in the standard Blue Gray over Light Gray A/N602.

**A/C #3** PBY-5, V-189, U.S. Coast Guard. The aircraft was painted aluminum dope with Yellow-Orange upper wings and upper horizontal stabilizer. The rudder was Red, White and Blue.

**A/C #4** PBY-5 (BuNo 2293) of Patron 52, NAS Quonset Point, 1941. The aircraft is painted in the standard pre-war aluminum dope, with Orange-Yellow upper wings and upper horizontal stabilizers. The upper wing chevron and fuselage stripe are painted True Blue with Black trim (provided as decals).
