The P-51D "Flying Dutchman" was flown by Lt. Bob Goebel, 308th Fighter Squadron, who received the P-51D in place.



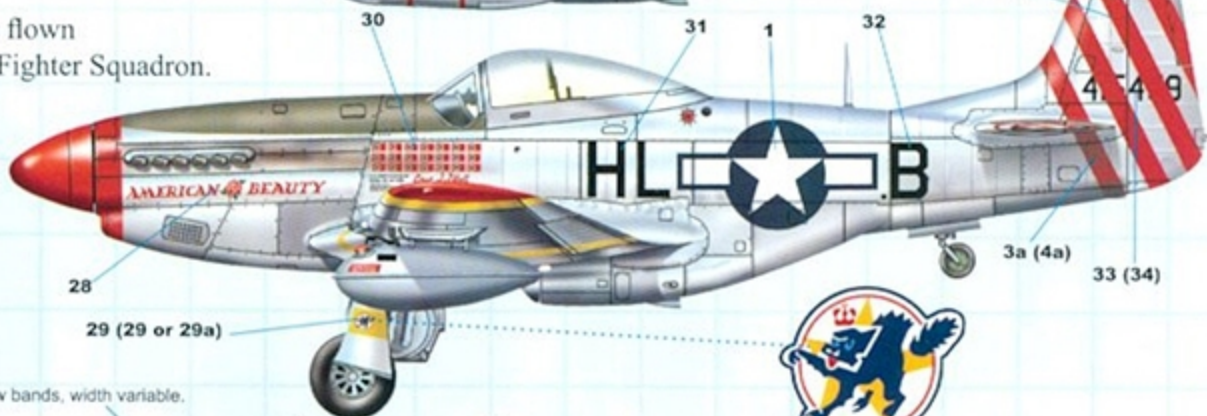

The P-51D "American Beauty" was flown by Capt. James Voll with the 308th Fighter Squadron.

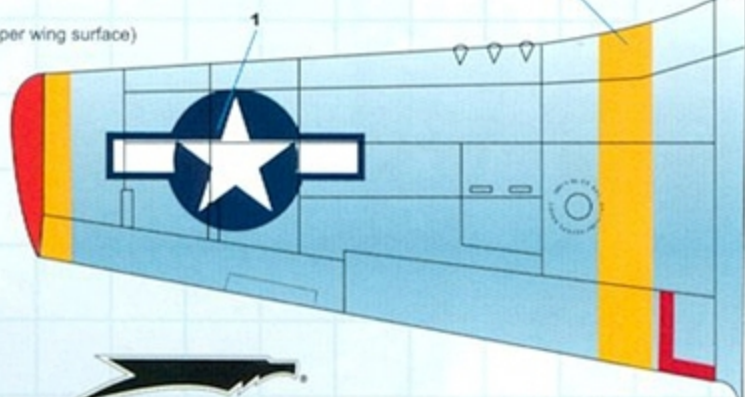


Starboard nose art

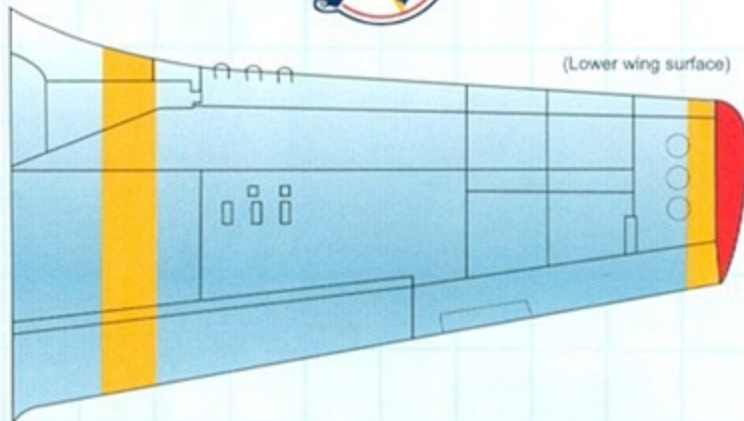


Yellow bands, width variable.
