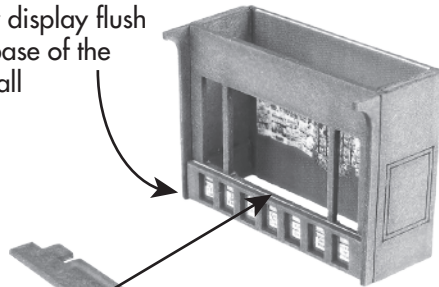
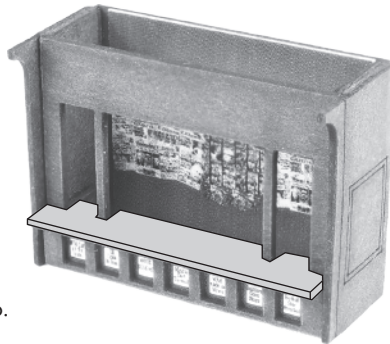


## Fig. 2 - FRONT WALL cont'd

Glue the under counter display flush to the base of the front wall



Then glue into place the counter top. The slots in the counter fit snugly around the display window supports.



Like so.

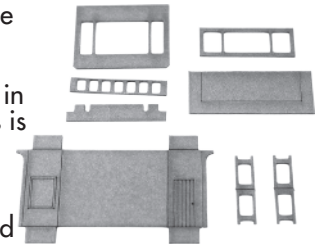
To construct this kit you will need the following:

1. A Modellers knife.
2. A steel ruler.
3. Glue - UHU Solvent Free Clear Adhesive is our favourite.
4. A cutting surface - a sheet of card or a cutting mat.
5. Fine point tweezers to hold the smaller components.
6. Metcalfe UltraFine Tip Glue Bottle (Code: MT907)

## EXTRACTING COMPONENTS FROM SHEETS.

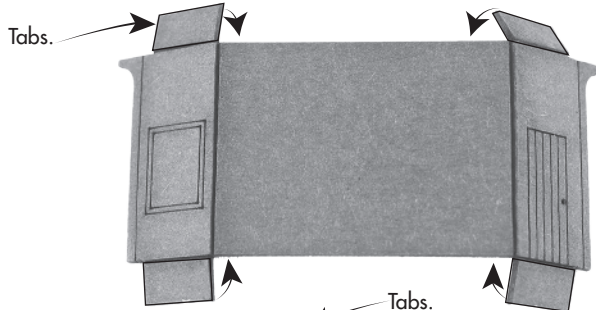
To release the laser components *carefully* push them out from the card, these components are delicate.

Store the released components in a separate 'Builders Yard'. This is an area kept away from your working surface, keep the components here until needed. Use a tray or thick piece of card to make your builders yard.



## Fig. 1 - REAR & SIDE WALLS

Take the rear and side wall section and fold back the 4 tabs and glue into place.



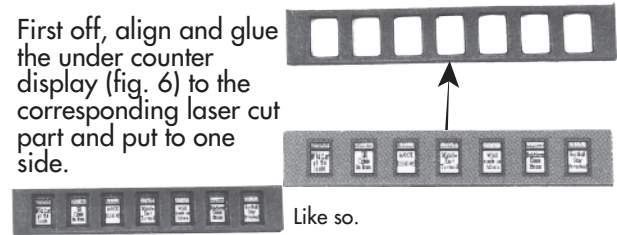
Next cut out a rear wall display (see fig. 6) and glue into place on the inside of the rear wall inbetween the folded back tabs.



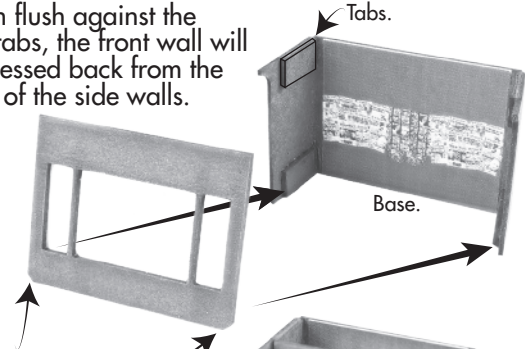
Like so.

## Fig. 2 - FRONT WALL

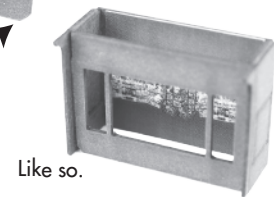
First off, align and glue the under counter display (fig. 6) to the corresponding laser cut part and put to one side.



Now affix the front wall section flush against the inner tabs, the front wall will be recessed back from the edges of the side walls.



Keep the cut off corners to the base.

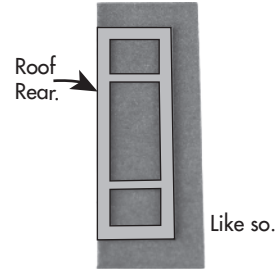

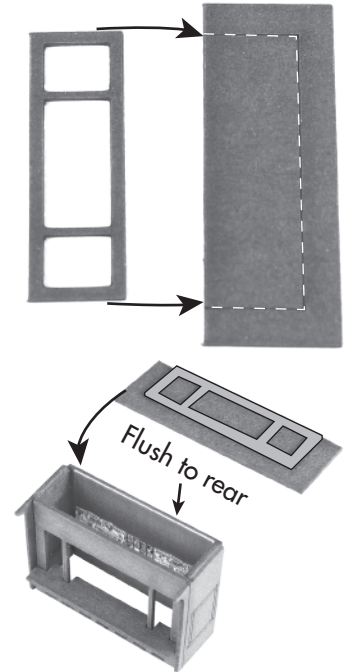
## Instruction Sheet 2

### Fig.3 - ROOF

Glue the roof detail to the main roof section. Use the guide scoreline to help you position it centrally.

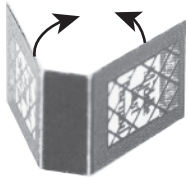
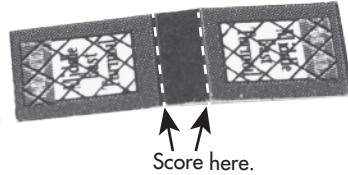


Then glue the roof to the walls. Keep the rear of the roof flush to the rear of the kiosk walls.



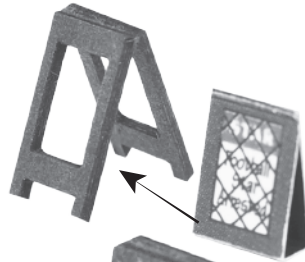
## Fig.4 - A BOARDS

Carefully cut out a selection of the A board displays and very carefully score along the edges of the black base.



Fold back and carefully glue the edges together creating a free standing triangle.

Now carefully align and glue the display to the frame.



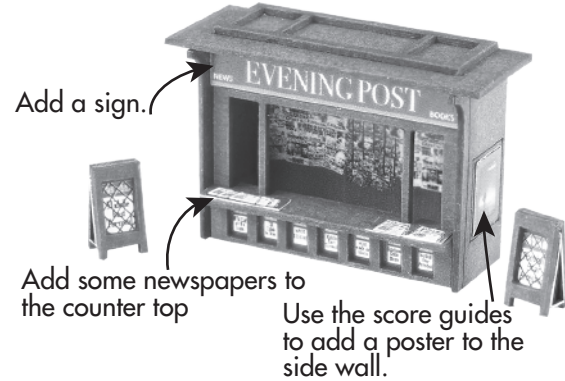
Like so.



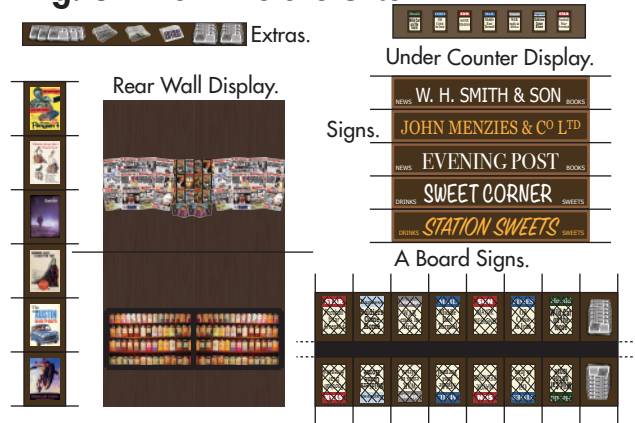
Use watercolours to paint the white edges.
