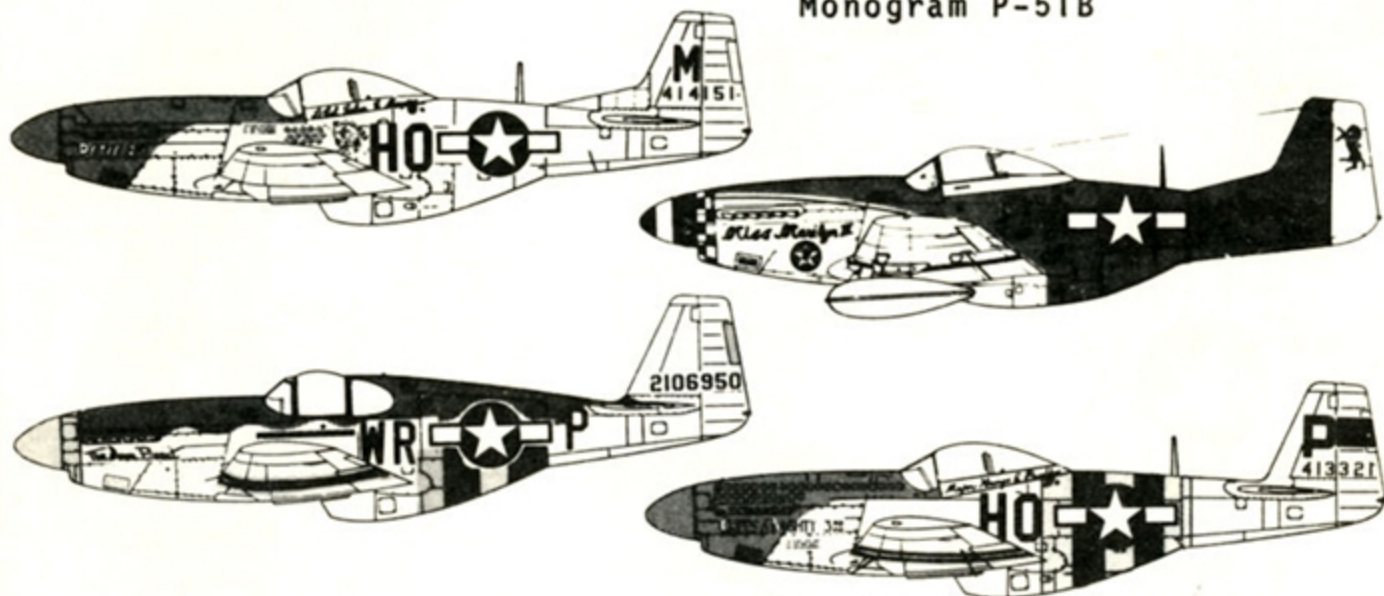

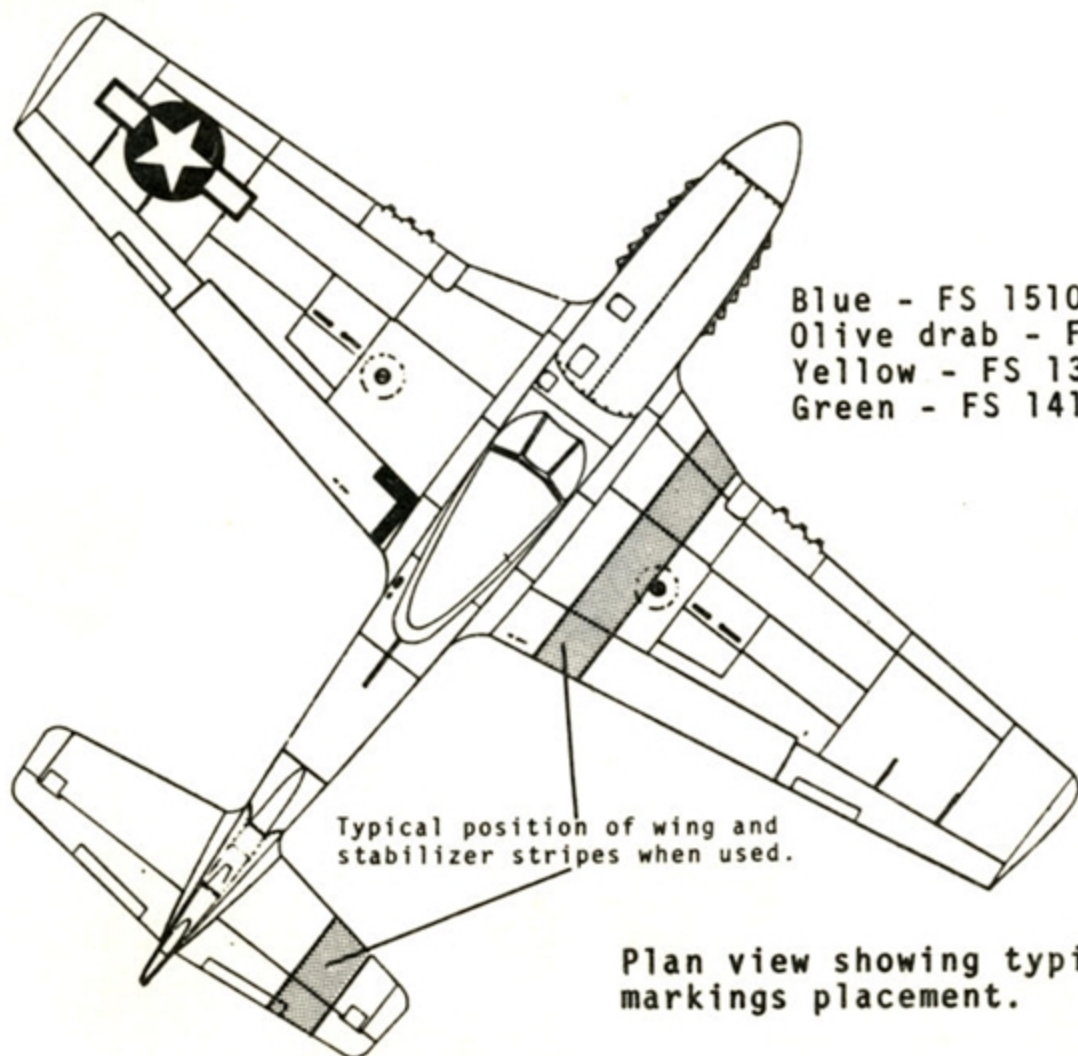

Typical position of wing and stabilizer stripes when used.

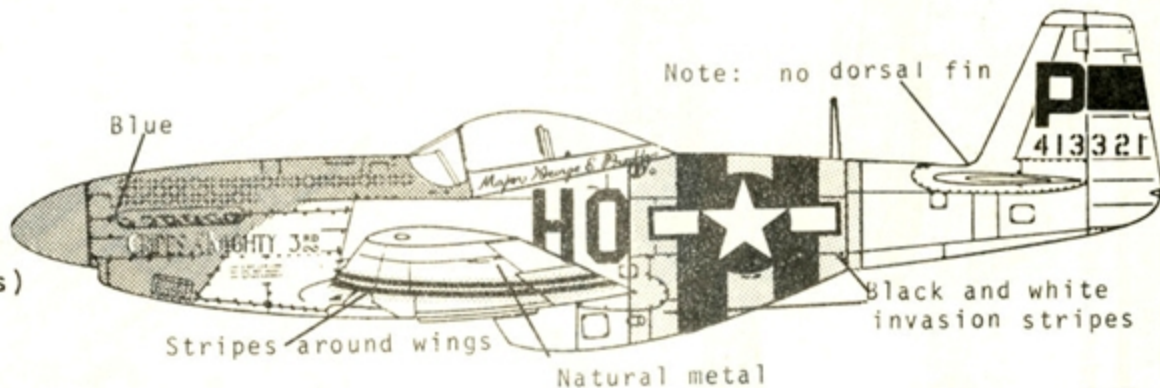
Plan view showing typical markings placement.

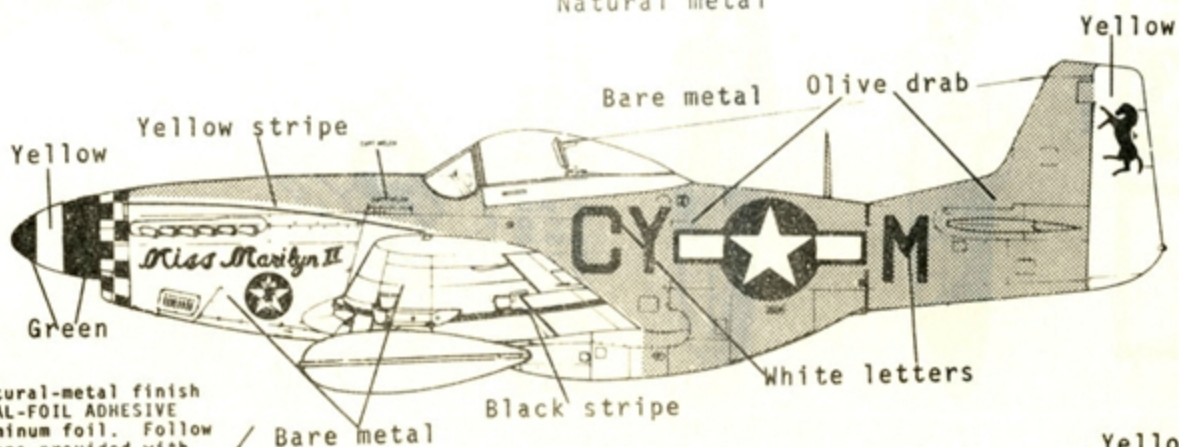
