


La-7, flown by Ivan N. Kozhedub, Summer 1945. Dark gray (F.S. 36176) and medium gray (F.S. 36270) camouflage with light blue (F.S. 15200) undersurfaces. Cowl and spinner red. Rear part of tail white. Cowl bands and panels aft of exhausts natural metal.

La-7, flown by Lt. Col. Dolgushin, 165th I.A.P, 4th Air Army, Germany, 1945. Upper surfaces medium gray (F.S. 36270), lower surfaces light blue (F.S. 15200). Spinner and cowl red. Cowl bands and panels aft of exhaust natural metal. Note: paint vertical stabilizer and rudder white before applying items 15 & 16.



La-7, flown by Sultan-Amet Khan, Spring 1945. Dark gray (F.S. 36176) and medium gray (F.S. 36270) camouflage with light blue (F.S. 15200) undersurfaces. Yellow spinner, red cowl. Cowl bands and panels aft of exhausts natural metal.

La-7, special presentation a/c for Ivan N. Kozhedub. Upper surfaces medium blue (between F.S. 35180 & 15092), lower surfaces light blue (F.S. 15200). Cowl red. Spinner, and rear part of tail white. Cowl bands and panels aft of exhaust natural metal.
