






Spitfire Mk. Vb, AA853, No. 302

Spitfire Mk. Vc, JK?, No. 2 Squadron, Royal South African Air Force, North Africa, 1942. RAF Dark Earth, Mid Stone and Azure Blue camouflage with red spinner. Digits of serial number overpainted. Aircraft has four 20mm cannon in the wings. NOTE: It is not known for certain whether this aircraft carried the orange, white and blue national insignias used by some SAAF units. The orange parts are provided separately should you wish not to use





Spitfire Mk. Vb, No. 19, Portugese Air Force, 1943. RAF Dark Green, Ocean Grey and Medium Sea Grey camouflage with spinner also in Medium Sea Grey.
