





RIGHT SIDE DECAL LAYOUT and color scheme





Spitfire Mk. Vc, ZP-X/BS 219, camouflage is Dark Earth (RAF), Foliage Green (RAAF), over Azure Blue (RAF). Spinner and tail stripe are Sky Blue (RAAF), leading edges of wing are white.

Spitfire Mk. Vc, QY-G/A58 236, camouflage is Dark Earth (RAF), Foliage Green (RAAF), over Azure Blue (RAF). Small \*G\* on nose is applied over painted Dark Green patch. Spinner is black, inboard leading edges of wing are white.






Spitfire Mk. VIII, UP-F/A58, camouflage is Dark Green (RAF) and Mixed Green over Medium Sea Grey (RAF), with upper surface camouflage wrapping completely around the nose. The exact shade of Mixed Green is uncertain, but is thought to be similar to Cockpit Green (RAF), but lighter. Leading edges of wing and all tail surfaces are white, with camouflage showing through faded white paint on the horizontal stabilizers. Spinner is bright green, representing "B" Flight.

Spitfire Mk. VIII, ZP-Q/A58 614, camouflage is Dark Green (RAF) and Ocean Grey (RAF) over Medium Sea Grey (RAF). Spinner is red, leading edges of wing are white.

Note: the Spitfire Mk VIII had short span ailerons as shown on the drawing to the right.
