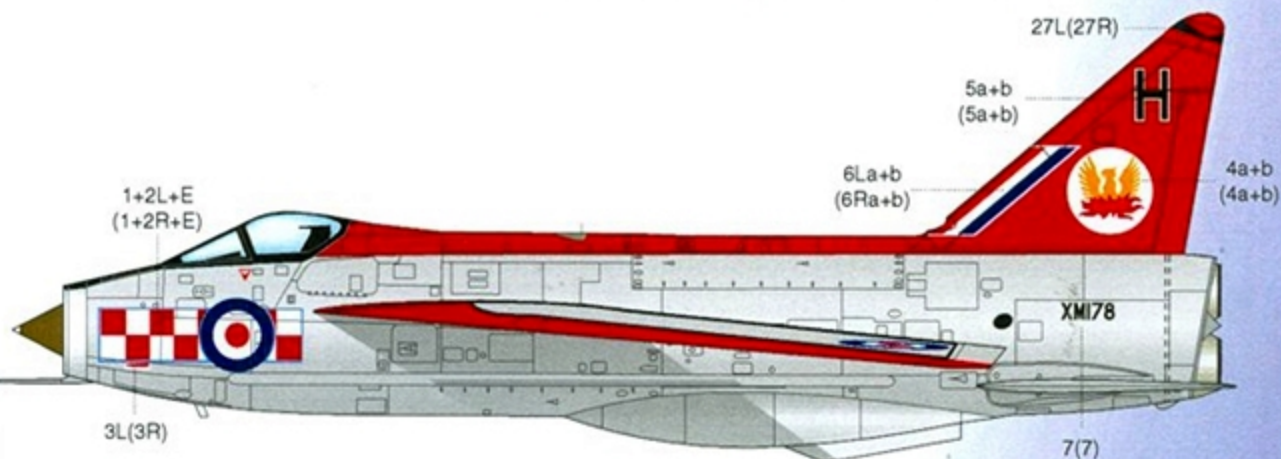

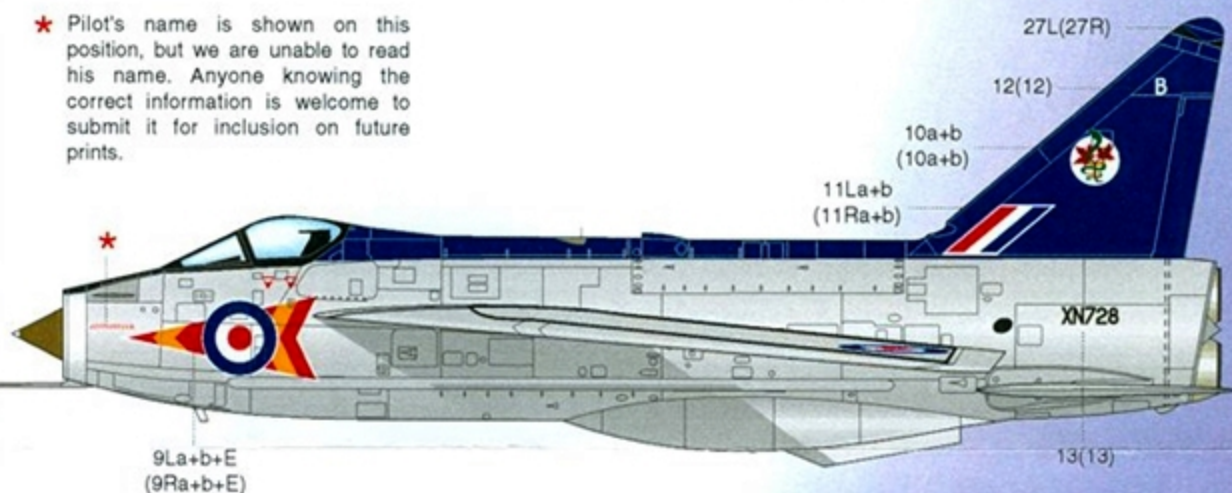

## Lightnings Pt I Early Days

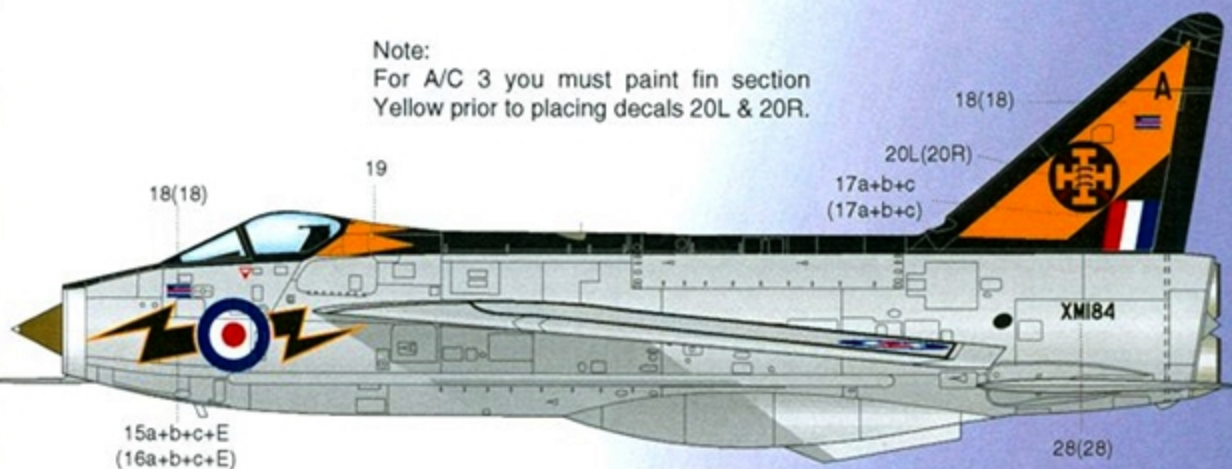
English Electric Lightning F.1A of No.56 ("The Firebirds") Sqn., Royal Air Force, 1963. Natural metal overall. Fuselage spine, fin, and top wing and stabilizer leading edges are gloss Post Office Red, with Black anti-glare panel, canopy framing, and dielectric fin panel. The Red wing and stabilizer areas are peculiar to this unit.



English Electric Lightning F.2 of No.92 Sqn., Royal Air Force, 1964. Natural metal overall. Fuselage spine and fin are Gloss Roundel Blue. Black anti-glare panel, canopy framing, and dielectric fin panel. The photo we have of this A/C shows it without the Blue spine but with the Blue fin. It is dated around 1964, the transition period from all Silver/Blue. Other A/C are shown in the same condition. We decided to depict it in its final, most colorful scheme.



English Electric Lightning F.1A of No.111 Sqn., Royal Air Force, 1964. Natural metal overall. Anti-glare panel, canopy framing, fuselage spine, and fin are Black.



English Electric Lightning F.1 of No.145 Sqn./ No. 226 OCU, Royal Air Force, 1964. Natural metal overall. Fuselage spine and fin leading edge are Gloss Post Office Red. Anti-glare panel, canopy framing, and fin dielectric panel are Black.
