

## A/C1

1-C-47D, Enfidaville, Tunisia, July 1943. Basically OD over Neutral Gray with the fuselage over sprayed with a Dk. Gray or Black color for night operations. Flown by Lt. G.B. Quisenberry of the 36 TCS/316 TCG. Scheme used during the invasion of Sicily.

## A/C 2

2-C-47A, a D-Day a/c of the 94 TCS/439 TCG at Devon, UK, June 5, 1944. Std. OD over Neutral Gray with D-Day wrap around bands. Flown by Group CO, COL. C.H. Young. Argonia was the pilot's hometown in US.

#### A/C3

3-C-47A, a nicely decorated C-47 with Black/Yellow checkered cowlings. Notice natural metal cowling flaps. OD over neutral Gray. This a/c still flies in the United Kingdom. 320 TS/27 TG, Lancashire, May 1944. Natural metal prop spinner. Very faded paint job.

### A/C 4

4-C-47B, 312 FS/27 TG, France, early 1945. Std OD over Neutral Gray with Black/Yellow cowlings and Yellow tail bands. Notice Black shadows to PW call sign.
