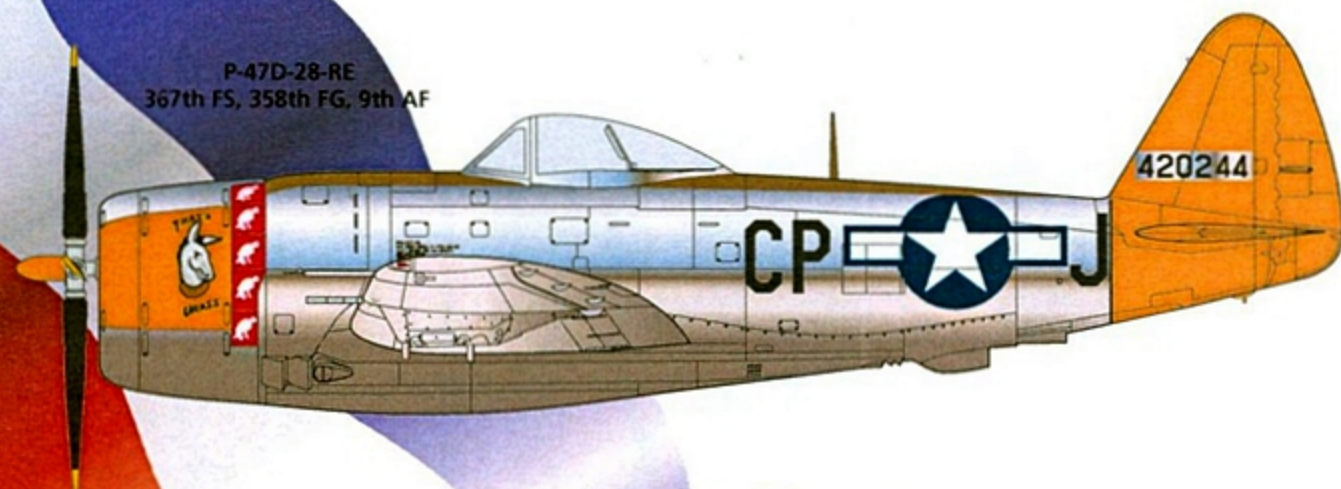

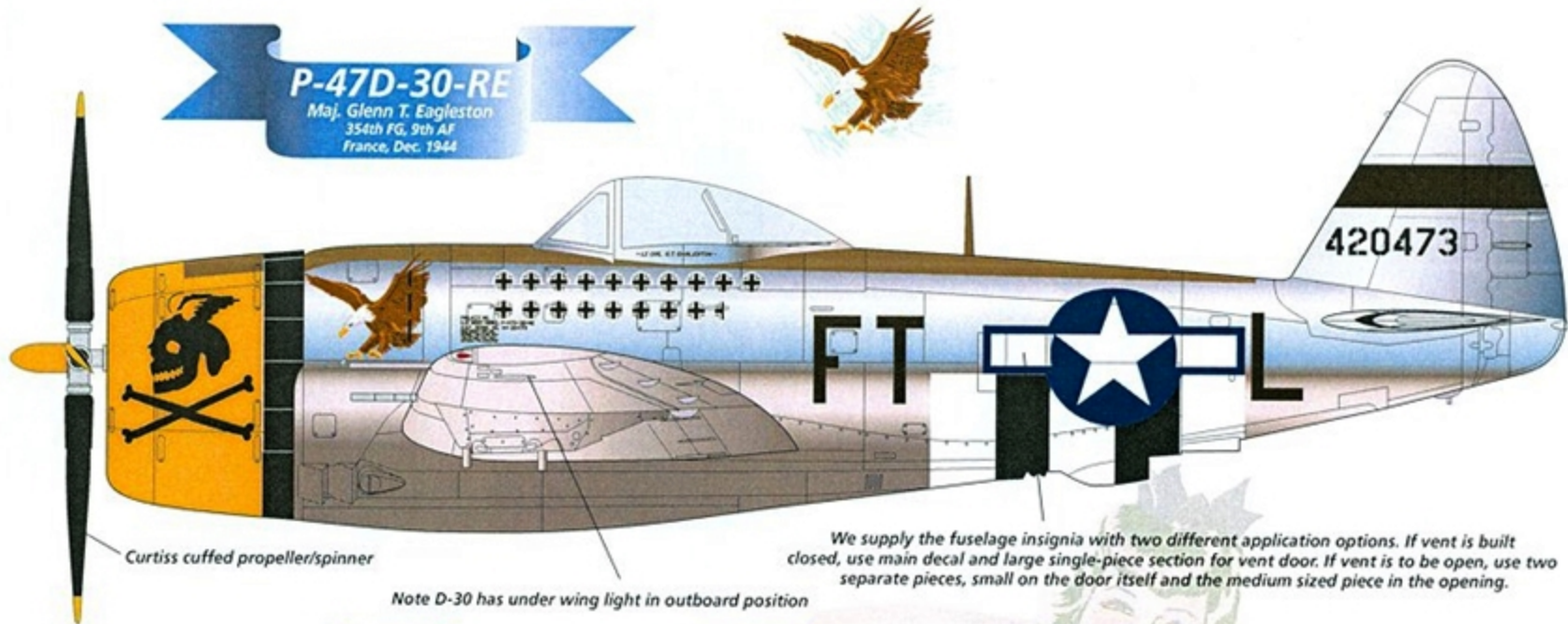

Note D-30 has under wing light in outboard position

We supply the fuselage insignia with two different application options. If vent is built closed, use main decal and large single-piece section for vent door. If vent is to be open, use two separate pieces, small on the door itself and the medium sized piece in the opening.

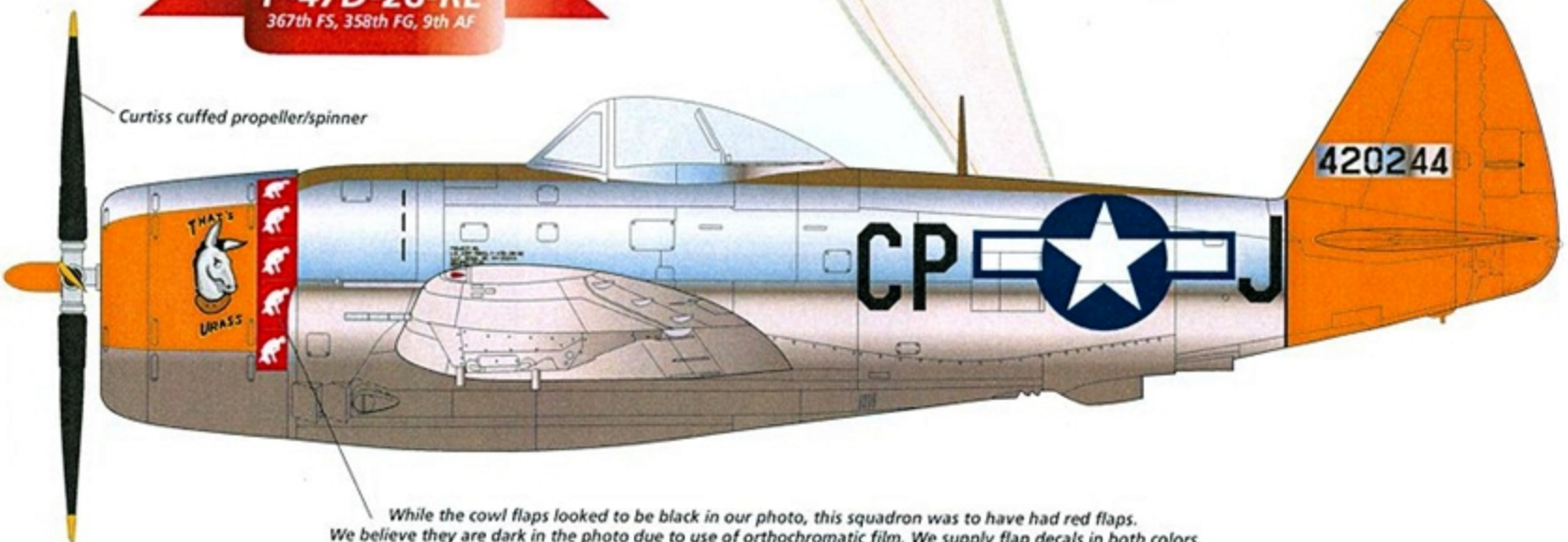
