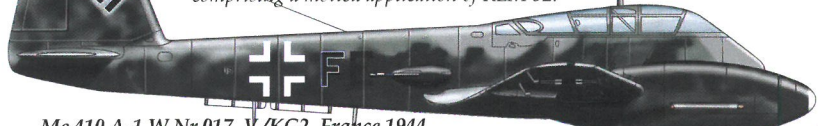

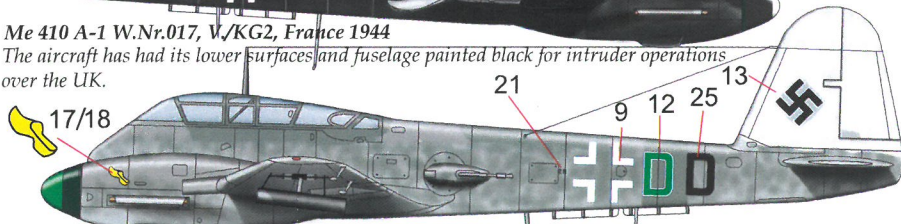

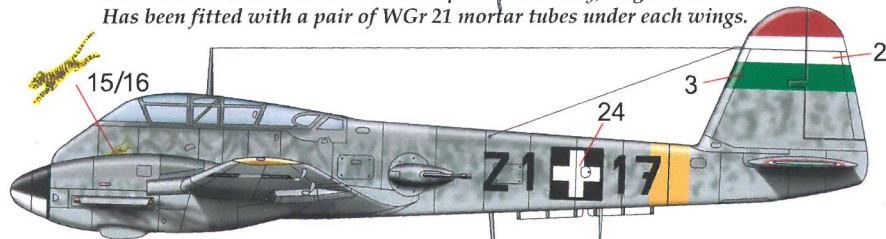


Me 410 A-1 W.Nr.017, V/KG2, France 1944

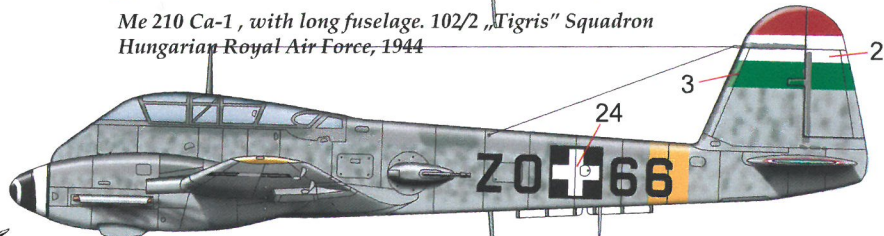
The aircraft has had its lower surfaces and fuselage painted black for intruder operations over the UK.



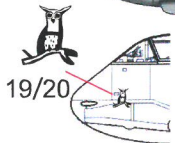
Me-210 A-1 W.Nr. 2102251 ZG 26 Diepholz, Germany, August 1943

Hungarian Royal Air Force, 1944

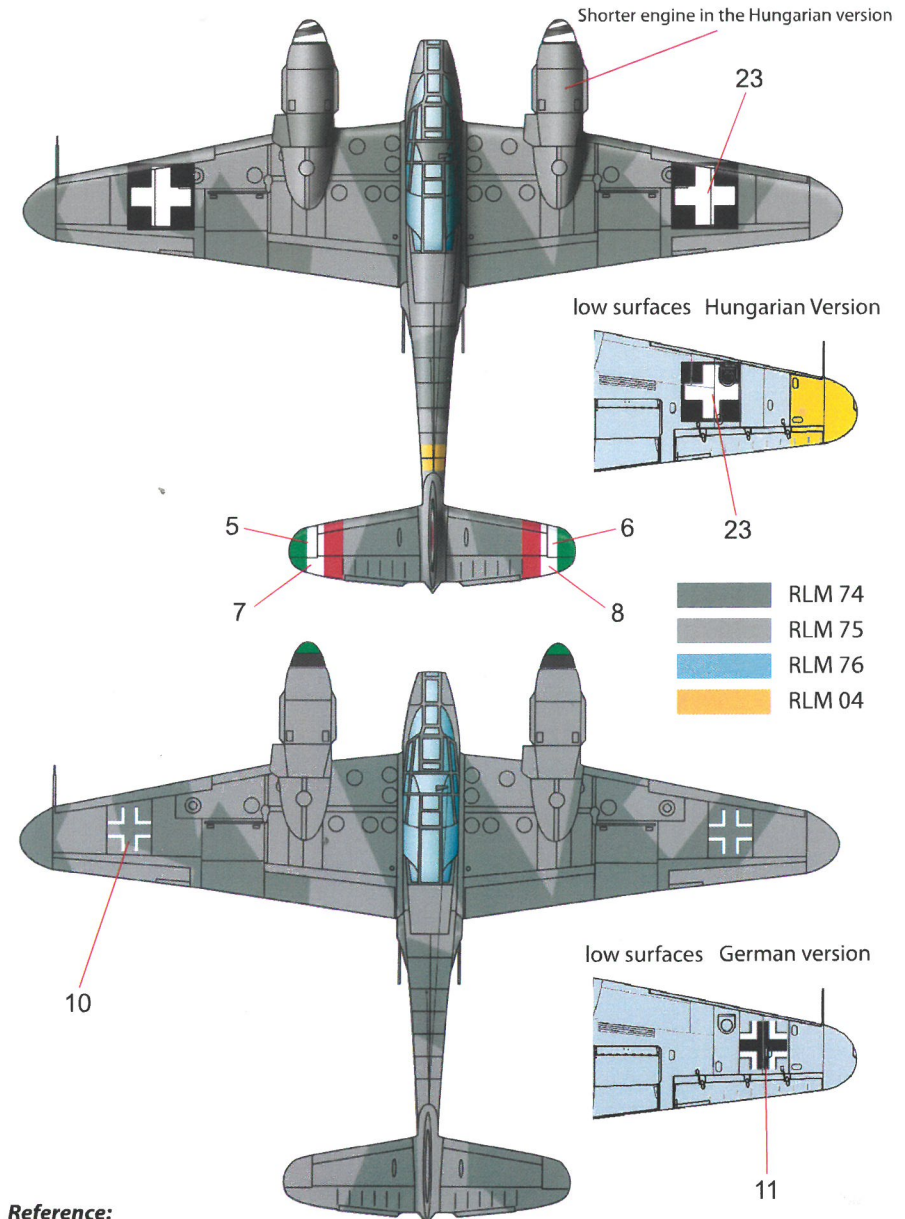

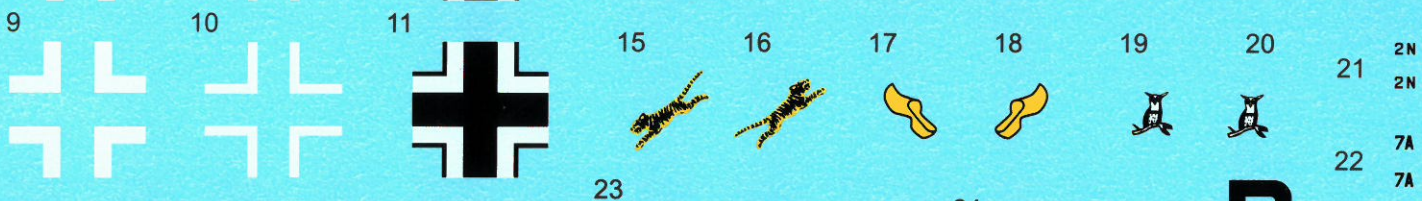
