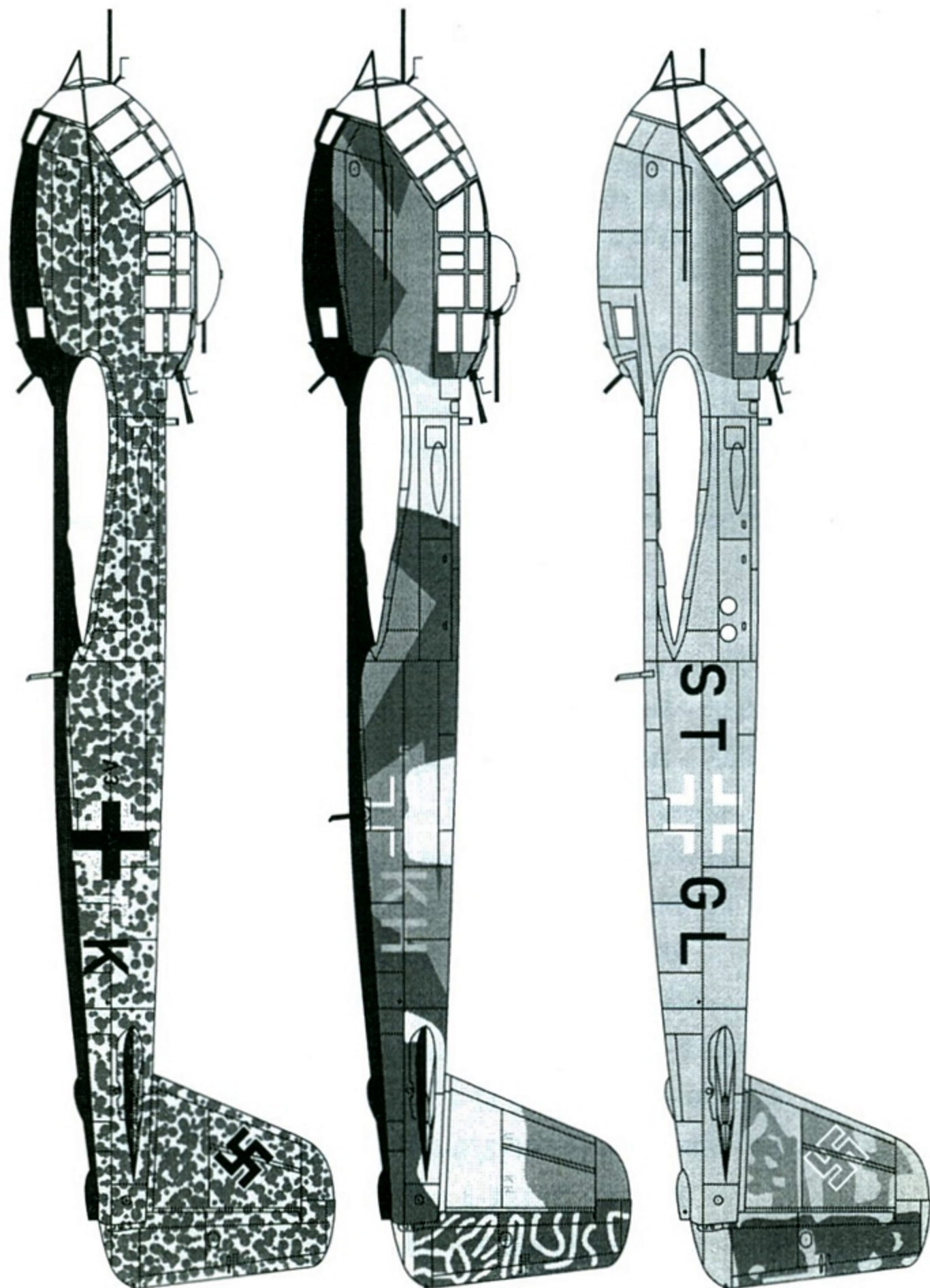

## NOTES

#1 – E-model (or F) converted as a personal transport for GFM Erhard Milch. RLM 70/71/65 with RLM 65 sprayed over most of the fuselage and upper surfaces. RLM 70/71 canopy framing. Soft-edge segmented spinners. Bombsight replaced by window. Two round observation windows installed at mid-fuselage. References: A – page 4; B – page 49.

#2 – KG 26 A-model abandoned in France, 1944. RLM 70/71/22 with disruptive stripes of RLM 76. RLM 76 squiggles on rudder. No swastikas. Unknown style of lower crosses. Trailing antenna at mid-fuselage. Reference: A – page 18.

#3 – KG 200 E-model abandoned at France, 1944. RLM 76/22 with heavy dapple of an unknown dark color. Side markings toned down with light dapple; upper crosses possibly toned down or painted over. Unknown if geschwader code (A3) was applied. Unknown style of lower crosses. Reference: A – page 7.

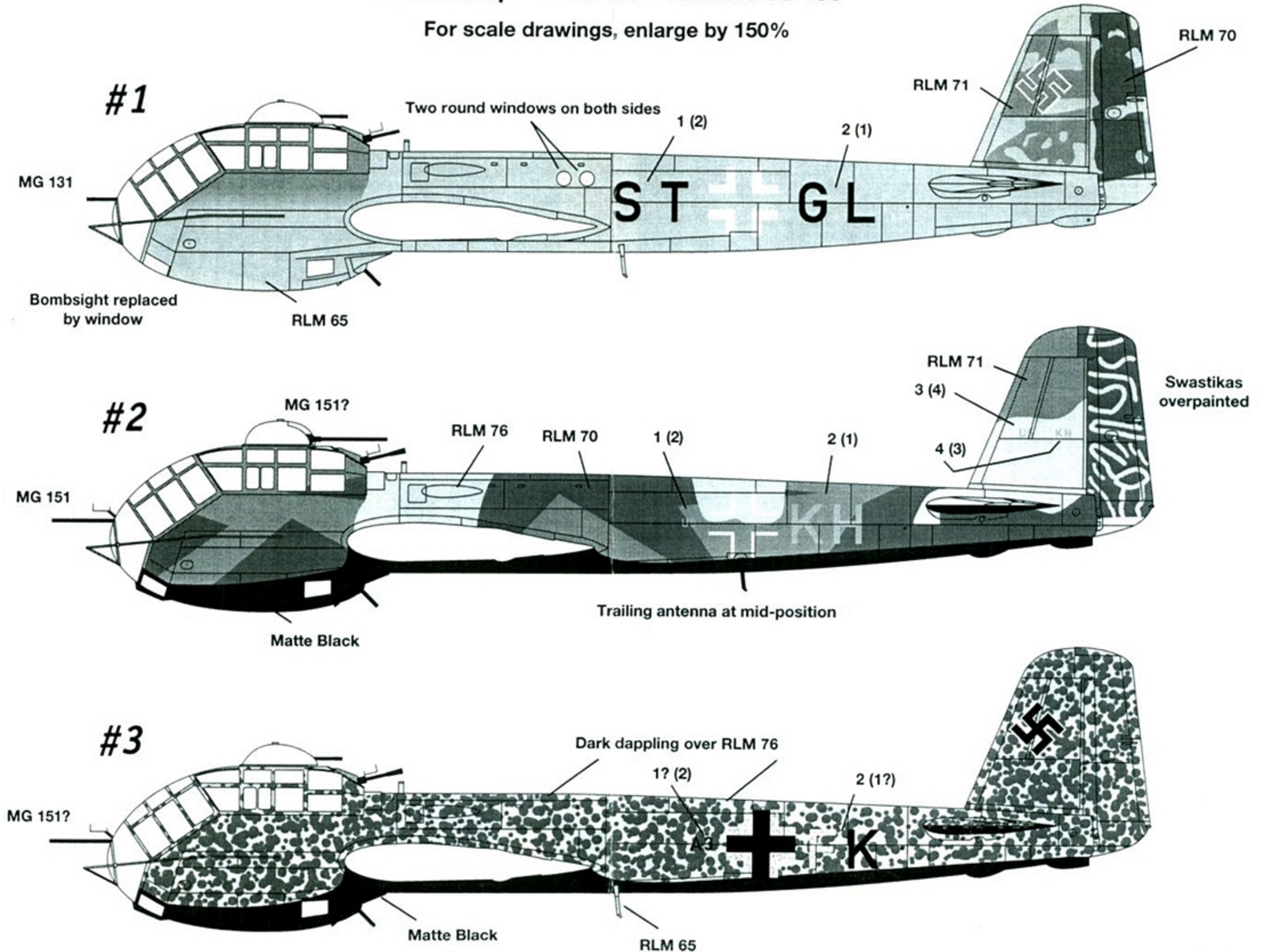

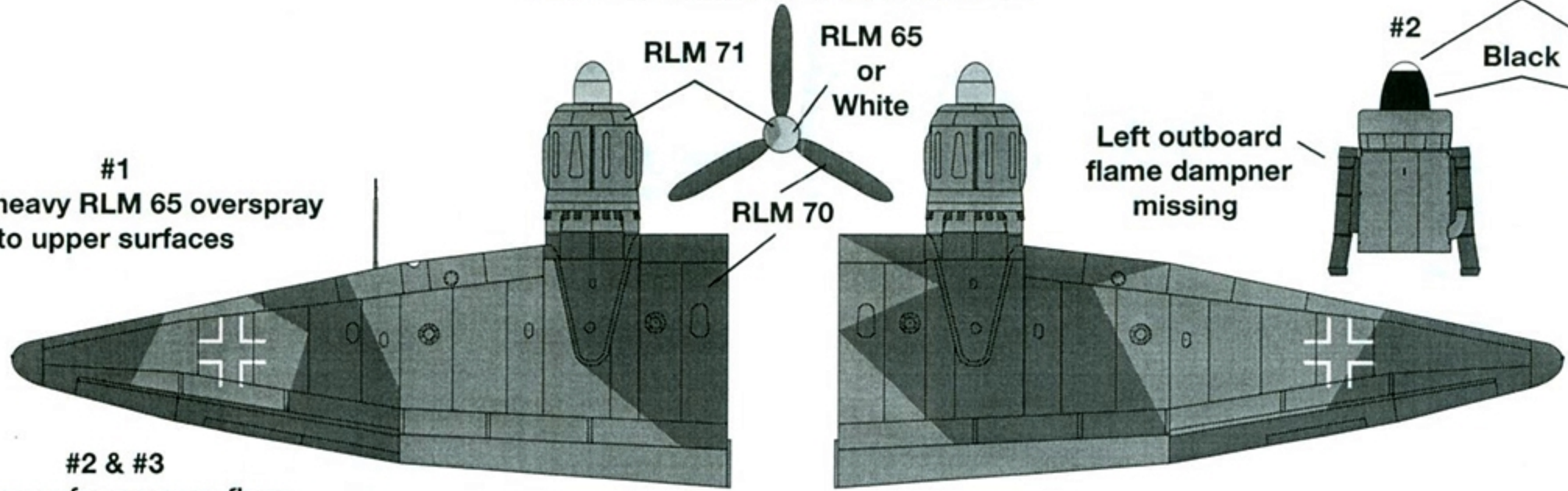

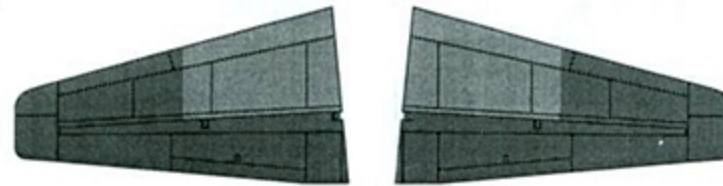

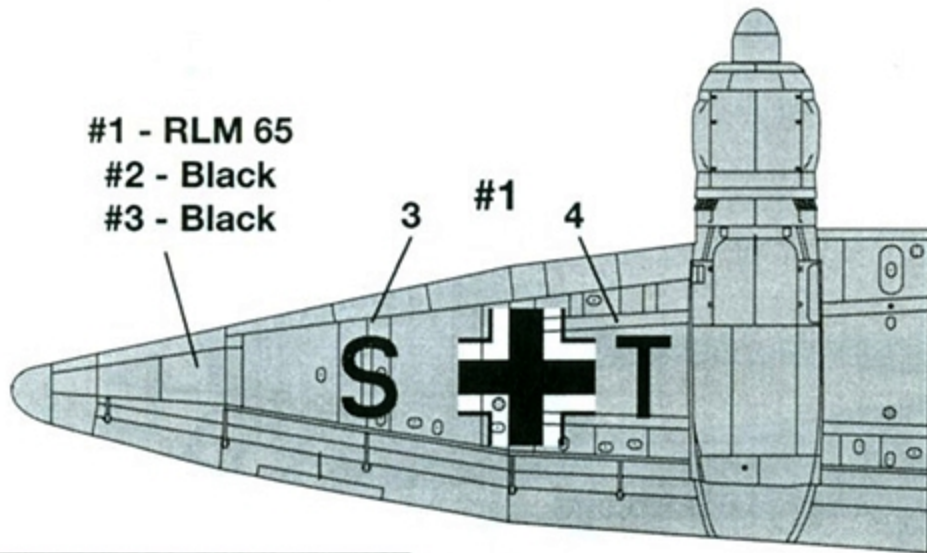

to upper surfaces



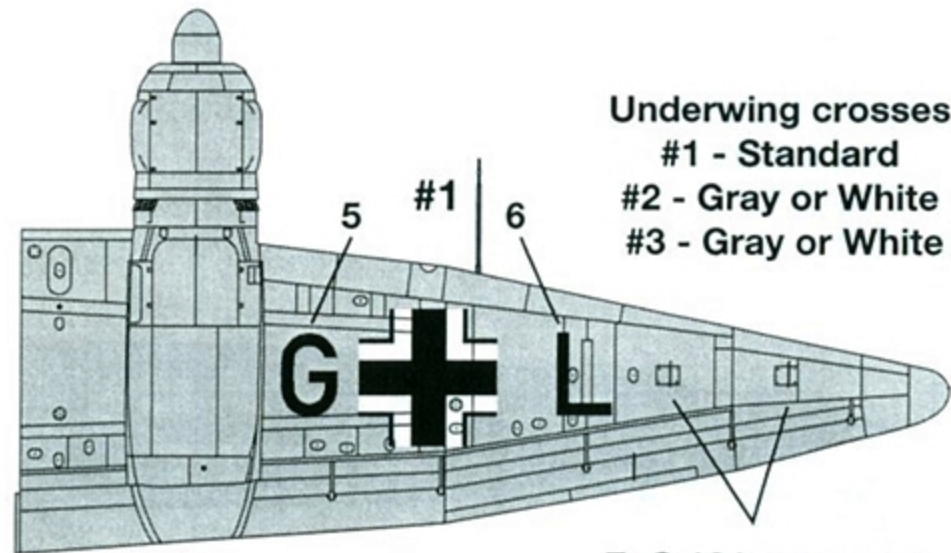
#2 & #3

per side view fuselage spine



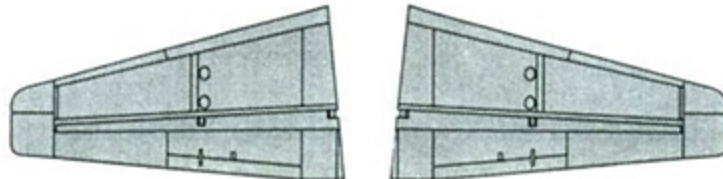
#1 - RLM 65
