




A/C #2. Ki-84 Type KOU. 57 Shinbu-Tai, Flown by Sentai Leader 2nd Ltn. ITO, May 17, 1945. Shimodate A/B, Japan. Upper surfaces is dark green with a brownish tint to it. Lower surfaces IJAAF Lt. Gray. Cockpit well is natural metal finish. All other interior parts, wheel wells, inside of landing gear doors, etc. Aotake (metallic blue/green). Propeller is greyish green.

Tamiya Ki-84 Frank

A/C #3. Ki-84 Type KOU. 57 Shinbu-Tai, Flown by Corporal Takano, May 1945 Shimodate A/B, Japan. Upper surface color is black (although a very dark brown color was used on Hayates belonging to Shinbu-Tai Squadrons). Lower surfaces IJAAF Lt. Gray. Cockpit well is natural metal finish. All other interior parts, wheel wells, inside of landing gear doors, etc. Aotake (metallic blue/green). Propeller is greyish green.

A/C #1. Ki-84 Type KOU. Army Special attack force # 182 Shinbu-Tai. Flown by its leader, 1st Ltn. Iwamoto, August 1945. Tatebayashi, Japan. Upper surface very dark brown/green. Lower surfaces IJAAF Lt. Gray. Cockpit well is natural metal finish. All other interior parts, wheel wells, inside of landing gear doors, etc. Aotake (metallic blue/green). Propeller is greyish green.. No wing armament.
