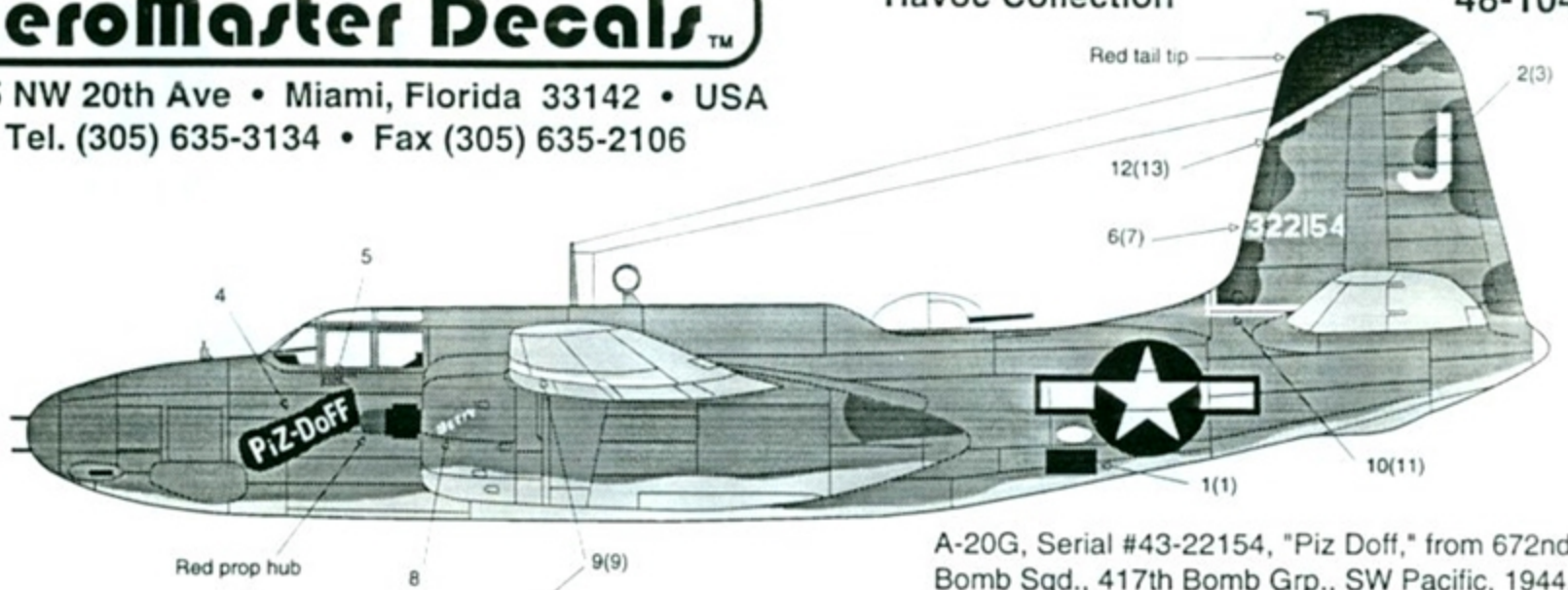

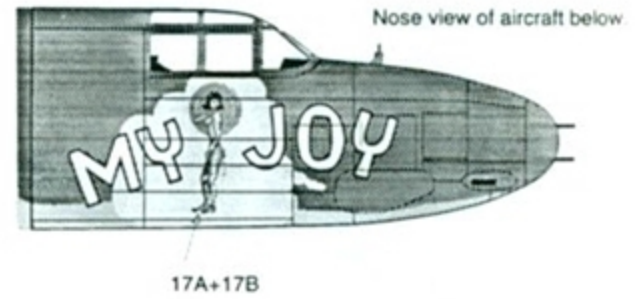
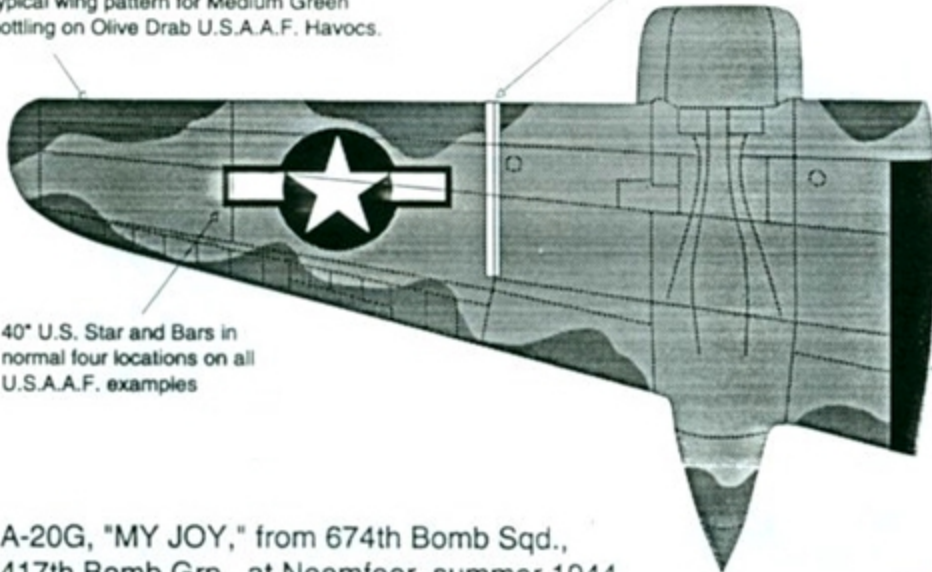

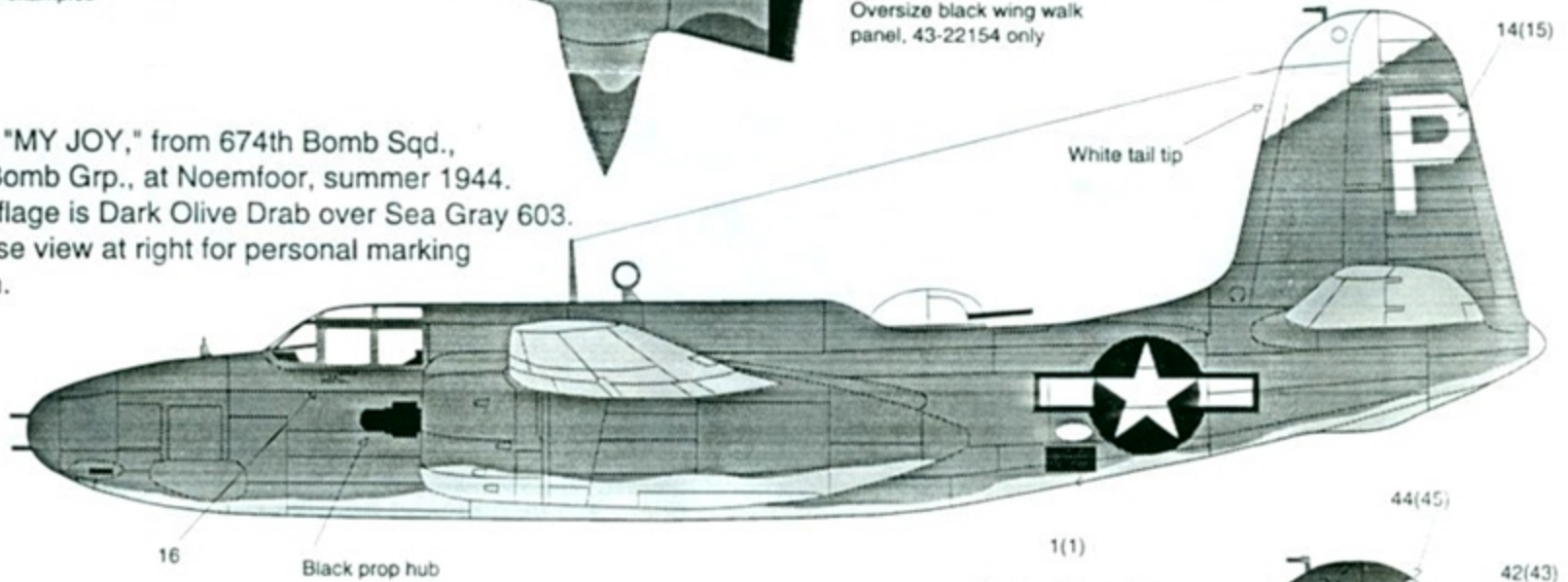
Typical wing pattern for Medium Green mottling on Olive Drab U.S.A.A.F. Havocs.



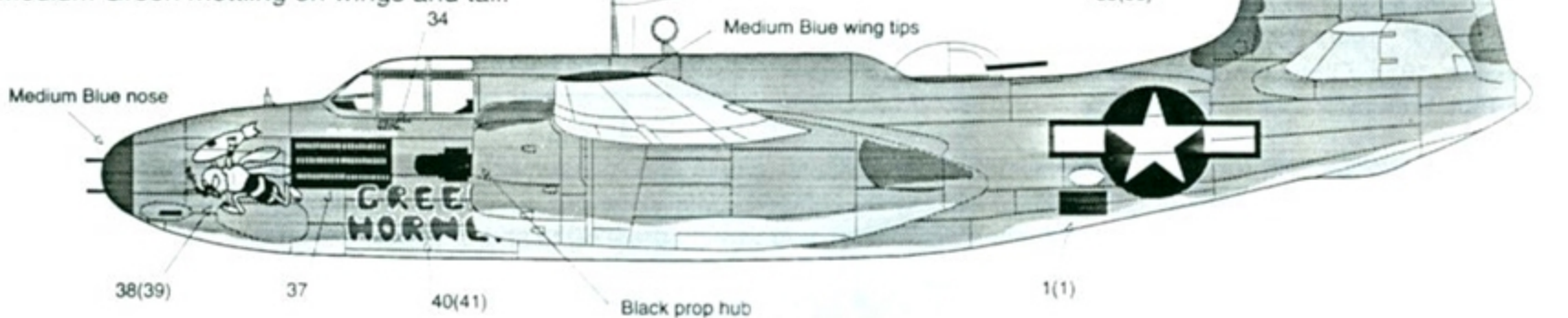
40° U.S. Star and Bars in normal four locations on all U.S.A.A.F. examples

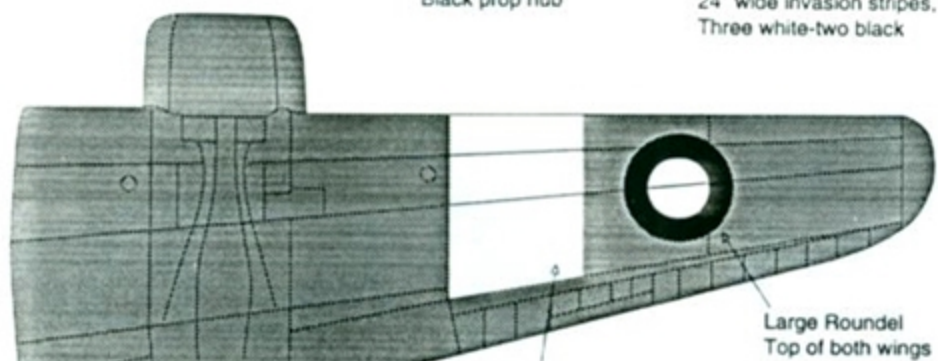
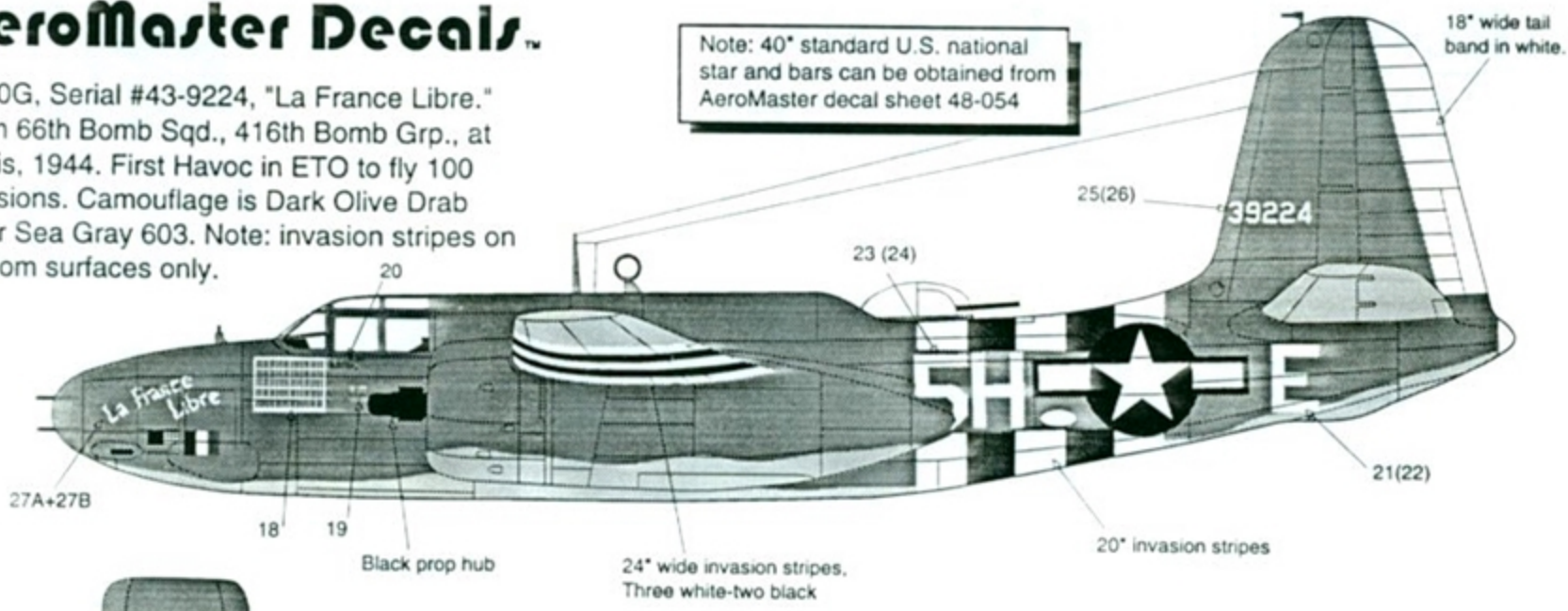

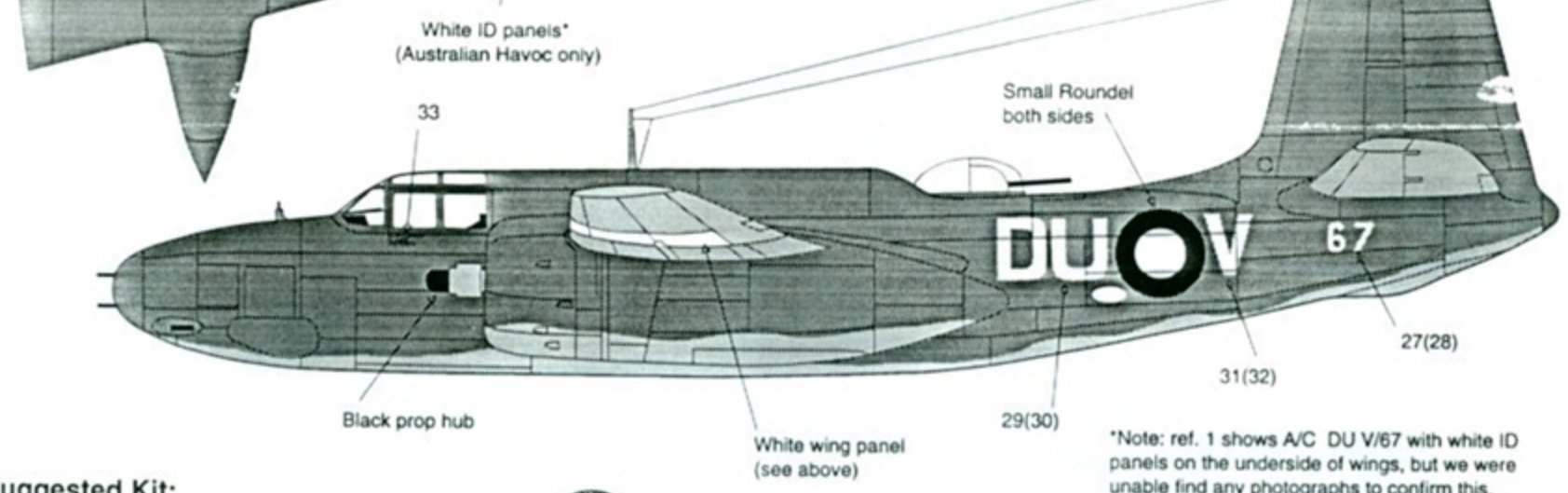

A-20G, "DU-V/67," from Royal Australian Air Force No.22 Squadron at Kamiri, 1944. Camouflage is Medium Green over Gray.
