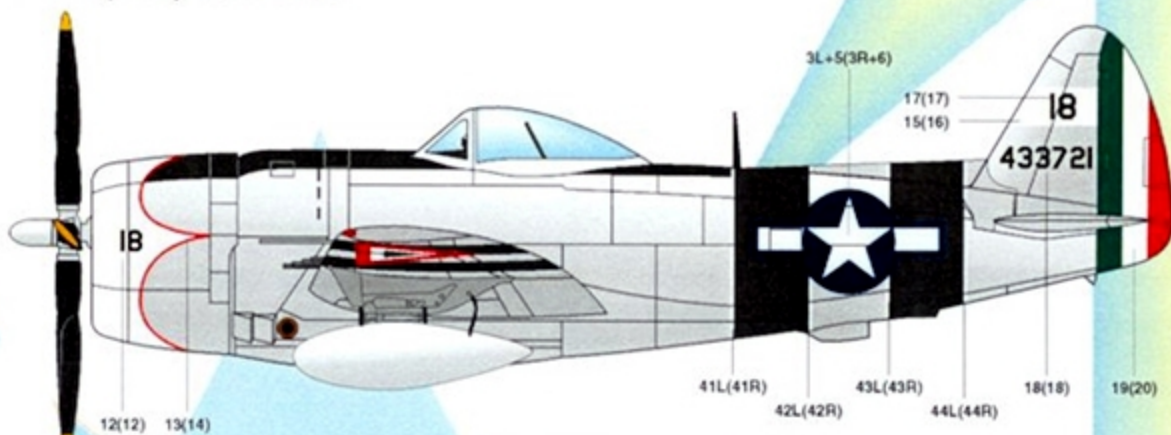

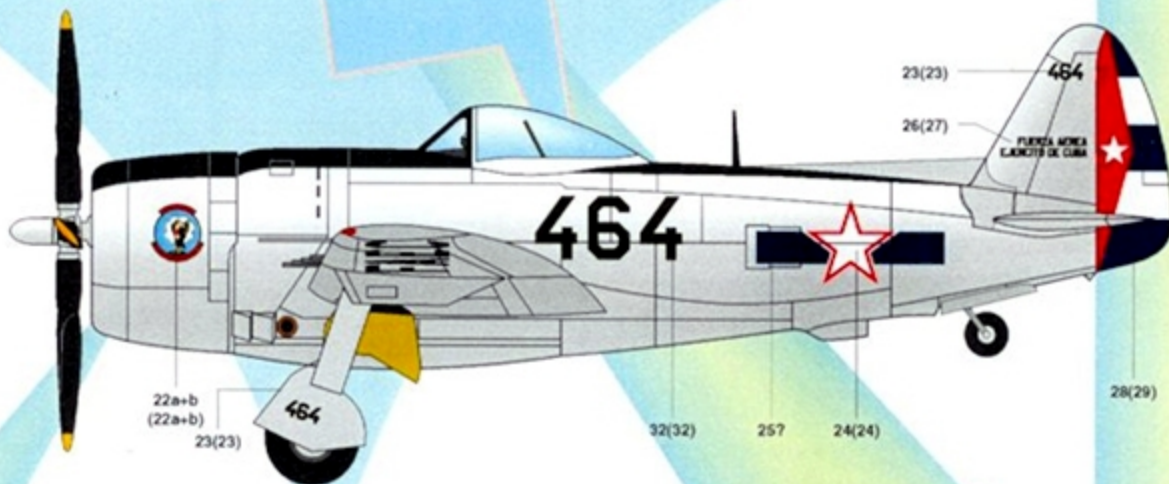
P-47D Thunderbolt, Mexican Air Force, 201 Escuadron, attached to the USAAF 58thFG, Philippines, 1945. Aluminum with Black anti-glare panels, White nose "petal" outlined in Red and Black I.D. stripes outlined in White. No.18 was the only Esc.201 P-47known to have carried nose "petal" design in combat.



(below) P-47D, Brazilian Air Force, attached to the USAAF 12th AF, Italy, 1945. Overall aluminum with black anti-glare panels.



Republic P-47D Thunderbolt, No.1 fighter-bomber sqn., Cuban Army Air Force, mid-1950's. Aluminum with black anti-glare panels. Note the duplication of the aircraft's serial on the fin tip and gear doors.



Note different position of fuselage star & bars.



As Castro's rebellion gained intensity, Cuba's P-47D's received overall coats of brownish olive drab (aprox FS 14052). Note the aircraft's serial on the gear doors.
