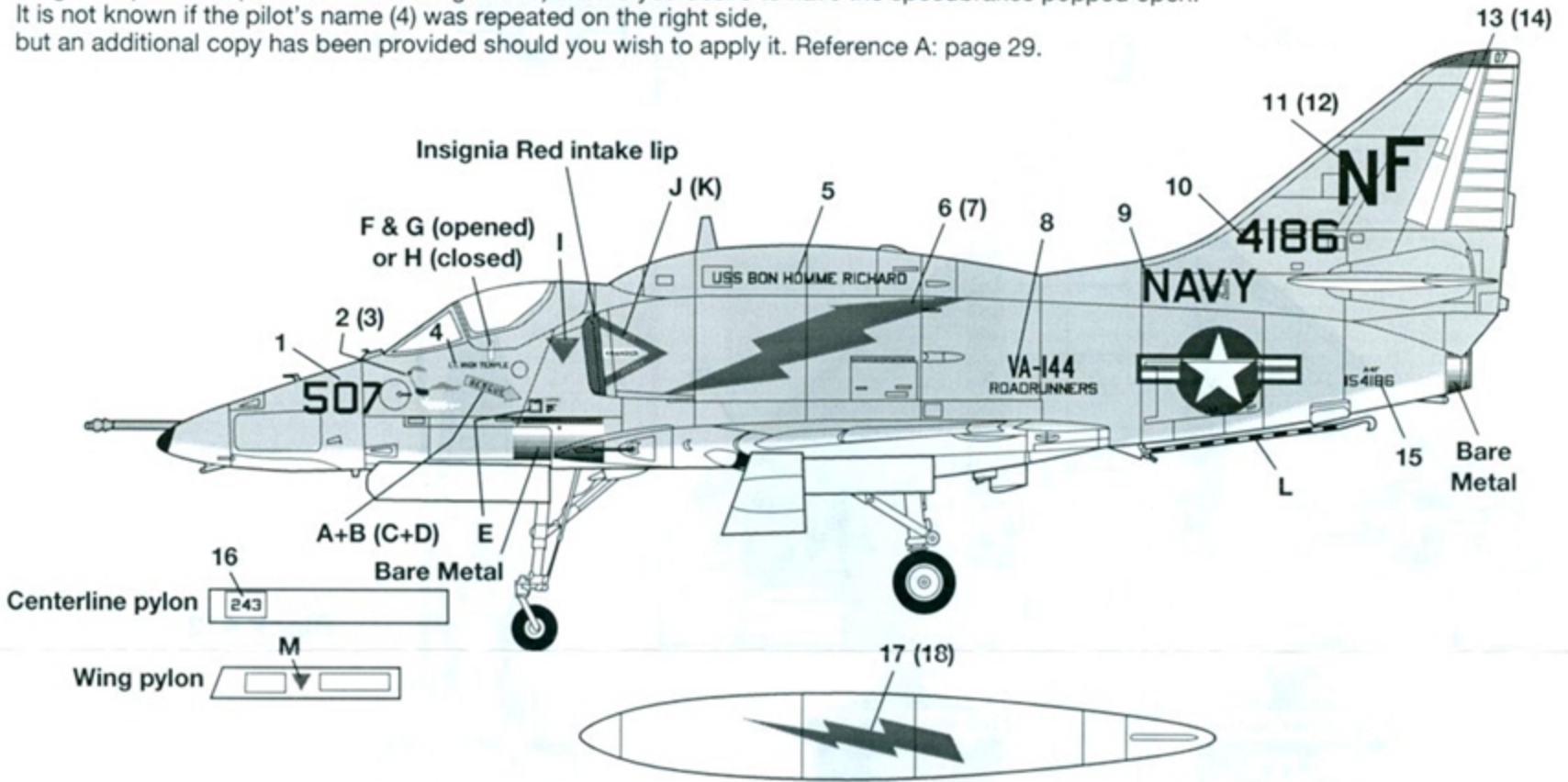

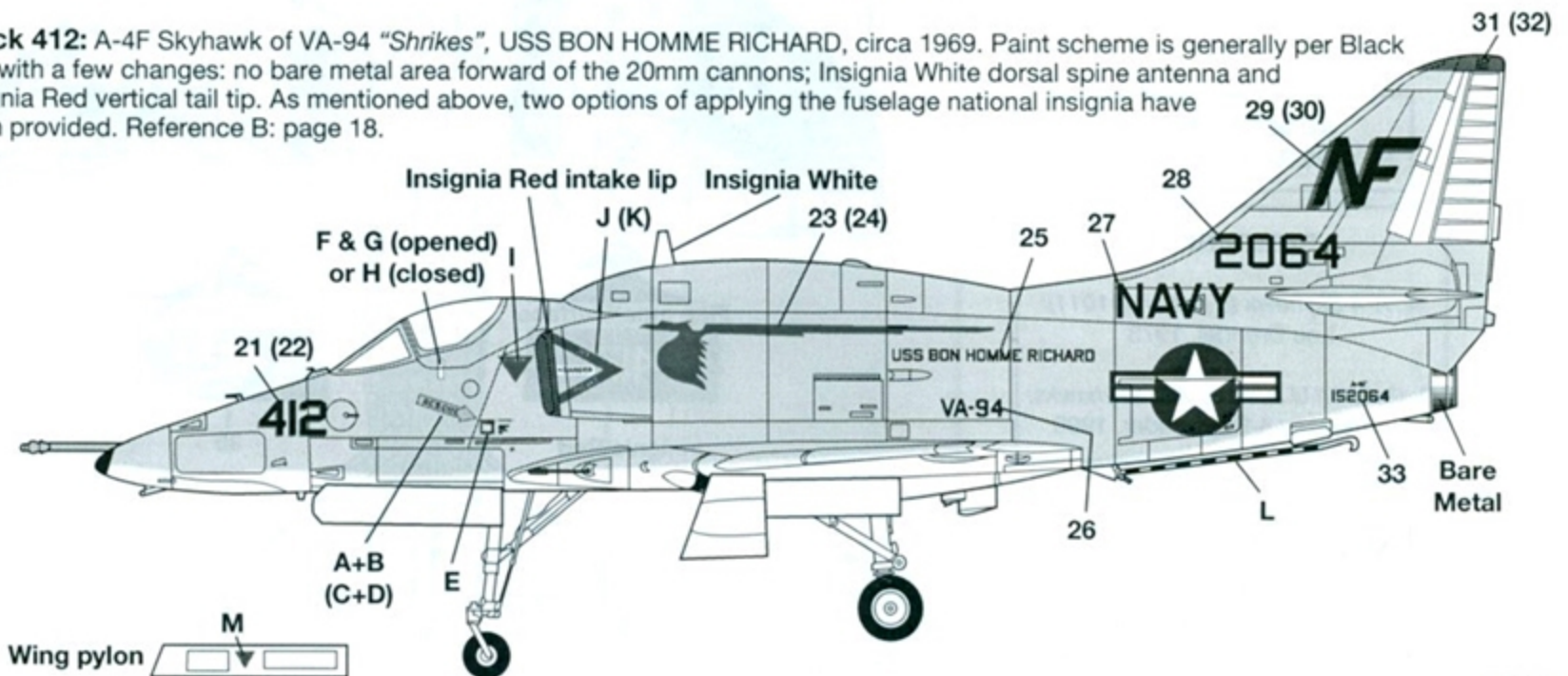
VA-144 "Roadrunners" & VA-94 "Shrikes"

McDonnell-Douglas A-4F Skyhawk

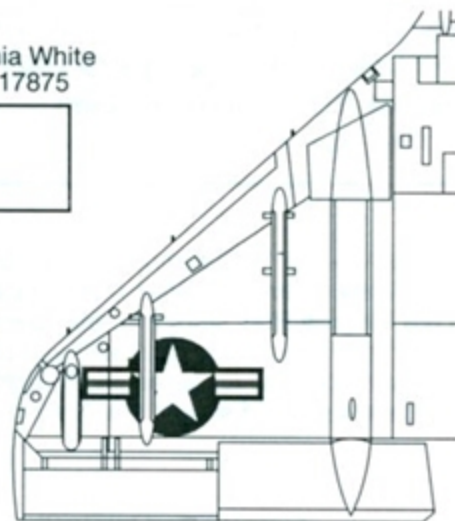
**Black 507:** A-4F Skyhawk of VA-144 "Roadrunners", USS BON HOMME RICHARD, circa 1969. This Skyhawk is Light Gull Gray over Insignia White with Insignia White control surfaces. The area immediately forward of the 20mm cannon is bare metal. The tip of the nose is Black and the intake lips are Insignia Red. Note the small passive ECM sensors below the wing cannon. An optional set of pre-split national insignia is provided (sized for the Monogram kit) should you desire to have the speedbrakes popped open. It is not known if the pilot's name (4) was repeated on the right side, but an additional copy has been provided should you wish to apply it. Reference A: page 29.



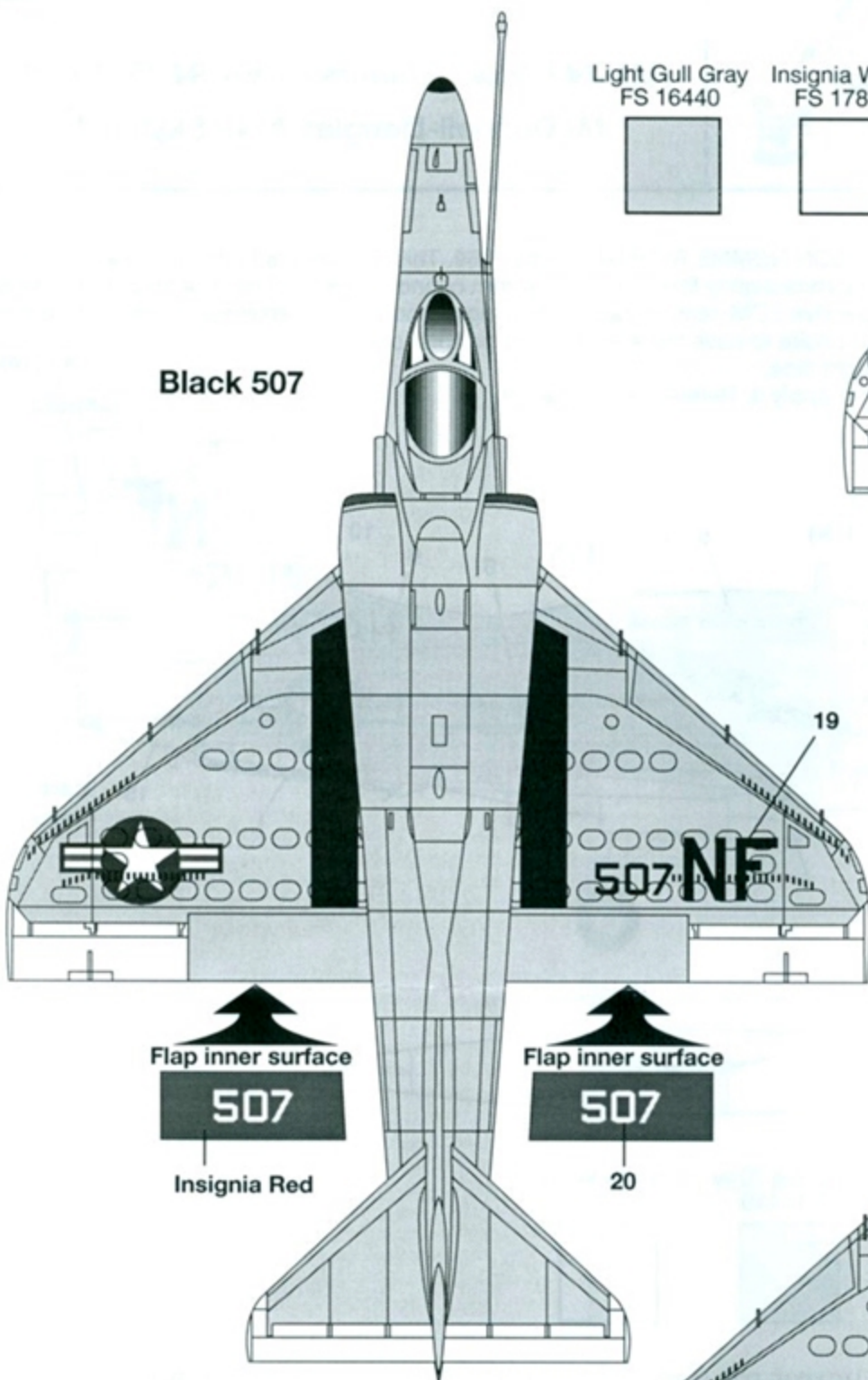
**Black 412:** A-4F Skyhawk of VA-94 "Shrikes", USS BON HOMME RICHARD, circa 1969. Paint scheme is generally per Black 507 with a few changes: no bare metal area forward of the 20mm cannons; Insignia White dorsal spine antenna and Insignia Red vertical tail tip. As mentioned above, two options of applying the fuselage national insignia have been provided. Reference B: page 18.



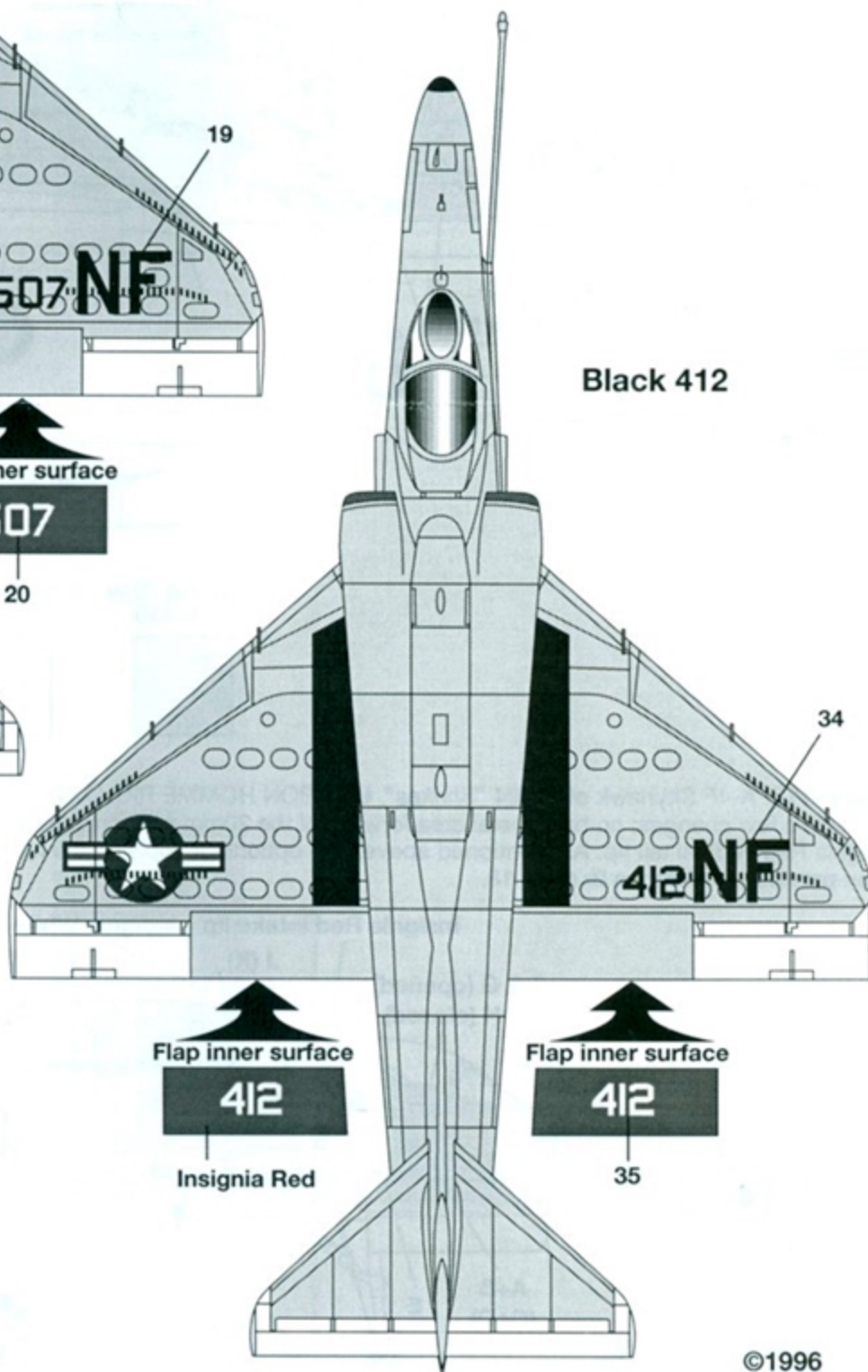
