

NOTE: The "No Step", "Step" and Arrow markings on this scheme are black. All other stenciling is white








NOTE: Standard national insignias are 40 inch diameter on the fuselage and 50 inch diameter on the wing

TBM-3 Avenger #314 Tri-color Scheme Note how the intermediate blue wraps around and over the leading edge of the wings and horizontal stabilizers
