


P-38M, 418 NFS, flown by 1st Lts. Johnny Brewer and David Hopwood during the occupation of Japan, late1945. Gloss Black with Flat Black A/G panel. N.M. turbocharger exhaust areas. This $A / C$ was heavily stained on top of booms and across fins and rudders. Note Flame Damper shrouds at the end of the armament. The name Snooks may have been on both sides.

P-38J 15-LO, 27th F.S., 1st F.G., Vincenzo, Italy 1944-45. Shinny N.M. finish with Red trim decorated this beautiful machine. The name Nellie Ann could have been on right side too. O.D. anti glare panels. (see Illustration)

P-35J, 367th F.G.9th A.F., Gung Ho was a very inconspicuously marked A/C, except for the beautiful Rabbit and Dragon carried on the left side of the nose. Yellow center fuselage nose tip.
