

A: Bf.109E-3 No. 8, Grupul 7 Vânătoare, Pipera - Bucharest, Spring 1941

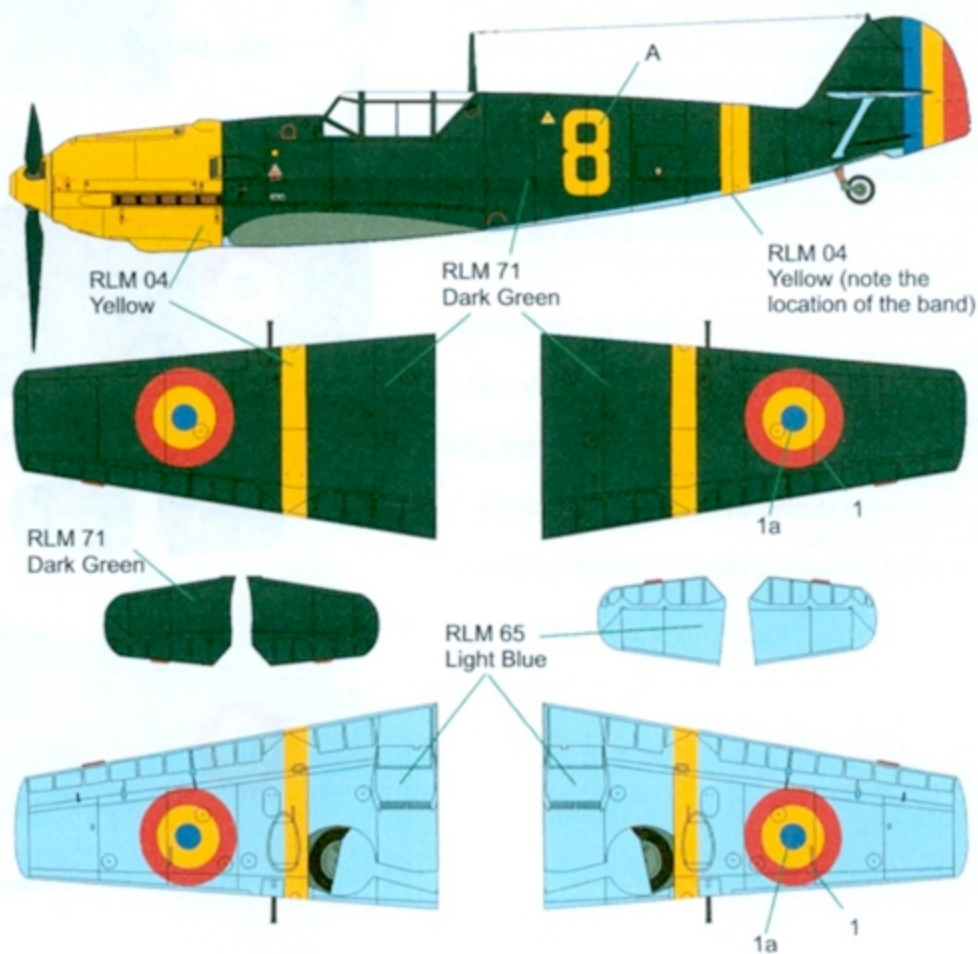
- Uppersurfaces painted RLM 71 Dark Green (some sources state RLM 70 Black Green)
- Undersurfaces painted RLM 65 Light Blue
- National insignia consisting of 1000 mm cockades on the wings. The cockades are placed symmetrically on the wings, overlapping the slats and ailerons.
- Romanian blue/yellow/red tricolour on the rudder (blue always at the mast)
- Markings consisting of RLM 04 Yellow 250 mm bands on both sides of the wings and on the fuselage as well as yellow nose and spinner. The scale dimensions of these bands are:

Scale 1/32 = 7.8 mm

Scale 1/48 = 5.2 mm

Scale 1/72 = 3.5 mm

- Spinner painted RLM04 yellow.
- Propeller blades painted RLM 70 Black Green
- Landing gear legs and inside of the landing gear doors painted RLM 02 Grey
- Cockpit interior painted RLM 02 Grey with RLM 66 Black Grey instrument panel
- All maintenance stencils were standard and in German, but some stencils were overpainted during overhaul. Please study the references.
- Aircraft armed with MG-FF 20mm cannons.



B: Bf.109E-3 No. 24, Grupul 7 Vânătoare, Pipera - Bucharest, Spring 1941

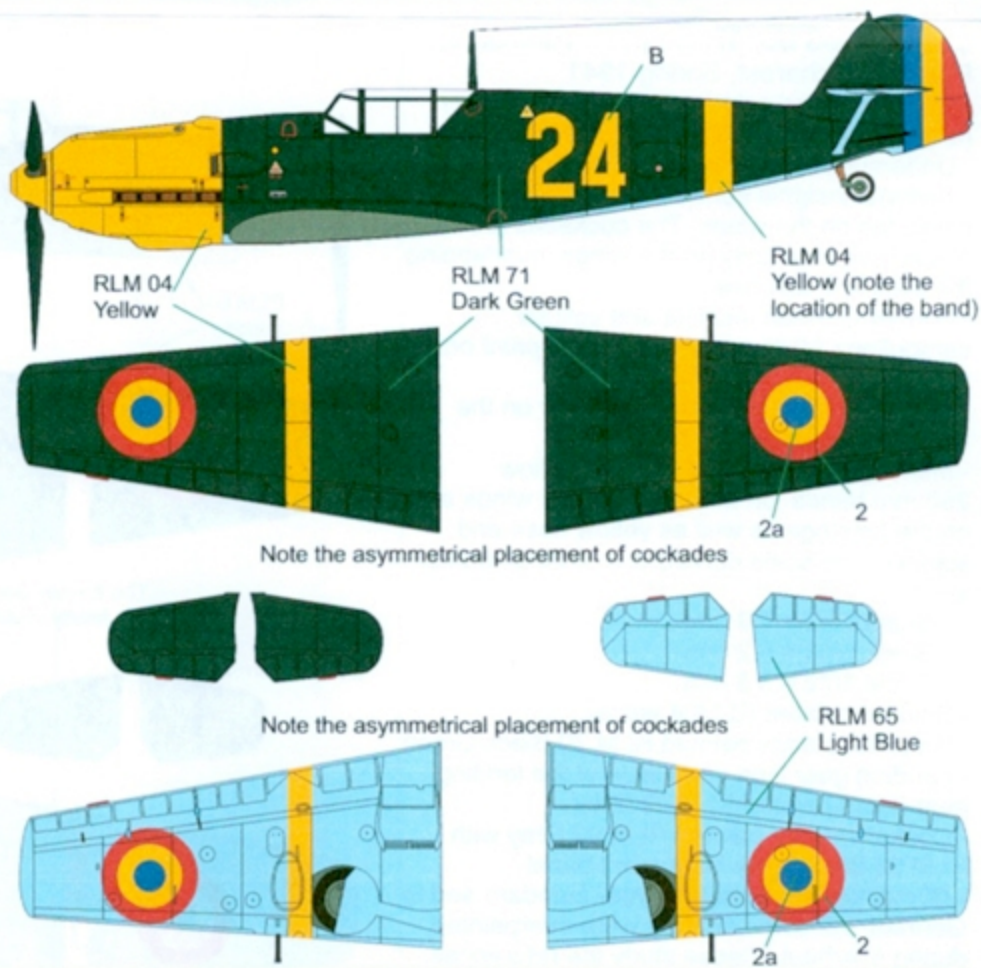
- Uppersurfaces painted RLM 71 Dark Green (some sources state RLM 70 Black Green)
- Undersurfaces painted RLM 65 Light Blue
- National insignia consisting of 1000 mm cockades on the wings. The cockades are placed asymmetrically on the wings, overlapping the slats and ailerons.
- Romanian blue/yellow/red tricolour on the rudder (blue always at the mast)
- Markings consisting of RLM 04 Yellow 250 mm bands on both sides of the wings and on the fuselage as well as yellow nose and spinner. The scale dimensions of these bands are:

Scale 1/32 = 7.8 mm

Scale 1/48 = 5.2 mm

Scale 1/72 = 3.5 mm

- Spinner painted RLM04 yellow.
- Propeller blades painted RLM 70 Black Green
- Landing gear legs and inside of the landing gear doors painted RLM 02 Grey
- Cockpit interior painted RLM 02 Grey with RLM 66 Black Grey instrument panel
- All maintenance stencils were standard and in German, but some stencils were overpainted during overhaul. Please study the references.
- Aircraft armed with MG-FF 20mm cannons.

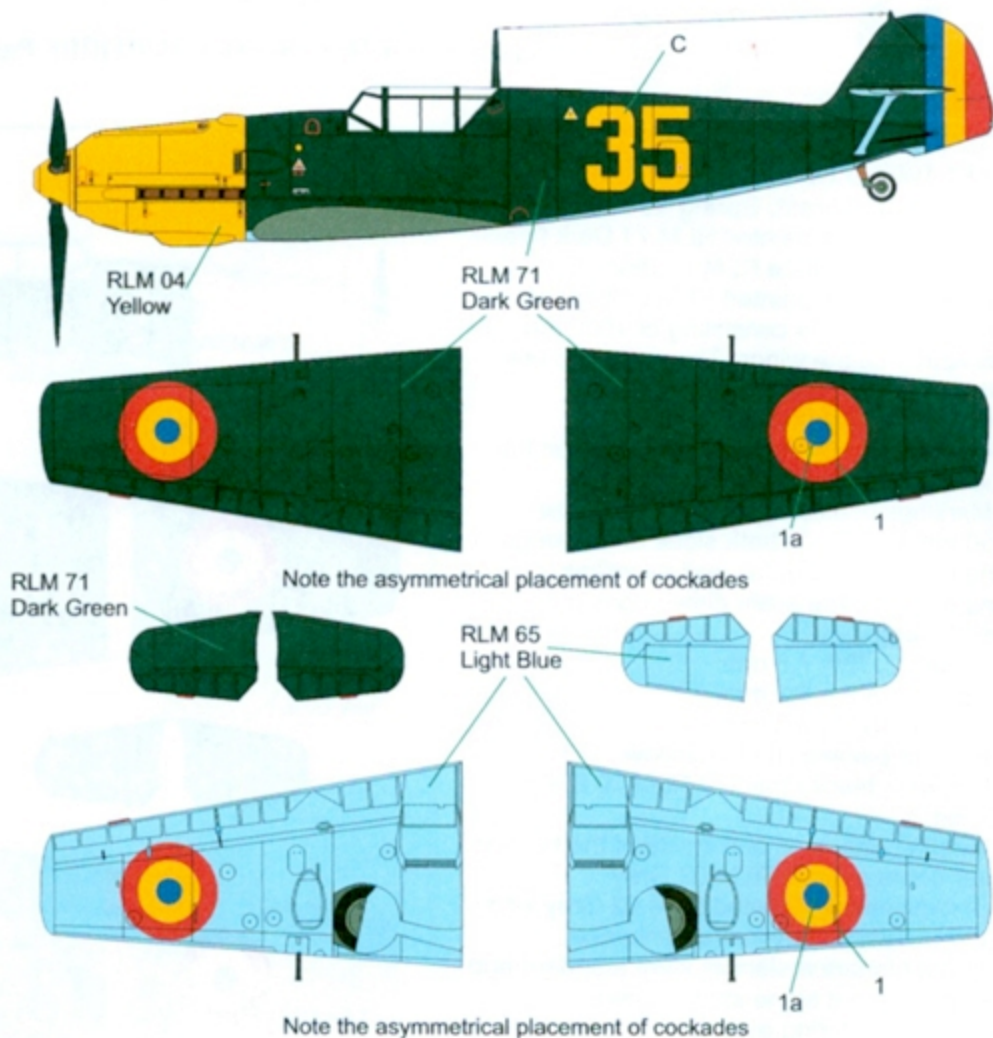

C: Bf.109E-3 No. 35, Grupul 7 Vânătoare, Pipera - Bucharest, Spring 1941

- Uppersurfaces painted RLM 71 Dark Green (also possibly RLM 70 Black Green)
- Undersurfaces painted RLM 65 Light Blue
- National insignia consisting of 1000 mm cockades (item 1) on the wings. The cockades are placed asymmetrically on the wings, overlapping the slats and ailerons.
- Romanian blue/yellow/red tricolour on the rudder (blue always at the mast)
- Nose and spinner painted RLM04 yellow.
- Propeller blades painted RLM 70 Black Green
- Landing gear legs and inside of the landing gear doors painted RLM 02 Grey
- Cockpit interior painted RLM 02 Grey with RLM 66 Black Grey instrument panel
- All maintenance stencils were standard and in German, but some stencils were overpainted during overhaul. Please study the references.
- Aircraft armed with MG-FF 20mm cannons.



D: Bf.109E-3 No. 37, Grupul 7 Vânătoare, Pipera - Bucharest, Spring 1941

- Uppersurfaces painted RLM 71 Dark Green (also possibly RLM 70 Black Green)
- Undersurfaces painted RLM 65 Light Blue
- National insignia consisting of 1000 mm cockades on the wings. The cockades are placed symmetrically on the wings, overlapping the slats and ailerons.
- Former German insignia and splinter camouflage faintly visible under the paint on the wings.
- Romanian blue/yellow/red tricolour on the rudder (blue always at the mast)
- Markings consisting of RLM 04 Yellow 250 mm bands on both sides of the wings and on the fuselage as well as yellow nose and spinner. The scale dimensions of these bands are:
 Scale 1/32 = 7.8 mm
 Scale 1/48 = 5.2 mm
 Scale 1/72 = 3.5 mm
- Spinner painted RLM04 yellow.
- Propeller blades painted RLM 70 Black Green
- Landing gear legs and inside of the landing gear doors painted RLM 02 Grey
- Cockpit interior painted RLM 02 Grey with RLM 66 Black Grey instrument panel
