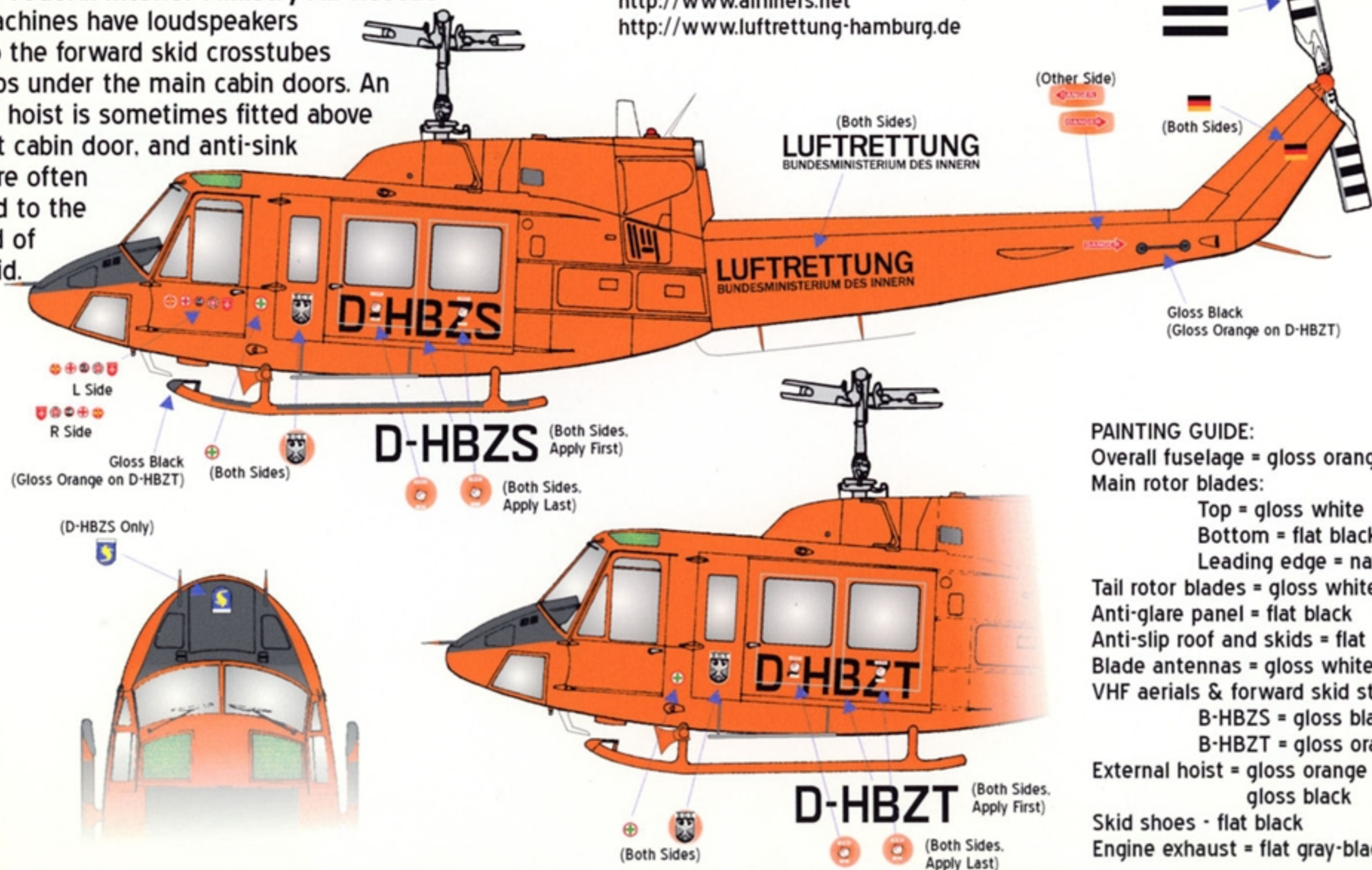
These decals are printed on an ALPS printer. Apply them as you would any other waterslide decal- they work best on a smooth, glossy surface. They are as strong and flexible as silk-screened decals, but unlike silk-screened decals, the carrier film covers the entire sheet. You must trim around the decals as closely as possible to eliminate the carrier film. To protect the ALPS ink from scratches during handling, a coat of Future has been applied to the surface of the sheet. These decals work very well with decal solutions such as MicroSol and MicroSet, but please first test your particular solution on a scrap decal, such as the sheet identification lettering. ## German Federal Interior Ministry Air Rescue

Both machines have loudspeakers fitted to the forward skid crosstubes and steps under the main cabin doors. An external hoist is sometimes fitted above the right cabin door, and anti-sink shoes are often attached to the rear end of each skid.

### PAINTING GUIDE:

Overall fuselage = gloss orange

Main rotor blades:

Top = gloss white

Bottom = flat black

Leading edge = natural metal

Tail rotor blades = gloss white

Anti-glare panel = flat black

Anti-slip roof and skids = flat black

Blade antennas = gloss white

VHF aerials & forward skid steps:

B-HBZS = gloss black

B-HBZT = gloss orange

External hoist = gloss orange or

gloss black

Skid shoes = flat black

Engine exhaust = flat gray-black
