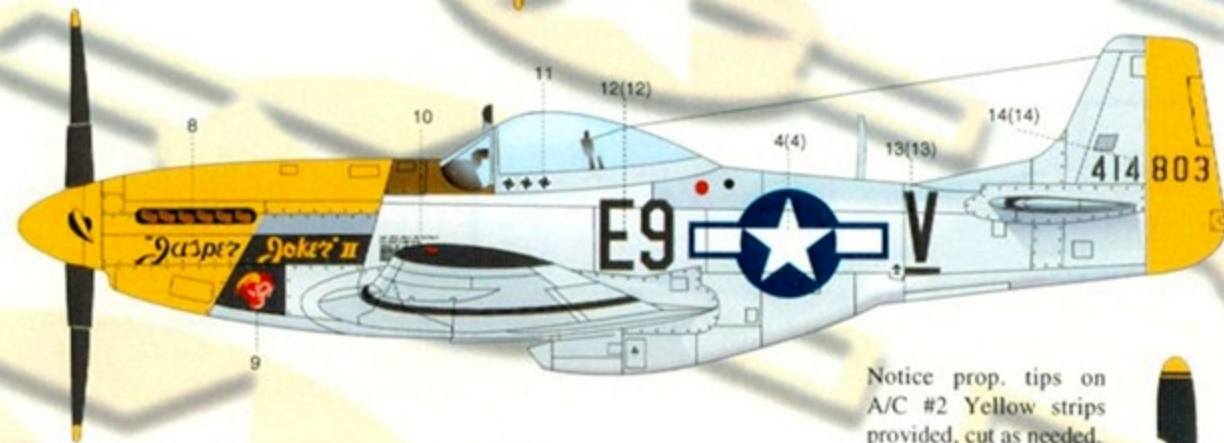
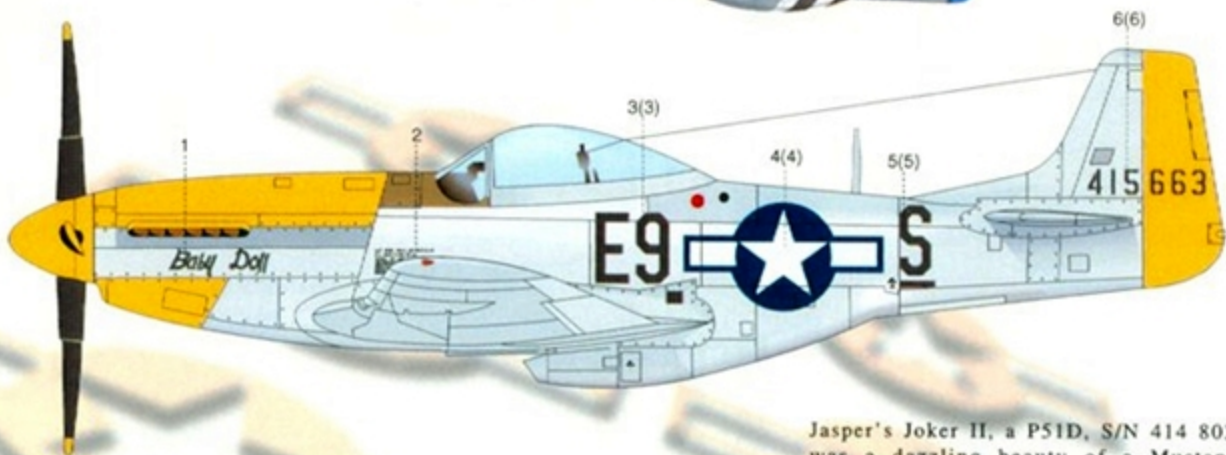

Baby Doll, a P51D, S/N415 663, flown by Lt. Clarence Sullivan, Jr. Natural metal finish with Yellow nose and rudder. Section of O.D. antiglare panel shows between canopy and Yellow section. Lt. Delmer A. Ford was K.I.A. in this aircraft on April 16, 1945. Notice the underlined S code indicating there were two aircraft with the same code.

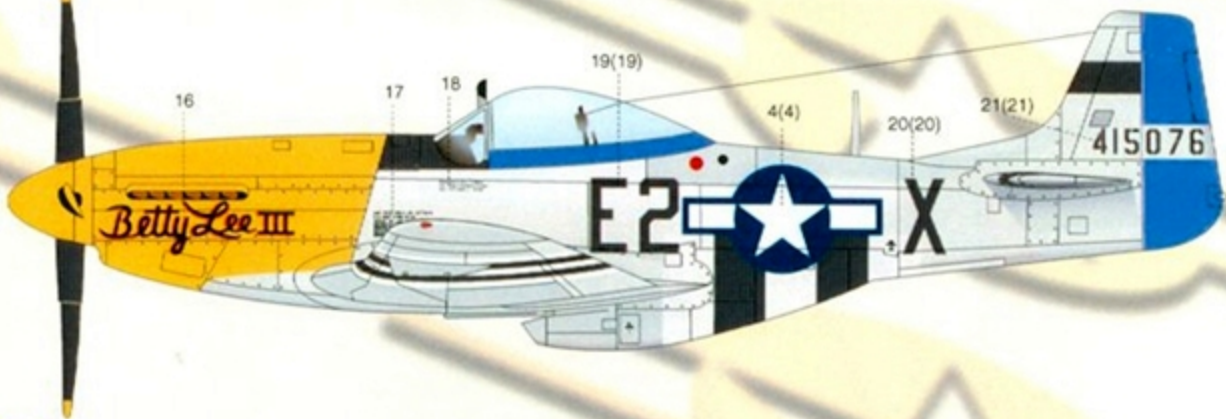


Notice prop. tips on A/C #2 Yellow strips provided, cut as needed.

Jasper's Joker II, a P51D, S/N 414 803, was a dazzling beauty of a Mustang flown by Lt. Donald F. Vulgamore. Natural metal finish with Yellow nose and rudder, Black wing & horizontal stab. bands, Black wing tips and name/nose art background. Two aerial victories, one (1) ground kill and a damaged was the final score of Jasper's Joker. O.D. antiglare panel. Notice rear view mirror. Three reversed swastikas on White circle on canopy frame.

Overall Aluminum finish with Yellow prop spinner, forward nose; pale Greyish Blue rudder, canopy frame and Black anti-glare panel. Black band on vertical fin. D-Day stripes on lower main wings and rear fuselage. 'White' fuselage D-Day stripes are pale Gray (dirty white).

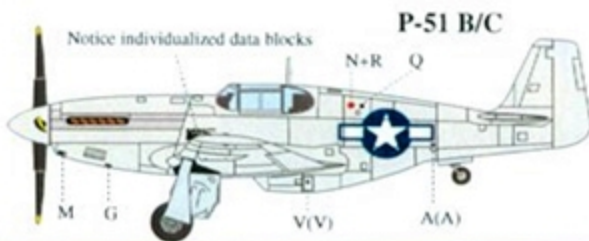
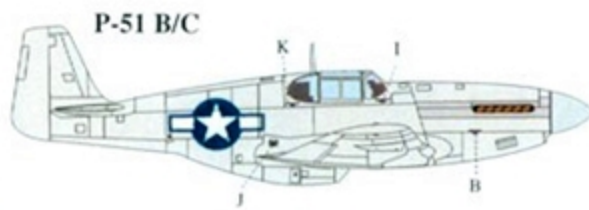
