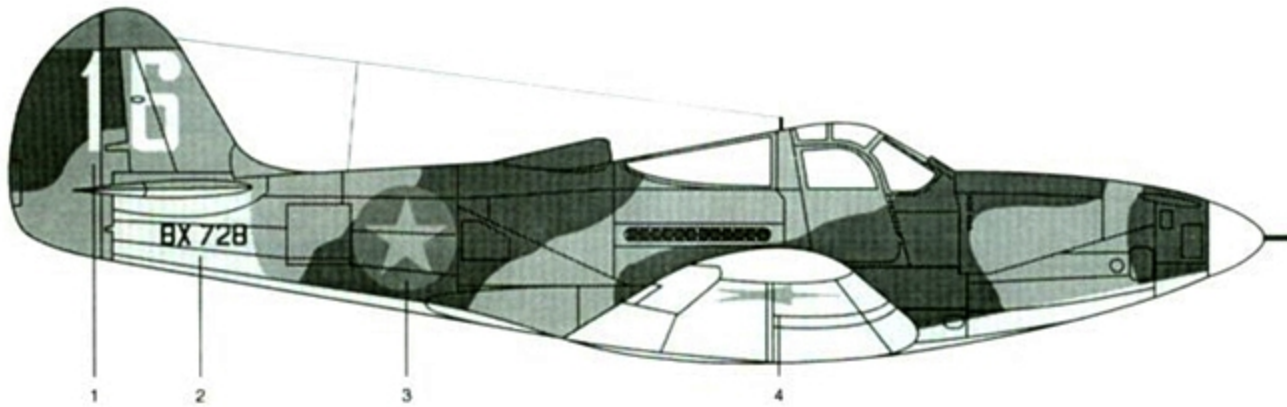

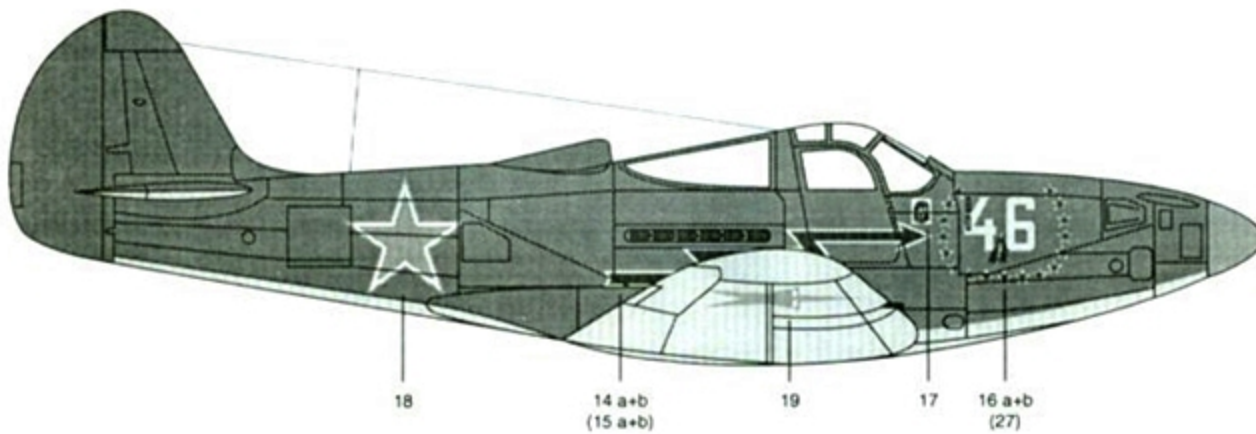
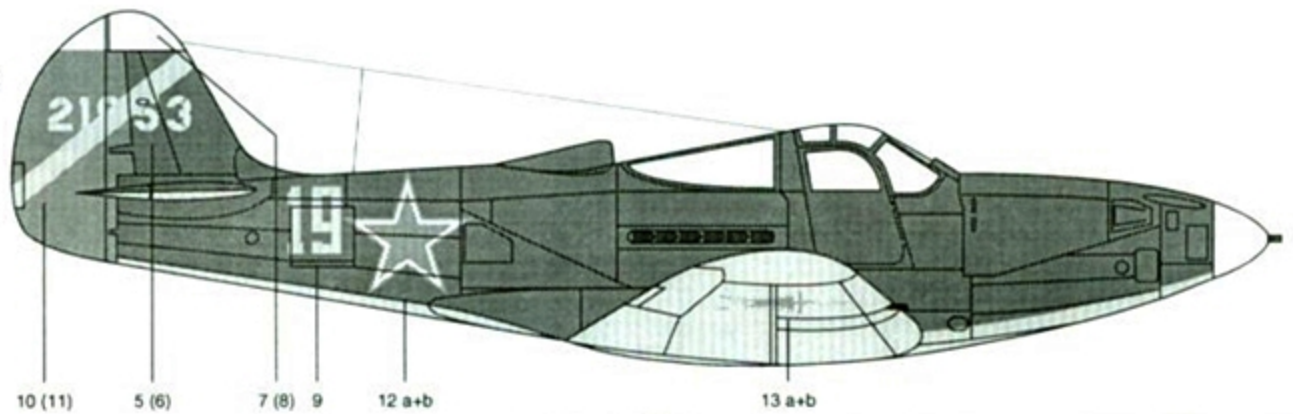

P-400 Airacobra I, BX728, 19th Guards IAP, East Karelia, 1942. RAF Dark Earth, Dark Green & Sky camouflage. RAF roundel locations overpainted with colors similar to the local camouflage. Fin tip red, spinner white.

P-39N, possibly 42-8753, Black Sea Fleet, Soviet Naval Aviation, June 1944. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray camouflage with white fin tip and spinner. Replacement rudder from P-39Q resulted in mis-matched serials. Rudder appears to be a lighter shade of Olive Drab.



P-39N, serial unknown, flown by Hero of the Soviet Union N.I. Protenkov. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray camouflage with red spinner.

P-39N, serial unknown, 17th IAP, 1944. Flown by Maj. V.F. Sirotn. Olive Drab and Neutral Grey camouflage with white spinner and nose wheel hub.
